WILL'S WAY SHARP AT WOODBINE Travers winner **Will's Way** (Easy Goer) drilled a mile in 1:39 4/5 over the Woodbine main track yesterday and is right on target for the \$4 million Breeders' Cup Classic October 26. With regular rider Jorge Chavez in the irons, the colt breezed through fractions of :24, :48 and 1:12 3/5; he went out the nine furlongs in 1:53 4/5. "He handled the course nicely," said trainer Jim Bond. "He went a little quick the early part--he was anxious, sharp--but he settled down and everything looks good right now. He galloped out strong. We were looking for a stiff work and we got it. Hopefully, he comes out of the work well and we can go ahead and pre-enter, but we won't count our chickens before they're hatched." If all is well, the three-year-old will blow out next Monday or Tuesday.

AQUEDUCT STAKES SCHEDULE SET A schedule of 42 stakes worth \$3,840,000 has been set by the New York Racing Association for its 1997 winter/spring meeting at Aqueduct. Changes in the announced stakes schedule come as a result of a nine-day increase over the 1997 calendar at Aqueduct's spring stand. Turf stakes such as the GIII Fort Marcy H. (May 10) and GIII Beaugay H. (May 11) will be run later in the meet than usual and the GI Carter H. (May 4), GII Withers (May 3) and GIII Vagrancy (April 27) will be contested at the Big A instead of at Belmont Park. "Running these two turf stakes later in May as opposed to their usual April dates affords us a better chance to have the weather on our side," said Aqueduct's Racing Secretary Michael S. Lakow. "And moving quality races such as the Carter, Withers and Vagrancy to Aqueduct strengthens its already solid stakes schedule. In fact, with the Withers now a full two weeks before the Preakness, it will give trainers a little more time if they would like to use the Withers as a prep." Other highlights of the stakes schedule include the GII \$100,000a Distaff H. March 15, GII \$200,000 Gotham March 29, GII \$500,000 Wood Memorial April 12 and GII \$200,000 Excelsior Breeders' Cup H. April 26.

Sixieme Sens, winner of a listed stake at Longchamp in May, 1995, was brought to the U.S. for her four-year-old campaign. The dark bay, second in the \$100,000 Hanshin H. over the Arlington Park turf in her last outing Aug. 25, was sent off the 6-5 favorite here and did not disappoint. Ridden for the first time by Jerry Bailey, she rallied from last to first in the seven-horse field to win her first U.S. stake by two lengths. "I was a little concerned about the soft turf, but she kicked in real good today," said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "She'll go back to California now. There's a stake for her in two or three weeks (the \$100,000 Louis R. Rowan H. Oct. 26) going one mile on the turf."

FASIG-TIPTON ANNOUNCES FALL MIXED SALE CATALOGUE Fasig-Tipton has catalogued 735 horses for its Fall Mixed Sale at Newtown Paddocks in Lexington, Kentucky November 8, 9 and 10, 1996. It is the biggest catalogue put together by the company since 1989. The sale opens with Book I Friday and Saturday, 490 broodmares and weanlings, with sessions beginning at 10 a.m. During Saturday afternoon, Arthur Appleton's Bridlewood Farm will offer a mixed reduction of Thoroughbreds, including several mares in foal to Skip Trial, sire of leading three-year-old Skip Away. Book II contains selected weanlings and broodmares. The selected portion of the sale gets underway at approximately 5 p.m. Saturday and at 7:30 p.m. Sunday evening. Among the weanlings are colts by leading sires Seattle Slew and Seeking the Gold and a colt from the first crop of Horse of the Year Holy Bull. Covering sires of selected broodmares include Holy Bull, Capote, Kingmambo, Quest For Fame (GB) and Unbridled. Catalogues will be mailed Oct. 18 and will be available from Fasig-Tipton offices Monday, Oct. 21.

