SKIP AWAY HEADED FOR BREEDERS' CUP

Trainer Sonny Hine has decided to take on the reigning Horse of the Year once more in a quest to dethrone him; Hine's three-year-old **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), who bested **Cigar** (Palace Music) by a diminishing head in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup October 5, will face the champ once again in the Breeders' Cup Classic at Woodbine October 26. The colt, who runs in the colors of Hine's wife, Carolyn, will be supplemented to the race at the cost of \$480,000; the first installment of \$160,000 is due Tuesday, when pre-entries for racing's championship day are taken. "We're going to chase it," said Hine from his barn at Keeneland yesterday. "The horse is doing so darn good and I've been getting wisdom from everyone. Other trainers have told me 'you'll always regret it if you don't go--you might not ever get the this chance again.'" Carolyn Hine added, "I think what's most important to me is to be Horse of the Year. He deserves it; he's earned everything he's ever gotten." But even a Classic victory by Skip Away may not be enough to overshadow Cigar's accomplishments, including his dramatic triumph in Dubai, this year; still, the title is likely to be won--or lost--at Woodbine.

GOFFS IRISH NATIONAL YEARLING SALE

POSTS MAJOR GAINS Goffs' Irish National Yearling Sale ended Thursday with 554 yearlings sold during the sale's three sessions for a gross of \$38,937,297 and an average of \$70,285, up 62 percent from last year's average of \$43,366. Three yearlings brought \$92,282 each to top Thursday's third and final session. The first, a colt by Treasure Kay (GB)--Pipe Opener (GB) (Prince Sabo {GB}), was purchased by Mr. David Hanley. The second, a dark bay colt by St. Jovite--Scissors (Blade), was bought by Horse France Ire. Ltd. The third, a filly by Second Set (Ire)--Stanerra's Wish (Ire) (Caerleon), was purchased by Silky Green Inc.

Boston Harbor had dominated in his last two starts, winning the Ellis Park Juvenile by six lengths and the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile by seven, but had to work a little harder to pick up his third straight stakes score. The speedy colt once again jumped out to the lead at the start but was pressed by 40-1 outsider **STARKE BOUY** (Ferdinand) for the first half, then was joined by Florida invader **Blazing Sword**, who took the lead for a few strides at the sixteenth pole but was turned back as the crowd's choice prevailed in a close finish. "He wasn't going to really extend himself until the other horse got to him," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey of Boston Harbor. "Most horses will run on, even if they're waiting on horses, as soon as another horse comes to their flank. But this horse waited until (**Blazing Sword**) got all the way up to his eyeball. And then he looked over and saw it was time to start running again. I'm glad I had the opportunity to ride him now, before the big race (Breeders' Cup Juvenile October 26). I think I learned a lot." The victory earns Boston Harbor the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund's \$1 million bonus for sweeping this race as well as the GIII Bashford Manor, Ellis Park Juvenile and GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile. The runner-up, winner of the first two legs of the Florida Stallion Series, missed sweeping that triple when third by a neck in the final race last time out. "I thought I had (Boston Harbor) at one point," said his jockey, Willie Martinez. "But he saw my horse and took off again. My horse put up a fight."

MIXED RESULTS FOR TURFWAY FALL MEET

The 1996 Fall Meet at Turfway Park concluded last Friday, October 4, with varied results. The 10th anniversary fall season paid record purses of \$6,317,980, an increase of 24.5 percent from 1995. The average daily purse distribution of \$274,695 was also an all-time high, up 24.5 percent from a year ago. The track offered the second highest purse structure in the country, behind only Belmont Park, during the 23-day meeting. The total handle, \$80,727,568, was also up from 1995, rising 13.9 percent; out-of-state sources taking the Turfway signal accounted for \$39,440,154 of that total, an increase of 58 percent from last year. But wagering throughout the state of Kentucky dropped 6 percent to \$26,636,498 in 1996, while on-track handle slipped 16.7 percent to \$14,650,916 this year. Total on-track attendance was also off, dropping 22.9 percent as 71,989 patrons visited the track this season.

"Turfway's Fall Meet offered the best racing this track has ever produced," said President Mark Simendinger. "Unfortunately, our on-track figures slumped during the meet, but that was expected. With Ohio now providing full-card simulcasting, people in the northern suburbs of Cincinnati have an option of where to go to wager their dollars. I think it is obvious we need to continue looking for ways to improve Turfway, and for ways to attract fans to our facility."

U.S. HORSES NOMINATED TO JAPAN CUP A

total of 17 U.S.-based horses have been nominated to the 1996 Japan Cup, to be run Nov. 24 at Tokyo Racecourse. The \$3,286,296 event is for three-year-olds and up at 1 1/2-miles on the turf. The U.S. nominees are **Admise (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}), **Android (Riverman)**, **Awad (Caveat)**, **Blumin Affair (Dynaformer)**, **Celtic Arms (Fr)** (Comrade in Arms {GB}), **Dare and Go (Alydar)**, **Dernier Empereur (Tremolino)**, **Diplomatic Jet (Roman Diplomat)**, **Flag Down (Deputy Minister)**, **Miss Caerleona (Fr)** (Caerleon), **Montjoy (Manila)**, **Ops Smile (Caveat)**, **Talloires (Tremolino)**, **Time Star (Manila)**, **Urgent Request (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest), **Windsharp (Lear Fan)** and **Volochine (Ire)** (Soviet Star). In addition, one Canadian-based horse, **Chief Bearhart (Chief's Crown)**, was nominated. Other Group 1-winning nominees from around the world include **Definite Article (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), **Oscar Schindler (Ire)** (Royal Academy) and **Zagreb (Theatrical {Ire})** from Ireland; **Swain (Ire)** (Nashwan) and **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King) from France; **Halling (Diesis {GB})**, **Singspiel (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}), **Glory of Dancer (Shareef Dancer)**, **Luso (GB)** (Salse) and **Strategic Choice (Alleged)** from Great Britain; and **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) from Australia.

PENTIRE TO JAPAN CUP Pentire (GB) (Be My Guest), winner of this year's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot, will have his last run before going to stud in the Japan Cup Nov. 24. The four-year-old was purchased by the Yoshida family earlier this year and is to stand at their Japanese base beginning next season. Geoff Wragg, who trains Pentire at Newmarket, does not feel the bay's disappointing 10th-place finish in last Sunday's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe should have any relevance for his next outing. The handler insisted, "The Arc was a nonentity of a race for him. He gave away ground at the start and you can't afford to do that at Longchamp. He never had position."

Entries are limited to three per entrant in the television, radio and photography categories, and two per entrant in newspaper and magazine writing. The Eclipse Awards will be presented at the 26th annual Eclipse Awards Dinner Feb. 4, 1997 at the Sheraton Bal Harbour Hotel in Bal Harbour, Florida.

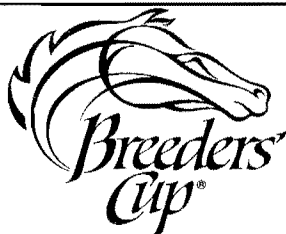
