TATTERSALLS OCTOBER CONCLUDES ON

HIGH NOTE When the hammer fell for the final time at Park Paddocks in Newmarket Saturday morning, 901 yearlings, an amazing 97 percent of those sent through the ring, had sold for a total of \$32,545,260 and an average of \$36,120 at Tattersalls October yearling sale. The gross was up 59 percent from last year's figures, the average was up 29 percent, and the median of \$26,400 was up 33 percent. The top seller on the final day of the sale was a filly by Lyphard out of Vivre Libre (Honest Pleasure); consigned by Highclere Stud, the half-sister to GSP Wishing (Lyphard's Wish {Fr}) sold for \$205,400 to Mr. John O'Byrne. After the sale, which saw records fall in all categories, Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony said, "A recent article in an American magazine referred to our Houghton Sale as 'the world's strongest horse sale in 1996,' but I believe we have just seen another contender for that accolade. Our vendors have done a magnificent job. They have presented us with probably the best ever October catalogue, and they have been rewarded for their confidence. A strong catalogue produces strong demand, and buyers have come from far and wide this week. Italian and German buyers have been here in unprecedented numbers, while French, Scandinavian, Eastern European and Far Eastern connections have also been extremely active. But no bloodstock sale can be a success without domestic support, and it has been equally gratifying to see British and Irish buyers in abundance, competing at all levels of the market. The sale has been a resounding vote of confidence in Newmarket as the focal point of the European bloodstock market."

WEATHER KNOCKS OUT EAST COAST

RACING The afternoon card at New York's Belmont Park and the evening card at The Meadowlands in New Jersey were both canceled yesterday due to high winds and heavy rain in the area. The forecast was calling for from two to five inches of rain, and wind gusting up to 40 miles per hour; racing will resume at Belmont today and at The Meadowlands Tuesday night. The seven New York-bred stakes races which had been scheduled at Belmont will be redrawn and run Sunday, October 27 at Aqueduct. Saturday's hunt meet in Red Bank, New Jersey, was also called off because of the weather.

Bosra Sham returned to an emotional reception from both her connections and the Newmarket racegoers after her devastating win in the Champion. The Henry Cecil-trained filly is clearly enormously talented. But, after a series of well-publicized foot problems which had restricted her to just three runs before yesterday, she had also attracted a good deal of public sympathy. Not that she needed it here, though, as, despite a mid-week injury scare, she proved far too good for her rivals. **EVEN TOP (IRE)** (Topanoora {Ire}) led at a steady early gallop with Halling and Timarida (Ire) dogging his tracks. Halling took up the pace with over a quarter-mile left to race. But, before he could build a decisive advantage, Pat Eddery on Bosra Sham made his move. His mount shot to the front 300 yards from the wire and, although hanging to her left as if still favoring her troublesome front hoof, she sprinted clear. Cecil said: "The past few days have been sheer hell. But this was wonderful." Added Eddery: "I rode her in some work last week and she had come on so much for her run in the Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot (her first race in over four months) that I just couldn't see any horse in the world giving her eight pounds if she came here fit. Halling really took off. But Bosra Sham's acceleration was fantastic."

LORD CARSON TO VINERY IN '97 Mr. and Mrs. Ben P. Walden, Jr.'s Vinery announced yesterday the purchase of **Lord Carson** (Carson City), first in the GI Boojum H. at Belmont Park October 6. The four-year-old, winner of 12 of his 26 starts to date for earnings of \$598,741, is currently being syndicated for stud duty in 1997. Bred and raced by David P. Reynolds, the colt will make his final career start in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Woodbine October 26. A stakes winner at two, three and four, Lord Carson equaled Turfway's six-furlong track record of 1:08 3/5 winning this year's Kentucky Cup Sprint, and took the Boojum in the identical time. His stud fee will be set after the Breeders' Cup.

ZAGREB TO MISS BREEDERS' CUP Zagreb (Theatrical {Ire}), who carried the Allen Paulson colors to a six-length win in the Irish Derby at The Curragh in June, will miss next weekend's Breeders' Cup meeting at Woodbine and appears certain not to run again this year. Dermot Weld, the bay's Irish-based trainer, had been considering sending the colt to Canada despite a disappointing 13th-place finish last time out in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp October 6. But, following recent tests, Zagreb has been discovered to be less than 100 percent and connections will not be bidding for glory next Saturday. Weld said: "The horse has a slight head cold and that has made our Breeders' Cup decision easier. We are looking forward to him running in next season's big races as a four-year-old."

Isitingood notched his first graded stakes win two starts back in the GIII Longacres Mile at Emerald Downs, then followed with a third-place effort in the GIII Kentucky Cup Classic Sept. 21. Ridden by regular jockey David Flores here, the five-year-old went up to duel for the lead with Distorted Humor entering the backside, alternated on the lead with that rival the rest of the way and finally outgamed him to the wire for a head decision. "I got a clean break out of there, and I got a good position," said Flores. "I saved my horse, and he felt so strong in the end. I rode him with confidence today because he was training pretty well." Last year's Fayette winner JUDGE T C (Judge Smells), who edged out Isitingood for second in the Kentucky Cup Classic, finished sixth.

The California Horse Racing Board has approved the distribution of \$187,000 from the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club to 20 different charities. A total of \$94,000 will go to non-racing organizations, including the United Way of San Diego and the North County YMCA; of the \$93,000 headed to racing charities, \$16,000 will go to the Helen Woodward Animal Center, \$15,000 each to the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation and University of California-Davis Equine Research Laboratory; \$10,000 apiece to the California Equine Retirement Foundation, the Don MacBeth Memorial Jockey Fund, the University of California Race Track Industry Program and the Winners Foundation; and \$5,000 to the Shoemaker Foundation.

The CHRHB has also endorsed California State Senator Ken Maddy for an appointment to the new National Gambling Impact Study Commission; President Bill Clinton and the Congress are in the process of making appointments to the nine-member commission.
