KEENELAND CATALOGS 3,844 FOR

NOVEMBER A total of 3,844 horses, including 78 from two major dispersals, will be offered at this year's Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. The 11-day auction runs November 10-20, with sessions beginning at 10:00 a.m. daily. Windfields Farm completes its dispersal with an offering of 42 broodmares and 29 weanlings; the renowned stable's final consignment includes its last two Northern Dancer mares, SW Linda North, dam of GISW Norquestor, and Sudden Frost, a full sister to Epsom Derby winner Secreto, as well as Angelic Song (Halo), a full sister to Devil's Bag and Glorious Song, and Minister's Song (Deputy Minister), a half-sister to the two champions. Societe Aland will offer seven horses in its dispersal, five broodmares and two weanling colts. The breakdown for the Keeneland November Sale is: 1,721 weanlings, 20 two-year-olds, 73 three-year-olds, 57 four-year-olds, 1,955 broodmares, 14 horses and four stallions. Last year, Keeneland sold 2,863 lots for a total of \$142,142,300 at its November Breeding Stock Sale.

TTBA SALE OPENS The Texas Thoroughbred Association's 1996 Fall Mixed Sale began at Fort Worth's Will Rogers Equestrian Center Saturday with separate sessions for weanlings, yearlings and horses of racing age. A total of 53 weanlings sold for \$262,900, an average of \$4,960 and a median of \$3,300; 30 were listed as not sold. The top-selling weanling was a filly by Salt Lake out of Chief's Lil' Lady (Chieftain); consigned by Tom Baron's Woody Creek Ranch, the half-sister to stakes winner Megachief was purchased by Mary Anne Parris for \$19,000. The yearling session saw 16 of 27 hips change hands, grossing \$71,200 for an average of \$4,450 and a median of \$1,700. A Summer Squall colt brought the highest bid at the session; consigned by RGX, Inc., the son of the Damascus mare Tartus sold for \$41,000 to Carter-Walsh Farm. Thirteen of the 19 horses of racing age were sold, bringing a total of \$17,000 for an average of \$2,954 and a median of \$1,300. The two-day auction concluded yesterday.

California Contingent Arrives...Fifteen horses left California for Canada Sunday morning in their quest for Breeders' Cup glory. On the 4:00 a.m. PDT flight were, for the Classic: **Alphabet Soup** (Cozzene), **Atticus** (Nureyev), **Dare And Go** (Alydar), **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold); Turf: **Talloires** (Tremolino); Juvenile: **Zippersup** (Alwuhush); Distaff: **Different (Arg)** (Candy Stripes); Mile: **Smooth Runner** (Local Talent), **Urgent Request (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest); Sprint: **Boundless Moment** (Crafty Prospector), **Criollito (Arg)** (Candy Stripes), **Lakota Brave** (Northern Prospect), **Paying Dues** (Cure the Blues); Juvenile Fillies: **Critical Factor** (Star de Naskra), **Dunbar Hill** (Pine Bluff).

BC Work Tab...Turf candidate **Chief Bearhart** (Chief's Crown), second in the GI Canadian International last out, worked six furlongs in 1:16 1/5 over Woodbine's E.P. Taylor Turf yesterday. "This horse doesn't usually work well," said jockey Sandy Hawley, aboard for the move. "He does as much as he has to, but when I tapped him on the shoulder he responded and really dug in. The cut in the ground was perfect, but I think he would prefer slightly firmer." Sprint hopeful **Langfuhr** (Danzig) also breezed yesterday, going a half in a sprightly :45 3/5 before galloping out five furlongs in :59 over a wet main track. The work was the fastest of 21 on the tab. Another pointing for the Sprint, three-year-old filly **Capote Belle** (Capote) went five-eighths in 1:00 Sunday, while Classic runner **Formal Gold** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) went six furlongs in 1:12. "He went as good as one can go," said trainer Bill Perry. The colt will blow out for the \$4 million event Friday. **My Flag** (Easy Goer), aiming at the Distaff, went five furlongs in 1:02 and will also blow out, Thursday or Friday.

SLEEPYTIME FOR WINTER REST Sleepytime (Ire) (Royal Academy), favorite for next year's 1000 Guineas, is to be rested until 1997 after failing to perform as well as connections had hoped in her latest workout. Trainer Henry Cecil had been planning to start the filly, unlucky in running when third in Ascot's G1 Fillies' Mile September 28, in this Saturday's Listed Radley S. at Newbury. But following a lackluster gallop, it has been decided she will not race again as a juvenile. Cecil said: "Sleepytime did not really sparkle. She looks as though she has had enough for this season, so we have decided to put her away until next year."

Miss Huff n' Puff, fourth in the GI Matron and GI Frizette in her last two starts, was scheduled to make her turf debut in the Miss Grillo but found herself the 2-1 favorite when the race was switched to the main track. The big bay sprinted to the lead right out of the gate, sailed through swift early fractions of :45.41 and 1:09.95, then opened it up down the lane to win handily in a time two ticks faster than the colts covered the distance in the GIII Pilgrim later on the card. "I don't know how she went from being 15 lengths out of it at the start in her last to going to the lead here," said trainer Rick Violette. "I do know that in her last two starts she was in season; I hate to blame it on that but Richie (Migliore) said today she dragged him to the lead." Miss Huff n' Puff is the first stakes winner for owners Ralph M. Evans, Anthony J. Aprilante and Alphonse Zenna. She will start next in the Gill Selima at Laurel November 3.

Boosted by full-card simulcasting, total handle at the Ohio oval was \$30,180,872, up 9.9 percent from the \$27,455,090 wagered at last year's corresponding 49-day meet. The average daily handle of \$569,450 was up 1.6 percent from 1995. Total attendance for the Randall Meet was also up slightly as 202,605 fans visited the track, up 6.7 percent from a year ago, but the daily average of 3,823 was down 1.3 percent from 1995.
