QUEST FOR FAME GETS FIRST STAKES

WINNER Shuttle stallion **Quest For Fame (GB)** (Rainbow Quest) sired his first stakes winner last weekend when his juvenile colt **Hockney**, owned by Jack and Bob Ingham's Woodlands Stud and trained by John Hawkes, won the Listed AJC Canonbury S. over five furlongs at Randwick in Sydney, Australia. **Noise**, the Epsom Derby winner's first starter in Australia, was runner-up in the Listed AJC Breeders' Plate earlier in the week. Both performances have surprised the breeding experts, who expected the stallion's progeny to need time and distance to be at their best. Woodlands Stud owns a 50 percent interest in Quest For Fame with Gainesway Farm in Kentucky.

FOXHOUND TO HILL 'N' DALE

Foxhound (Danzig), who stood the 1996 season at Coolmore Stud in Ireland, has been purchased by Hill 'n' Dale Farm and will begin stud duties next year at the Lexington, Kentucky farm. A stakes winner at two in France, he went on to place in three G3 stakes. Foxhound's dam, Lassie Dear, produced Weekend Surprise, the dam of Summer Squall, Honor Grades and A.P. Indy. "We initially purchased an interest in Foxhound when he retired to Coolmore Stud in 1996," said John Sikura. "With the success in the U.S. of Summer Squall and Honor Grades from Foxhound's immediate family, we increased our stake in the stallion and decided to bring him over here." Foxhound, who was bred to more than 90 mares this year, will stand for \$4,000, live foal.

AMERICAN DAY TO STAND AT MARGAUX

Graded stakes-placed **American Day** (Nureyev), who broke his maiden by 13 lengths on the turf at Hollywood Park, has been retired and is scheduled to stand the 1997 season at Margaux Farm in Midway, Kentucky. At three, he was third in the GIII El Camino Real Derby and won a one-mile allowance on the main track at Santa Anita. The half-brother to MGISW Best Pal will stand as the property of Golden Eagle Farm for \$3,000, live foal.

Unlucky to suffer her first career loss when second after a rough trip in the Ellis Park Debutante two starts back, Southern Playgirl bounced back to capture the GII Arlington-Washington Lassie by a neck in her most recent outing. Sent off the crowd's choice to take another here, the chestnut sat just off the pace to the far turn before taking command and drawing away down the stretch. "She's special," said jockey Randy Romero. "When I called on her she went to running, but after she made the lead she just pulled up and waited. She needs competition--she waits on horses. But if one would have come, she would have gone on again." The filly could make her next start in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Woodbine October 26, and Romero added, "You haven't seen her best race because she waits on horses. There's a lot more there that I don't even know about." Original runner-up Private Pursuit came out for running room at the sixteenth pole and bumped Screamer; she was disqualified and placed third for the infraction. "My filly's coordination just hasn't caught up with her size yet," said Pat Day aboard Private Pursuit.

VIRGINIA HORSEMEN SIGN CONTRACT WITH COLONIAL DOWNS

After a one-month delay, Colonial Downs and the Virginia chapter of the Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association have signed a \$4.5 million purse account contract. The contract had been delayed by a suit filed by two Northern Virginia horsemen, James Casey and Hazel March, but Circuit Judge Thomas D. Horne denied their request for an injunction in a ruling handed down October 2, stating that the two had failed to substantiate their claim that the agreement would cause them financial harm. Colonial Downs' Jeff Jacobs negotiated the agreement, which calls for 5.25 percent of all wagers placed on simulcast races at Virginia's Satellite Wagering Facilities, retroactive to the opening of the first site last February, to accrue in the purse account. Colonial Downs, when filing its 1997 racing schedule with the Virginia Racing Commission, declared a plan that will offer Thoroughbred purses of \$150,000 per day.

HEART LAKE TO JAPAN

According to yesterday's *The Sporting Life*, Heart Lake (GB) (Nureyev) has been purchased by Teruya Yoshida and will stand the 1997 breeding season at Shadai Stallion Station in Japan. The five-year-old earned the majority of his more than \$1.8 million career bankroll in Japan, taking both the 1995 G1 Yasuda Kinen and G1 Keio Hai Spring Cup there last May. Heart Lake made his final start in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood July 31, finishing a disappointing ninth, and retires with a record of six wins from 17 starts. He is expected to ship to the Hokkaido stud at the end of October.

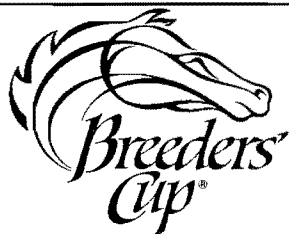
