**HINE HOSPITALIZED; CLASSIC BID ON HOLD** Trainer Sonny Hine was admitted to St. Joseph Hospital Saturday afternoon after suffering severe abdominal pain. "They think it's a kidney stone," said his assistant, Pete Johnson, yesterday morning. "They're running tests on him. A specialist is coming (Sunday) afternoon." With Hine in the hospital, his star three-year-old **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) missed his scheduled six-furlong breeze yesterday and the colt will not work until his trainer is back at the barn, which puts his Breeders' Cup Classic bid in jeopardy. Even before going to St. Joseph Saturday, Hine told the *Asbury Park Press*, "The way I feel now, I'm not going anywhere... and that horse goes nowhere without me."

Robert Sangster's colt Revoque won his second Group One juvenile event in France within a month here, establishing himself as a serious contender for next season's 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Fellow English contender REFERENDUM (IRE) (Common Grounds {GB}) led the field, but John Reid had Revoque settled well in behind the leader and with two furlongs to race, the winner was sent to the front; he ran on well to hold the challenge of Majorien. Reid said: "I was always traveling really well. When I asked him to quicken, his response was immediate." Revoque's trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam said: "This win makes Revoque the best two-year-old in Europe. He won't run again this year and he may go straight to the 2000 Guineas next season, as he is a very handy type." Bookmakers William Hill have cut Revoque's odds for the 2000 Guineas from 10-1 to 7-1 after this easy victory.

CONCEPCION (GER) (Acatenango {Ger}) and CORAL REEF (ITY) (Big Reef {Ire}) led the field here, with Strategic Choice just behind. Early in the straight Strategic Choice took the lead, but Dettori then brought Shantou from the rear and Sheikh Mohammed's colt swept away for an easy success from the fast-finishing Sacrament. Dettori said: "It was a very easy job. The horse was flying. Mr. Gosden said that if he had an easy race here, he might next run him in the French St. Leger (Prix Royal-Oak, Oct. 27 at Longchamp)."

**HAWTHORNE OPENS TODAY** Thoroughbred racing returns to Illinois' Hawthorne today, October 14 for a 67-day meeting that runs through December 31. Daily purse distribution for the meet, including stakes, will start at \$180,000. The opening-day card features the \$100,000-added Valnor Breeders' Cup S. for fillies and mares going a mile on the grass, the first of 23 stakes events scheduled for the season. The highlight of the track's stakes program will be the 60th running of the \$300,000 GII Hawthorne Gold Cup, which is set for November 16, and the \$200,000 GIII Hawthorne Derby, to be run October 19. "I'm excited about the upcoming season," said Hawthorne President Thomas F. Carey. "Our horse population is solid in number and quality, and the strong daily purse structure reflects our commitment to the Illinois horsemen." A total of 13 Illinois-bred stakes will be offered, including the six races of the Phil Georgeff Illinois Festival of Racing, to be held November 9. Hawthorne will be open for live racing Wednesdays through Mondays, with full-card simulcasting only on Tuesdays. Post time is set for 1:00 p.m. daily with the exception of Breeders' Cup Day, Oct. 26; Thanksgiving, Nov. 28; and closing day, Dec. 31, when first post will be 10:30 a.m. There is no racing Christmas Day.

Apprentice jockey Phil Teator rode his first career winner at Belmont yesterday, guiding **Rice** (Blushing John) to a 10-length victory for trainer Bill Mott in the day's fifth race. "It's just a fabulous feeling," said Teator, 18, who graduated from Ichabod Crane High School in upstate New York this year. "There's nothing like it in the whole world. I broke on top; I wanted to get him to the lead because he's a hard horse to rate... turning for home, I just turned him loose and he opened up. At the eighth pole, I was saying to myself, 'where is everybody?' Mr. Mott has given me a great chance and I owe him an awful lot."
