WOODMAN COLT BRINGS \$1.9 MILLION AT GOFFS IRELAND

Goffs' three-day 1996 Irish National Yearling Sale began on a high note Tuesday when a chestnut colt by Woodman brought a top price of \$1,906,780. Purchased by D.L. O'Byrne, agent, the colt is out of Danse Royale (Ire) (Caerleon), a GSW in France who was also third in the Irish 1,000 Guineas. Tuesday's session turned out to be a family affair, as the second highest-priced offering at \$932,203 was a colt by Last Tycoon (Ire)--Flame of Tara (Ire) (Artaius). Flame of Tara is the dam of Danse Royale, whose Woodman colt topped the session. Purchased by Shadwell Estate Co. Ltd., the Last Tycoon colt is a half-brother to Salsabil (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), winner of the British 1,000 Guineas and the Irish Derby against colts, and a full-brother to G1 St. James's Palace House S. winner Marju (Ire). The day's third highest price of \$451,977 was paid by J.T. Doyle, Esq. for a filly by Last Tycoon (Ire)--Fair of the Furze (Ire) (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}). The filly is a half-sister to G1 Derby Italiano winner and Arc de Triomphe runner-up White Muzzle (GB) (Dancing Brave). Overall, 131 yearlings were sold Tuesday for a gross of \$14,438,136 and an average of \$110,214. The sale continues through Thursday.

HELISSIO'S OWNER TURNS DOWN \$25

MILLION OFFER Enrique Sarasola, who turned down two bids of \$8 million each for Helissio (Fr) (Fairy King) prior to the three-year-old colt's win in Sunday's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, Monday refused yet another offer worth \$25 million, according to yesterday's *Racing Post*. However, Sarasola is considering selling a 50 percent interest in Helissio with a provision that the colt must continue to race through 1997. "We're up to something like \$25 million at the moment but no deal has been struck," said Sarasola's Racing Manager Bruno Ridoux. "Interest has been shown by Coolmore, Teruya Yoshida and Marc de Chambure's Haras d'Etream."

MEADOWLANDS, PHILLY PARK CANCEL

TUESDAY RACING With the remnants of Hurricane Josephine racing up the East Coast, Meadowlands Race-track canceled live racing for Tuesday night, Oct. 8. The track, however, remained open for day and night simulcasting. "With the anticipation of continued heavy rains accompanied by dangerously high winds, we felt the prudent decision was to cancel for the safety to the horses and jockeys," said Vice President for Thoroughbred Racing Robert J. Kulina. Live racing will resume at the Meadowlands Wednesday night, with the first post at 7:30 p.m. Also cancelling Tuesday's card was Philadelphia Park, which experienced a power outage.

MARKOFDISTINCTION DEAD

Markofdistinction (GB) (Known Fact) has died in Japan from a bout of colic, according to yesterday's *The Sporting Life*. The 10-year-old stallion won five of 12 starts during his racing career, including the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S., G2 Queen Anne S. and G2 Trusthouse Forte Mile--all in 1990--for earnings of \$677,420. Bought for stud duty by the Japan Racing Association, Markofdistinction stood for six years in Japan and has sired 44 winners from 73 runners, including four Group stakes winners. He was also the horse who gave champion jockey Frankie Dettori his first Group 1 win. "He was my first Royal Ascot winner and gave me my first Group 2 win as well as that first Group 1," said Dettori. "He was a horse with a tremendous turn of foot and we had some wonderful times together."

OBS FALL MIXED SALE RESULTS

Note of Desire, a three-year-old mare by Woodman--Yanuka (Ire) (Pitcairn) in foal to millionaire Kissin Kris, topped Monday's preferred session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales 1996 Fall Mixed Sale. Consigned by Summerfield, agent, the bay mare, a half-sister to MGSW Dilum (Tasso), was purchased for \$60,000 by Buzz Chace, agent for Leonard Pivnick's Aliyuee Ben J. Stable. There were 233 horses sold Monday for a gross of \$1,806,000 and an average of \$7,752, down 26.8% from last year's preferred session average of \$10,590. "Good-looking weanlings and mares with quality pedigrees demanded top prices," said Tom Ventura, director of sales. "The market remains difficult at the lower end for breeding stock." The open portion of the sale began Tuesday, with 182 horses selling for a gross of \$665,500 and an average of \$3,657, down 18.7% from last year's corresponding session average of \$4,496. Tuesday's highest price of \$38,000 was paid by Pegasus Stud for **Summer Cocktail**, an unraced three-year-old mare by Dr. Blum--La Mimosa (Bold Forbes). The mare, in foal to Defrere, was consigned by Eddie Woods, agent. The sale's third and final session will be held today.

PUTRA OUT UNTIL 1997 Putra (Dixie Brass), unbeaten winner of the G3 Lanson Champagne Vintage S. at Goodwood July 31 and currently third-favorite for next year's 2000 Guineas, will miss the rest of this season because of a bout of coughing. Paul Cole, the two-year-old colt's trainer, had been aiming to close his charge's juvenile campaign in the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket Oct. 18. But, after discovering the chestnut has an infection which has now been running four days, all plans for another run are on hold until 1997.

WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

PEDIGREE SHORTS...

Sadler's Wells' brother, Fairy King, is rapidly compiling a very impressive record of his own, and in Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero **Helissio** (c, 3, Fairy King--**Helice**, by **Slewpy**) he has sired a truly outstanding middle-distance horse. Helissio's pedigree is a real outcross, the only duplication within the first six generations being a 4x6 cross of Hail to Reason, but the background is certainly not devoid of interest. Travel down the female line to the third dam, Hermanville, and we find she is a daughter of Cutlass. Gambetta, the granddam of Cutlass, is by My Babu out of Rough Shod II, which makes her a half-sister to Thong, the granddam of Fairy Bridge. Since My Babu is out of Perfume II, a close relative to Nasrullah, and Thong is by Nasrullah's son Nantallah, the relationship is actually a little closer than that. Rough Shod II is out of the famous tap-root mare, Dalmary, and Dalmary's half-sister Carpet Slipper is third dam of Val de Loir, who is also in Helissio's pedigree through his son Val de l'Orne (sire of Helissio's second dam).

We mentioned last week that Miswaki has two group/graded stakes winners with Targowice in the pedigree of the dam (Targowice being a very close genetic relative to Miswaki's granddam Rose Bower). Well, now there are two group/grade one winners by Miswaki with Targowice in the dam. Last weekend **Daylight Come** (f, 3, Miswaki--Lady Winner, by **Fabulous Dancer**) captured a Canadian grade one event, and on Sunday, **Kistena** (f, 3, Miswaki--Mabrova, by **Prince Mab**) defeated the brilliant Anabaa to take Europe's premier sprint, the Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp. Prince Mab is a son of Targowice, so Targowice and Rose Bower appear 3x3 here.

There are no prizes for ignoring the obvious and it is obvious that daughters of Graustark and His Majesty from the Sunny Vale family work very well with Roberto, the combination producing such superior runners as Dynaformer, Brian's Time and Sunshine Forever. This clearly didn't escape the notice of Juddmonte Farm, who sent Carya, by Northern Dancer out of a sister to the dam of Sunshine Forever, to Lear Fan, a son of Roberto. The result, **Ryafan** (f, 2, Lear Fan--Carya, by Northern Dancer), narrowly overcame another Juddmonte-bred, **Yashmak** (f, 2, Danzig--Slightly Dangerous, by Roberto) to take the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp Sunday.
