CIGAR WORKS FOR BREEDERS' CUP CLASSIC

Sporting a new protective fiberglass patch on his right fore hoof, **Cigar** (Palace Music) breezed six furlongs in 1:15.22 Thursday morning at Belmont Park in his penultimate prep for the Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup Classic. "He went much like he did last year," reported trainer Bill Mott. "He's fine, his foot is fine and we are all in good humor." Mott said the patch was applied Tuesday more to safeguard the old injury than to protect a "slight" new problem on the foot. "There is something there, but to call it a quarter-crack might be bad terminology," he said. "At this point, if you rated it on a scale of 1-to-5, 5 being the worst, this is a 1. There was a little change in the hoof wall and we repatched it." Mott said if all continues to go well, Cigar will depart for Toronto Oct. 23.

TATTERSALLS OCTOBER YEARLING SALE

BOASTS 100% CLEARANCE RATE Thursday's third session of Tattersalls October Yearling Sale at Newmarket, England hit a new high when 100% of the 179 horses sent through the ring were reported sales. The 179 yearlings grossed \$8,197,200, up 36% from last year's corresponding day. The average of \$45,974 was up 18% from 1995, and the day's median of \$36,300 was a 22% increase. Through the sale's first three sessions, 664 yearlings have grossed \$23,589,390. With morning and evening sessions Friday and a morning session Saturday still to come, this year's gross is already 15% higher than the gross for the entire 1995 sale. The 1996 sale's new high price was reached late during Thursday's evening session when Prince Fahd Salman's Newgate Stud paid \$189,750 for a filly by Brief Truce--Vian (Far Out East).

EDDIE MAPLE BREAKS COLLARBONE

Jockey Eddie Maple will be sidelined for four weeks after suffering a broken right collarbone during Monday's 10th race at Belmont Park, according to today's *Daily Racing Form*. Maple was aboard **Tiverton** (High Brite) in a 1 1/16-mile claiming race on the turf when the three-year-old clipped heels and fell. "I got up, pulled my goggles up and felt pretty good," Maple told the *Form*. "It was when I started walking that I felt something burning, and by the time I got back to first aid, I knew it was something more serious." Maple was disappointed he will be forced to miss New York Showcase Day at Belmont this Saturday. "I had a lot of business that day, and that is always something you feel bad about," he said. "But I'm a lot more happy to be able to walk around and talk about it."

BREEDERS' CUP PRE-ENTRIES: *Ninety horses have been pre-entered for the 1996 Breeders' Cup Championship. The seven-race card, with \$11 million in purses and awards, will be contested Saturday, Oct. 26 at Woodbine Racetrack, and will be televised live by NBC Sports (1:30-6 p.m. EDT) and by CBC (12:30-6 p.m. EDT).*

Trainer Leo O'Brien reported yesterday that **YANKS MUSIC**, who was pre-entered in both the Classic and the Distaff, is a likely starter in the Classic. "I'm pretty sure we're going to run her in the Classic," O'Brien said. "(Co-owner) Mr. (Michael) Fennessy is determined. His way of thinking is that if we run in the Distaff and are beaten by another three-year-old filly, that one would have a legitimate chance of winning the championship. If Cigar has a bad day and we have a good day, we could be right there." In an early Classic line released yesterday by Ladbroke, Yanks Music is 4-1, second choice behind Cigar.

Meadowlands Cup winner **DRAMATIC GOLD** breezed six furlongs in 1:13 2/5 Thursday at Hollywood Park.

MT. SASSAFRAS, Canada's lone hope in the Classic, drilled five furlongs in :59 3/5 at Woodbine Thursday, galloping out six furlongs in 1:14. "He went very well; did it easily," said trainer Barb Minshall. "It was basically a maintenance breeze. He went out there by himself and just galloped around."

Trainer Bill Mott did not enter MGI winner **Wekiva Springs** (Runaway Groom) in the Classic. "He's just had some minor problems and we want to run him next year," Mott said. "So we felt it was best to pass the Breeders' Cup this year, which will give him a better chance for next year."

Britain's bookmakers have suspended betting on Saturday's G1 Champion S. at Newmarket following an injury scare involving 1000 Guineas heroine **Bosra Sham** (Woodman). The star filly was the second-favorite behind **Halling** (Diesis {GB}) for the 10-furlong test before rumors surfaced that the Henry Cecil trainee had, once again, suffered a foot problem. Cecil said, "She has a bruise and there is a pressure point. She's sound as a bell, but one never likes these sort of things to happen. We are still very hopeful, because she is so well in herself. We shall just have to see how she is." Bosra Sham suffered a foot injury just prior to her Classic success, but Cecil was able to get her to the 1000 Guineas fit enough to collect by a length and a half.

Meshhed (Gulch), the juvenile filly whose cow-kick put jockey Willie Carson in the hospital last month, proved she has racing talent as well as a temper with a 3½-length win at Redcar Thursday. The Ben Hanbury-trainee had to be mounted while still in her saddling box and delayed the start of the EBD Maiden Fillies' S. for over five minutes when refusing to enter the starting-stalls. Once running, she behaved perfectly, tracking the leader for the first 1/2-mile of the 7-furlong test and then surging clear under Richard Hills to take the prize.
