**KEENELAND FALL MEET OPENS TODAY** The 16-day Keeneland Fall Meeting, offering the highest purses in the history of the stand, opens today in Lexington, Kentucky. The meeting offers a total of \$7,302,000 in purse money, an average of \$456,375 daily, including Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund and Breeders' Cup monies. Stakes purses will total a record \$2,610,000. Keeneland will offer seven graded stakes races, beginning with today's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup. Ten races will be offered each of the three Sundays during the meet in order to make up for the live races that will be lost closing day, Saturday, October 26, when Keeneland will simulcast all seven Breeders' Cup Championship races from Woodbine. Mondays and Tuesdays will be dark during the fall meet. With the exception of Breeders' Cup Day, when live racing gets underway at 11 a.m., post time for the first race daily will be 1 p.m.

**PIVOTAL RETIRED** Pivotal (GB) (Polar Falcon), whose victory in York's Nunthorpe S. August 22 gave trainer Sir Mark Prescott his first taste of Group One glory, has been retired and is to stand at his owners' Cheveley Park Stud next season. The three-year-old had been a possible starter in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp. But Chris Richardson, manager at Cheveley Park, said: "Sir Mark was not really happy about running him on ground that looks likely to be too soft. So, as Mr. and Mrs. Richardson (the stud's owners) were here, we made the decision on the spot to retire him." No firm details of a fee for Pivotal's new career are expected until next week. But Richardson added: "He's done all we that have asked of him on the racecourse and we are obviously hoping he can do the same at stud." Pivotal's retirement to Cheveley Park means that the Newmarket enterprise is set to have its largest complement of stallions, seven, for 1997.

Winner of the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. going a flat mile last out after finishing fourth in the GI Pacific Classic two starts back, Dramatic Gold shipped east for the first time since running third in the GI NYRA Mile last November. The fourth choice in this 11-horse field, the bay gelding was never far off the leaders, hooked third choice Formal Gold at the top of the stretch and outgamed that rival in the drive to the wire to edge clear late. "We decided on the Meadowlands Cup for two reasons," said winning trainer David Hofmans. "The money, and we didn't want to race him at Santa Anita. It's one track he doesn't like." As for what's next, Hofmans said, "We'll consider the Breeders' Cup under the right circumstances. If Cigar doesn't go, we'll go for sure." The even-money favorite GERI (Theatrical {Ire}) was never in the hunt and finished 10th. "It was a very disappointing effort," said his jockey, Jerry Bailey. "I had a clean trip, but he never ran fast enough to get into any trouble."

Superstar **Cigar** (Palace Music) plays elder statesman to a trio of top three-year-olds who vie for divisional honors in the race within a race. The connections of **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner), **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) and **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) are realistic about their chances of beating the reigning Horse of the Year, but all feel they have a chance to move to the head of their class with a big performance Saturday. "There's Cigar, and then there's the rest of us," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who saddles Belmont S. and Super Derby winner Editor's Note. "It would be foolish to predict an upset. It will be a coronation for Cigar, but the three-year-old picture will take a little firmer shape." Added Cigar's conditioner, Bill Mott, "We'll see how the three-year-olds stack up against the older horses. Cigar will be facing three good horses he hasn't run against and we have to prove we can do it. But I think, if he gets beat, it will be human error that will lead to it."
