POLISH PRECEDENT COLT SMASHES TATTERSALLS RECORD

In a sale at which virtually every record has fallen, it remained only for a yearling at Tattersalls October sale to top the previous record of 220,000 guineas (\$361,500), set in 1986. That record fell Friday as Sheikh Mohammed's Darley Stud Management outbid Prince Fahd Salman, spending 310,000 guineas (\$511,500) for a colt by Polish Precedent. Consigned by Woodland Stud, the second foal from the Rainbow Quest mare Draft Board (GB) headlined a day when the clearance rate "dropped" to 94 percent as 167 yearlings sold for \$7,134,600, an average of \$42,730. The gross was up 74 percent from the corresponding day last year, while the average was up 56 percent. The sale's gross receipts are already 51 percent higher than the 1995 sale, with today's final session left to go. Tattersalls Marketing Manager Jimmy George said, "We thought this was an exceptional catalogue for an October yearling sale, and we're delighted to have broken the record for an individual yearling as well as the overall aggregate this week. It's as strong a sale as we could have possibly hoped for."

BREEDERS' CUP-BOUND CLAIMER LESS THAN STELLAR IN A.M.

Ricks Natural Star (Natural Native), a seven-year-old claimer who has been pre-entered in the Breeders' Cup Turf, worked six furlongs in 1:21 2/5 yesterday morning at Remington Park. The workout was the slowest of four at the distance, and a full four seconds behind the next slowest clocking. Last seen in a \$3,500 claiming event August 25, 1995 at Ruidoso, where he finished last, Ricks Natural Star has not won a race since scoring at that level in October, 1993 at Sunland Park. Owner/trainer William Livingston, who said that he had discovered a cure for the navicular disease which stopped the horse from racing last year, was pleased with the work. "That's pretty sharp for a horse that hasn't (won) in three years," he said. The 66-year-old Livingston, who took out his trainer's license near the end of September, went on to explain his desire to run in the event. "The horse is paid up, he's eligible, so we're not breaking any rules or anything," he said. "I doubt if I can get an adventure like this any other way--especially with a chance to get a pocketful of money at the same time."

In Command (Ire) is a 20-1 chance for next year's 2000 Guineas following his narrow win here at Newmarket. The Barry Hills trainee had finished only third behind BAHAMIAN BOUNTY (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) in the G1 Middle Park S. earlier this month. But, with an extra furlong to travel here and easier ground after heavy morning rain, he reversed that form convincingly. In Command was always in a handy position as co-favorite KAHAL (GB) (Machiavellian) and Musical Pursuit disputed the early pace. However, winning jockey Michael Hills asked for more effort two furlongs from the wire and his mount quickened well before holding the strong rally of the runner-up. Trainer Hills, who has now won a Group race in each of the past 25 years, said: "He was helped by the rain, but he has done really well physically since the Middle Park. I hope to prepare him for the Guineas next season. Michael (Hills) is adamant he will stay the mile."

DAY OF CHAMPIONS SET FOR NEWMARKET

According to yesterday's *The Sporting Life*, beginning in 1997 the 10-furlong G1 Dubai Champion S. at England's Newmarket racecourse will be the headliner for an event meant to mirror the Breeders' Cup. Newmarket Chairman Peter Player announced Thursday that the Newmarket Racecourses Trust would inaugurate a Champions Day next year which could decide many of England's championships on the racetrack, offering two Group One races, a Group Two, two handicaps and a listed sprint stakes. Nick Lees, Newmarket's clerk of the course, told *The Sporting Life*, "The Champion S. has occasionally been hit by the Breeders' Cup. Now we're saying we've got a terribly valuable race, come to us instead of the Breeders' Cup. Don't go halfway around the world to get beat; come and get beaten here!"

SHORTER MEETS FOR JERSEY TRACKS?

New Jersey's Garden State Park and Atlantic City Race Course submitted requests for severely restricted racing schedules at the monthly New Jersey Racing Commission meeting. Atlantic City requested just 26 dates, June 27-Aug. 9, down from 57 last year. Garden State applied for a two-day-a-week schedule from Jan. 3 to May 24, with racing Friday nights and a day-night doubleheader Saturdays, eliminating the Wednesday and Thursday dates the track ran this year. Rich Orbann, general manager at Garden State Park, said the track had considered closing their doors for Thoroughbred racing altogether, and has thus far scheduled only one stakes--the Jersey Derby--for the season. With the introduction of slot machines at nearby Delaware Park, said Orbann, "This is the toughest market around. Our weekdays have been horrendous--so poor that we thought we ought to give this a shot." A ruling is expected at the commission's November meeting.

AUSTRALIAN CHAMPION FOR ENGLAND'S

NATIONAL STUD Australia's former champion three-year-old **Danewin (Aus)** (Danehill) is to join the roster of stallions at The National Stud in Newmarket, becoming the first "shuttle" stallion from Australia to stand in England. In Australia, the now five-year-old stands at Emirates Park Stud at Murrurundi in New South Wales. Danehill's best performer to date, Danewin was rated top of his age group in both sprinting and middle distance categories in 1994/1995; he ran 30 times at two, three and four, winning 13 races, five of them Group 1, and earning more than \$1.5 million. The colt, a winner from six furlongs to a mile and a quarter, set a new course record of 1:59.99 for 10 furlongs winning the G1 Rosehill Guineas.

"PROP" BET Autotote Enterprises will once again offer a proposition wager on the Breeders' Cup. The wager, entitled "Stable Wars," asks fans to bet on a stable consisting of three horses and one jockey. The stable that earns the most points wins the wager, with five points awarded for a win, three for a second and one for a third. Win, exacta and trifecta wagering will be offered on the stables, with the minimum bet at \$1. CHARNWOOD FOREST TO STUD IN IRELAND

Charnwood Forest (Ire) (Warning {GB}), now given the all-clear to take part in next Saturday's Breeders' Cup Mile at Woodbine, will retire at the end of this year and stand from 1997 at Liam Cashman's Rathbarry Stud in County Cork, Ireland. Godolphin, in whose colors the four-year-old will race in Canada, was already in negotiations with Cashman before Charnwood Forest's victory in Thursday's G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket. But yesterday, Simon Crisford, the Dubai-based team's racing manager, revealed: "The horse will stand at Rathbarry for next season. He will run in the Mile for us, alongside **Mark Of Esteem (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), and, assuming he is available, Mick Kinane will ride him at Woodbine."