MISWAKI COLT TOPS FASIG-TIPTON SALE The sales topper at yesterday's first session of the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Fall Yearling Sale was a bay colt by Miswaki out of the stakes-winning Icecapade mare Cool Slate. Consigned by Blanford Stud, Padraig Campeon, agent, the colt was bought for \$60,000 by Heatherway Inc., agent. In all, 175 horses were sold for a total of \$1,656,400. The average sale price of \$9,465 marked an increase of 20 percent from the 1995 figure. Last year, in a one-day format, 272 horses were sold for an aggregate of \$2,137,800 and an average of \$7,860. The sale continues today in Lexington.

TATTERSALLS HORSES IN TRAINING SALE ITS LARGEST EVER The world's biggest horses in training sale, the Tattersalls Autumn Sale, is larger than ever this year. With 1162 horses catalogued, the sale runs from Monday, Oct. 28 to Thursday, Oct. 31 and will be immediately followed by the auction of 103 yearlings. In 1996 alone, the Autumn Horses in Training Sale has produced Classic, Group and Listed winners in Britain, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Norway, Sweden and the U.S. as well as the first three home in this year's Champion Hurdle at Cheltenham. FOREST WILDCAT TO SETTLE DOWN AT BROOKDALE Multiple graded stakes winner **Forest Wildcat** (Storm Cat) has been retired to Fred Seitz's Brookdale Farm, near Versailles, Kentucky, following his wire-to-wire win in Keeneland's \$150,000 Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. Sunday. The 5-year-old won five of his seven 1996 starts, including the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H. and the GIII Finger Lakes Breeders' Cup S., and twice equaled Pimlico's six-furlong stakes record. Forest Wildcat started 20 times, winning nine races and earning \$478,860. He enters stud as the property of a partnership and will stand for \$10,000, live foal. Brookdale also announced stud fees for two recently acquired stallions. **Double Negative** (Mr. Prospector) will stand for \$5,000, live foal and **With Approval** (Caro {Ire}) will stand for \$7,500, live foal.

DIFFERENT DEFINITE FOR BREEDERS' CUP **Different** (Arg) (Candy Stripes) will be supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Distaff at a cost of \$200,000, owner Sid Craig confirmed yesterday. "It's not a good deal from a business point of view," he said, "but you can enhance the value of your horse by winning it." Different, the latest Argentine sensation trained by Ron McAnally, master of Distaff and Eclipse winners **Bayakoa** (Arg) (Consultant's Bid) and **Paseana** (Arg) (Ahmad {Arg}), is four-for-four in the U.S. with Grade I wins on both turf and dirt. She picked up her most recent victory with an impressive effort in the GI Three Chimneys Spinster at Keeneland October 6.

DUBAI CHAMPION S.-G1, 3yo/up, 10fT

Halling (Diesis {GB}), unbeaten since his flop behind Cigar in the Dubai World Cup in March, looks certain to start favorite, but the Godolphin-trained five-year-old, already winner this year of the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown and York's G1 International S., will face a stiff test in this 10-furlong event. **Bosra Sham** (Woodman), heroine of the 1000 Guineas in May, delighted her connections with a workout at the weekend and trainer Henry Cecil confirmed: "I couldn't be happier with her." The British trainer's championship, in which Cecil and Godolphin's Saeed bin Suroor are currently closely matched on prize-money won this season, looks virtually certain to be resolved by this weekend's result. Likely French champion jockey Olivier Peslier is set to continue

his already productive association with **Glory Of Dancer (GB)** (Shareef Dancer) in Saturday's event. The 23-year-old rider partnered the colt when capturing Italy's G1 Gran Criterium at Milan last November, and has also been on board Glory Of Dancer on four occasions this term. **First Island (Ire)** (Dominion {GB}), trained by Geoff Wragg, has also been confirmed an intended Champion starter, which means he will not now run at the Breeders' Cup fixture at Woodbine October 26. Saturday's four other possible starters, revealed following yesterday's noon deadline, are: **Even Top (Ire)** (Topanoora {Ire}), **Tamayaz** (Gone West), **Timarida (Ire)** (Kalaglow {Ire}) and **Wall Street** (Mr. Prospector).

WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

REVOQUE (IRE) (c, 2, Fairy King--La Bella Fontana {Ire}, by Lafontaine)

If there is one stallion who is really on a roll, it is Fairy King. Last weekend his son Helissio showed himself the best middle-distance colt in Europe with a victory in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and this past Sunday, another son, Revoque, staked a claim to be considered Europe's best juvenile with a triumph in the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp.

Revoque's pedigree is something of an outcross, the only duplications within six generations being Hyperion 5x6x6, Djebel 6x6 and Gold Bridge 6x5. This makes an analysis of his pedigree somewhat speculative, but there are at least a couple of interesting points to note. The first speculation is that the pedigree might have something of an unsung hero in Vandale (Fr), who appears as the broodmare sire of Revoque's broodmare sire Lafontaine (incidentally, for those not overly familiar with the name of Lafontaine, he was a game, frontrunning, English-raced Group 3 winner by Sham).

To understand why Vandale is potentially important here, we have to understand the pedigree as a whole and particularly the impact of three classic horses bred by the Early of Derby--Hyperion and the brothers Pharos and Fairway. Fairy King's grandsire, Nearctic, is by a son of Pharos (GB) out of a Hyperion mare. His second dam is by *Forli (by a grandson of Fairway out of a mare by a son of Hyperion), and there is also another strain of Pharos in the pedigree. Moving to Revoque's dam, La Bella Fontana, we find through Sham three crosses of Hyperion's dam Selene, including one through Hyperion, while La Bella Fontana's own dam, Sorebelle (GB), contributes three more Fairway/Pharos strains.

What makes Vandale potentially important here is the pedigree of his sire, Plassy (GB). He is by Bosworth, a half-brother to Selene (dam of Hyperion), out of Pladda, a three-parts sister to Pharos and Fairway. This means Plassy is the perfect foil for Hyperion/Pharos and Hyperion/Fairway combinations, all the more so, actually, as Plassy also has a daughter of Hyperion's paternal grandsire, Bayardo. Of course, Revoque's sire, Fairy King, has Hyperion/Pharos and Hyperion/Fairway combinations through Nearctic and Forli.

For a second potentially important connection, we have to turn to *Djeddah, the broodmare sire of Fairy King's broodmare sire Bold Reason. Djeddah was bred by Marcel Boussac, and like so many good Boussac runners was a very inbred horse, in this case 3x2 to the sisters Durban (dam of Tourbillon) and Heldifann. This pair were granddaughters of the phenomenal tap-root mare Frizette (whose more recent descendants include Mr. Prospector and Seattle Slew). Lafontaine brings in a double of Djeddah's sire Djebel, and Revoque's fourth dam is by Black Tarquin, another descendent of Frizette. Djeddah's dam, Djezima, and Black Tarquin's dam, Vagrancy, are particularly closely related as both are by sons of Teddy out of granddaughters of Frizette.

Revoque's female line is a sprinting one, but where the most important duplications in the pedigree are in the deeper removes a horse will often stay further than one might expect. Come next summer, we might well find ourselves guessing whether Revoque will stay the mile and a half of the Epsom Derby.

PEDIGREE SHORT...

When a less fashionably-bred horse turns into a talented performer, there is usually something interesting to be found in the pedigree. This is the case with **Vivace** (f, 3, **Shot Gun Scott--Silent Prospect {Northern Prospect}**), a winner of 11 of 15 starts, who went past the \$500,000 mark in earnings when taking the Red Earth Derby at Remington Park Saturday. She has the sisters Perception (fourth dam of Shot Gun Scott) and Not Afraid (through her son Prince John) 5x5 in her pedigree. In both cases, the sisters are combined with Bimelech, making Thieving (the granddam of Shot Gun Scott) and Silent Screen (sire of Vivace's second dam) very close relatives.
