HELISSIO TRIUMPHANT IN ARC Three-year-old **Helissio** (Fr) (Fairy King) did not make his first career start until March of this year, but has made up for lost time in a big way. The bay colt, owned by Spaniard Enrique Sarasola, had won five of six starts this year prior to yesterday's Arc de Triomphe bid, including the G1 Prix Lupin and G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. He maintained his near-perfect record through Europe's greatest race, upping his career total to six wins in seven starts with a wire-to-wire victory over 15 star competitors. "We had lots of offers for the horse before the race," said Sarasola. "I am very happy; it was a fantastic moment. He will not race again this season, but I am hoping he will be back to win this race again next year." Winning trainer Elie Lellouche said, "It's a big joy and a big relief to win the race. Everything went according to what we expected and planned. Helissio is a true, genuine champion, but you never know until you prove your point." Winning rider Olivier Peslier said, "I really had an easy ride. I never saw anything else in the straight. I thought we'd gone around alone after a false start! I kept looking back and never saw anything." Helissio ran past his breeding in winning the 1 1/2-mile Arc, as the average winning distance of Fairy King's progeny is only 7.2 furlongs. G1 Ascot Gold Cup winner **Classic Cliche** (Ire) (Salse) ran disappointingly to finish last of the 15 finishers and Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford said, "He was not the horse we know him to be today. We'll make a decision in the next few days about whether he goes to the Melbourne Cup and then stays in training next year or not." Jockey Frankie Dettori said the four-year-old ran "completely flat." G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. winner **Pentire** (GB) (Be My Guest) was also a great disappointment and his trainer Geoffrey Wragg said, "He's come back as if he's never had a race at all," while jockey Michael Hills said, "He broke slowly, got back into the race, but once in the straight he didn't fire. I don't think he found his usual action, probably affected by the soft ground." Pat Eddery rode Epsom Derby winner **Shaamit** (Ire) (Mtoto {GB}), who finished seventh yesterday, and said, "He ran well to halfway up the straight and then got tired." Jockey Michael Kinane said of **Zagreb** (Theatrical {Ire}), who had not raced since taking the Irish Derby June 30, "I was delighted with his race. He had a great trip, but he had not run for so long and definitely needed the race."

A sixth win from seven lifetime starts for Helissio, who gave his Spanish owner Enrique Sarasola, trainer Elie Lellouche and jockey Olivier Peslier their first victories in Europe's great race, which was being run for the 75th time. Peslier sent Helissio straight to the front from the gate and he was always travelling well, leading from PILSUDSKI, ZAGREB (Theatrical {Ire}), CLASSIC CLICHE (IRE) (Salse) and SHAAMIT (IRE) (Mtoto {GB}). A half-mile out, Helissio still led from Pilsudski, Zagreb and Classic Cliche. On the turn into the straight, Helissio quickened brilliantly and soon went clear of the field, while Pilsudski battled on well to hold second from the fast-finishing Irish challenger Oscar Schindler, who had to weave his way through from the rear of the field. Andre Fabre's pair SWAIN (IRE) (Nashwan) and LUNA WELLS (IRE) (Sadler's Wells) finished well for fourth and fifth. The race was marred by the death of last year's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud winner POLARIS FLIGHT (Northern Flagship). The three-year-old was pulled up after breaking a leg two furlongs out and was humanely destroyed.

CIGAR UNDAUNTED BY DEFEAT The first thing Cigar (Palace Music) did upon returning to his barn Saturday after his second-place finish to **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) in the \$1 million Jockey Club Gold Cup was eat a peppermint candy. "Actually, more than one," said trainer Bill Mott's assistant, Simon Bray. "He was not despondent at all, not like he was after (being defeated in the Aug. 10 Pacific Classic) at Del Mar, maybe because he caught Skip Away two jumps after the wire and galloped out in front of him after the race." Bray added that physically, Cigar came out of the Gold Cup "in great shape. He is fine. No problem. Tentative plans call for Cigar to be flown to Toronto a week before the Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup Classic. That's tentative--a lot will depend on the weather. If it's raining up there, Bill will train him down here up to the race." Meanwhile, the question of whether Skip Away, who is not Breeders' Cup eligible, will be supplemented to the Classic is still up in the air. "We might have a small chance of getting Horse of the Year if we beat Cigar again in the Breeders' Cup, but Cigar has done a lot, going to Dubai and all, and I think there is always a bias for New York horses," said Skip Away's trainer Sonny Hine. "I don't know if it's worth \$480,000 to try to beat Cigar again. But I do think we would have an even better chance of beating him in Canada than we did here. My horse loves that track."

