SKIP AWAY TAKES CUP Skip Away (Skip Trial) ran the race of his life in yesterday's \$1 million Jockey Club Gold Cup, defeating reigning Horse of the Year Cigar (Palace Music) by a head and cementing his place at the top of this year's three-year-old crop. "Our last three races have been the fastest races run at those tracks--that's what prompted me to bring him here," said Skip Away's trainer Sonny Hine. "We wanted to run against Cigar. The worst that could happen was that we would get beat and be second--he is so far superior to the other horses. But we were lucky to hang on." Hine said a Breeders' Cup Classic bid for Skip Away, who is not Breeders' Cup eligible, is a possibility. "Some people I have trained for have offered to put up the money to go to the Breeders' Cup," Hine said. "I think it is a bad gamble, but they don't seem to think so. He did favor that track up in Canada--he set a stakes record in the Woodbine Million. Anything can happen." Cigar's trainer Bill Mott commented on the champion's second defeat in his last three starts. "The race looked as if it should play into our hands," Mott said. "I'd just be whining if I made excuses. They went the half in :47 3/5; he was four or five lengths off, well within range. He never pulled (jockey) Jerry (Bailey) out of the saddle the way he normally does. If we had to go back and do it over again, maybe Jerry would place him closer. But you can't go back. He's won some big races just like he ran this. I thought he ran a pretty darned good race." Bailey added, "I'm not as upset losing as I was the first time (when Cigar lost the Pacific Classic to Dare and Go Aug. 10). But I'm still disappointed when I lose a race. I'm looking for redemption in the Breeders' Cup."

Skip Away was looking to cement his position as the country's best three-year-old here after taking the lead in the divisional race with a win the GI Woodbine Million in his last start Sept. 15. He prompted the early pace set by Preakness winner Louis Quatorze. The pair set leisurely fractions of :24.09, :47.61 and 1:11.43 while Cigar was an unhurried third. Skip Away took a slim lead at the top of the stretch and was all out to hold off the late-charge of the reigning Horse of the Year to win by a head. "He ran the race of his life today--it was unbelievable," said winning jockey Shane Sellers of Skip Away. "To beat a horse like Cigar--he came to me at the sixteenth pole, but my horse fought hard; he dug in and just outran him." Jerry Bailey, Cigar's regular rider, said, "I ran second. I ran into a horse who ran an exceptional race. I have to tip my hat to the winner."

Diplomatic Jet captured the GI Man o' War in his last start Sept. 14. The chestnut colt was always near the leaders here, rallied around the second turn to open a three-length lead down the stretch and then just had enough left to hold off the late-closing Awad. "We're going to Toronto (to the Breeders' Cup Turf at Woodbine Oct. 26)--follow our same procedure and hope we can get the brass ring again," winning trainer James Picou said after the race.

Ordway broke his maiden at Saratoga in his second start Aug. 12 and followed that win with a distant second behind Smoke Glacken in the GI Hopeful Aug. 31. In his first start since that stakes debut, the colt rated along the rail, moved up around the turn and then bullied his way between horses in deep stretch to garner the lead and draw off. "I knew I had horse under me; I just needed some room to let him run," winning rider John Velazquez said. "Thank God, the hole opened and we went through quickly. The hole closed, but I was gone." Jerry Bailey, on GI Futurity winner Traitor, said, "He made a sweeping move turning for home. I thought I was going to win at the eighth pole." Ordway will now point for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but Traitor will pass up the championship race. "We'll put him away now and get him ready for next year," explained his trainer Mary Eppler.

Memories of Silver is unbeaten since taking to the turf for her maiden win at Belmont June 28. She followed that six-length win with a win in the Lake George S. and the Aug. 21 Gill Nijana S. The filly, rated in sixth place early here, threaded her way through the field on the turn and passed tiring pacesetter Antespend with an eighth of a mile to go. She finished a half-length in front of French invader Shake the Yoke, while setting a new course record. "Antespend was kind of getting a jump on her turning for home," explained winning rider Robbie Davis. "And I was a little concerned about her getting away. So I went after her a little bit sooner than I normally would have, but she caught her with total ease."

An extraordinary swerve from Moonax 1 1/2-furlongs out probably settled this event. Ascot Gold Cup third Nononito had taken the lead two furlongs out and had gone clear of the field, with Moonax beginning to make his challenge on the wide outside. While Nononito ran on up front, Moonax suddenly darted to his left and lost a great deal of ground. Jockey Frankie Dettori soon had Moonax racing again, but it was too late to make up the lost ground on Nononito, whose trainer Jean Lesbordes said, "Finally my horse had the ground he needed. He needs it just like this to be at his best. My dream is to win the Ascot Gold Cup and if the ground is right next year, he will have another try." Double Trigger, winner of the recent Doncaster Cup, failed in this race for the second year running. His jockey Jason Weaver said, "Double Trigger had a gap to go through, but he showed no speed on this ground and lost interest."

Savinio, winner of the GIII San Diego H. at Del Mar July 27 and most recently third in the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H., set the pace here while closely pursued by favored Alphabet Soup as Dare and Go stalked the top two. As the trio went under the wire for the first time, Alphabet Soup angled in, interfering with his two rivals. Alphabet Soup drew away from Savinio as they neared the wire the final time, but was subsequently disqualified and placed third. After the race, winning rider Corey Nakatani commented on the incident at the mile pole, "Chris (McCarron) (aboard Alphabet Soup) was riding to win and he got caught with his hand in the cookie jar. He was coming over. He got my space. In turn he was forcing me down on Dare and Go, and

taking his space. Dare and Go had to check, take-up and get out of there." Alphabet Soup and Dare and Go will now be pointed for the Breeders' Cup.

Winning trainer John Gosden said, "Annaba has always been a talented filly, but she runs too freely. She was helped greatly here by the Aga Khan's pacemaker and we must be grateful that she gave such a good lead. It made all the difference. Annaba also liked the track. It was good to soft but the horses were getting through it well. She also appreciated the extended mile and a half. I hope to keep her in training as a four-year-old, as her family have all gotten better as four-year-olds."

This was an amazing training feat from trainer John Gosden as his four-year-old Flemensfirth came back from a break of 371 days to win the race he won last year. Ridden by Frankie Dettori, Flemensfirth took the lead early in the straight and was never challenged, running out a very impressive winner. His next target is the G1 Premio Roma over 1 1/4-miles in Italy Nov. 10 and then, according to his trainer John Gosden, "He will stay in training especially for a tilt at the Dubai World Cup, which he had to miss this year because he sustained a small fracture of the near-fore cannon bone. We brought him back from that injury and had him ready for Royal Ascot, but the ground was much too firm for him. We then decided to wait until the Autumn. It was a long wait, but it was worth it."

Prescott, who said another crack at the Coronation S. is his filly's main aim for 1997, added, "She is very good, but she's fragile and you can't run her too often. I think today was the best she has ever been. But races take a lot out of her, so you have to pick your targets. She will be put away for the winter now and then come back for next season."
