FLORIDA DRUG TESTING UNDER REVIEW The Chief Inspector General's Office for the state of Florida is conducting an investigation into the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering's drug testing lab and its alleged use of outdated Elisa tests. The Inspector General's Office, which handles complaints against state agencies for Governor Lawton Chiles, became aware of the allegations concerning the use of outdated testing materials after two chemists who work in the lab alerted officials outside the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering. The whistle-blowers, whose names are being withheld by the state, said employees were told to ignore expiration dates on testing kits to save money, and that the tests for drugs in the urine and blood of horses and greyhounds may have been mishandled for as many as eight years. Sources in the governor's office said the investigation is focusing on the qualifications of the division's management, the use of expired testing materials and alleged falsification of test data. Some lab employees have told state investigators they can't vouch for the accuracy of their work because of the expired materials. Deborah Miller, director of the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering for the past 21 months, was unavailable for comment.

FEEES FOR TOP STALLIONS ON THE RISE **Rainbow Quest** (Blushing Groom {Fr}), Europe's leading sire of group winners in 1995, will have his stud fee hiked by one-third for 1997, according to a report in today's *Daily Racing Form*. The 15-year-old stallion, who resides at Banstead Manor Stud in Newmarket, England, will stand for a fee of approximately \$62,000, up from about \$47,000 in 1996. The *Form* reported that the fees for two top American sires will increase next year as well. **Mt. Livermore** (Blushing Groom {Fr}), who stood for \$30,000 in 1996, will see his fee rise to \$50,000, while **Broad Brush** (Ack Ack), who stood for \$25,000 last year, will have his fee increased to \$40,000. Both stallions stand at Gainesway in Lexington, Kentucky.

Chelsey Flower, a fast-closing fourth after a troubled trip in the GII Diana H. at Saratoga last time she ran, enjoyed clear sailing on the front end in this affair. Showing uncharacteristic early foot, the Kentucky-bred bay set a moderate pace through fractions of :50.52 and 1:15.61, opened it up at the top of the stretch and cruised home, easily holding the rallying Powder Bowl safe in the drive to the wire to earn her second graded win over this course this year. "She deserved it," said trainer Nick Zito. "If you see the charts from her recent races, you'll see all the trouble she's had. I said to Robbie (Davis) today, 'don't waste any time; go to the lead. If they catch her, they catch her.' This is a different filly--she's more relaxed now; she's professional." The winner of the GII Sheepshead Bay H. in July, Chelsey Flower may be headed to California and the barn of trainer Bill Spawr. "There's more (races) for her out there than in Florida," said Zito. Favored AMPULLA (Chief's Crown) pressed the pace but faded in the drive and finished eighth.