Looking to extend her unbeaten streak, the chestnut filly made a run from just off the pace at the top of the stretch to wear down her pacesetter Top Secret. "I thought I had relatively easy pickings turning for home, but that filly (Top Secret) accelerated nicely when Joe (Bravo) asked her, and I had to work to get by her," jockey Chris McCarron explained after the race. "Once she had her though, it was pretty much all over.

Different's a very good filly." Last year's Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **GOLDEN ATTRACTION** (Mr. Prospector) was scratched from the race with a bruised foot suffered during her winning effort in the Sept. 21 Turfway Breeders' Cup S., but will continue to be aimed for the Breeders' Cup Distaff.

Champion Serena's Song again led the field into the stretch with Yanks Music within pouncing distance. Serena's Song held on gamely, but Yanks Music was able to get by her to record her third straight win. "Serena's Song looked very tough at the end of the lane," winning trainer Leo O'Brien said. "But at the eighth pole Yanks Music kicked on." O'Brien indicated that Yanks Music may be pre-entered in the Breeders' Cup Classic. "It breaks your heart when they run that hard and lose," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said of the hard-knocking Serena's Song. "It was one hell of an effort." Serena's Song will run next in the Breeders' Cup Distaff.

GII Adirondack winner Storm Song injured an ankle in her sixth-place finish in the GI Spinaway, but returned to run second in the GI Matron Sept. 15. in her last start. Matron heroine Sharp Cat jumped out to the early lead, while Storm Song settled back into third. Storm Song began to challenge the favorite on the turn and drew clear in the final furlong. "She's been improving and she's already been running well against the big fillies," jockey Craig Perret said after the race. "She improved off the last race and generally good horses do that." Both of the top two fillies are scheduled to go on to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Woodbine Oct. 26.

Jockey Chris Antley straightened Bon Point out and the bay finished in front, but was disqualified and placed fifth following in the footsteps of Alphabet Soup in Saturday's GII Goodwood H. and original third-place finisher Criollito in the GIII Ancient Title Breeders' Cup earlier Sunday. The benefactor of the disqualification here was Admise, the lone filly in the field, who won the Honey Fox H. and Matching H. at Del Mar in her last two starts. The gray filly rallied from last in the field of five to outrun Khoraz down to the wire.

DISSERTATION (FR) (Sillery) set a good pace, with Yashmak and Ryafan following. On the turn into the straight, Dissertation still led, but was soon collared by Yashmak, with Ryafan closing on the outside. The two Abdullah runners fought out the finish, with Frankie Dettori and Ryafan gaining command close to home, while Irish challenger Family Tradition finished well to be third and the previously undefeated BIANCA NERA (GB) (Salse) just got up to get fourth. Bookmakers reacted by quoting Ryafan and Yashmak as 7/1 shots for next year's 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Winning trainer John Gosden said, "We've seen two nice fillies battling out the finish. Both must be good to draw away from the field like they did. I must pay tribute to Pat Eddery, who rode Ryafan when she ran last time in Ireland. He told me she would be better stretched out to a mile. He then chose to ride Yashmak, but he took the defeat in good spirit. Ryafan likes it soft and while I don't think she will stay a mile and a half, she should get a mile and a quarter, so we'll plan a French campaign for her, going for the Poule d'Essai des Poulisches (French 1000 Guineas) and the Prix de Diane (French Oaks), which is over a mile and a quarter."

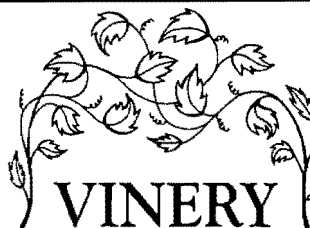
