MISTLE CAT DEAD Mistle Cat (Storm Cat), winner of the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua at San Siro racecourse in Milan, Italy Oct. 6, has died. The six-year-old gray, flag-bearer for trainer Sean Woods's Newmarket stables, had been due to retire to stud for 1997. But Friday morning, while doing his usual feeding round at the yard, Woods discovered Mistle Cat dead in his stall. The handler said, "We are all shattered. This is a big blow to me personally, because the horse has been a great friend to me. But it is devastating for my staff as well. Everybody here simply loved him." Vets at Newmarket's Animal Health Trust are carrying out a postmortem on the Kentucky-bred. Woods added, "He was fine when I went to look at him on Thursday night at about 10 o'clock. But at 5:30 the following morning he was dead. There was not a mark on him. He wasn't cast in his box and no bones were broken. Now we shall just have to wait and see what the experts come up with about the cause of death. There is no point in speculating." Mistle Cat won six of 30 career starts, including the G3 Prix du Palais-Royal at Deauville May 26. He also placed in nine Group events.

ARAZI TO THREE CHIMNEYS Arazi (Blushing Groom {Fr}), who took the 1991 Breeders' Cup Juvenile with an electrifying move, will stand the 1997 breeding season at Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky. Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum will retain ownership of the colt, who was named champion two-year-old in both Europe and North America, as well as Europe's 1991 Horse of the Year. "From the day he won the Breeders' Cup Juvenile so impressively, there has been tremendous American interest in Arazi," said Robert Acton, the stud director of Dalham Hall Stud in England, where the seven-year-old stood his first four seasons. "We see this as a chance to provide the horse access to mares of American bloodlines and speed that will suit him, while still being able to breed our mares to him. Three Chimneys has had great success with Rahy and has long been interested in standing this horse." Added Three Chimneys owner Robert Clay, "Arazi is a son of Blushing Groom (Fr), a miler of incredible accomplishment, and hails from a distinguished female family. Certainly the news that he returns to the U.S. is very welcome to any who lament the loss of prominent stallions to the Far East." Arazi was represented by his first crop to race this season; he will stand for \$30,000, live foal. News cont. p4

TATTERSALLS HORSES IN TRAINING SALE

BEGINS MONDAY Among the 1162 horses catalogued for the Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale, to be held at Newmarket, England Oct. 28-31, are a number of high-class two-year-olds, including **Rich Ground (GB)** (Common Grounds {GB}). Winner of the G3 July S. at Newmarket, Rich Ground also ran fourth in the G1 Prix Morny behind dual Group 1-winning two-year-old Bahamian Bounty. Other black-type performing juveniles being offered include the fillies **Eye Shadow (GB)** (Mujtahid) and **Olympic Spirit (GB)** (Puissance) and the gelding **Victory Dancer (GB)** (Ron's Victory). A Juddmonte consignment features 55 horses, including three-year-old colts **Projection** (Topsider), a GSP half-brother to GISW Toussaud; and **Balladur** (Nureyev), a winning half-brother to champion Sanglamore.

MONTREAL RED, PONCHE TO OCALA STUD

FARM Montreal Red (D'Accord) has been purchased by Bill Murphy and Mike O'Farrell and has been syndicated to stand at O'Farrell's Ocala Stud Farm in Ocala, Florida for the 1997 breeding season. Trained by Scotty Schulhofer for Canada-based owner Jim Miller, Montreal Red won four of 13 starts for earnings of \$306,979. All four of his victories came at age two; they included tallies in the G1 Futurity S., GII Saratoga Special and GIII Sanford S. The chestnut also placed in the G1 Hopeful S. at two and the GIII Appleton H. at four. Montreal Red is a full-brother to Princess Accord, a multiple stakes-winner in England. Also entering stud in 1997 at Ocala Stud Farm is **Ponche** (Two Punch). The seven-year-old roan won 16 of 47 starts, including five stakes, for earnings of \$437,086. Out of the stakes-winning mare Street Ballet (Nijinsky II), Ponche will stand for a 1997 stud fee of \$1,500, live foal. Montreal Red's first-year stud fee has been set at \$2,000.

CHURCHILL DOWNS' 107TH FALL MEETING BEGINS SUNDAY Featuring a record purse structure of \$1.7 million and a stakes schedule boasting no purse under \$100,000, Churchill Downs will open its 107th fall racing meet this Sunday. During the meet, which runs through Nov. 30, Churchill's races will be available by simulcast at approximately 620 sites throughout the U.S. and Canada. Of the 11 stakes scheduled during the 30-day season, nine are graded. Leading the list with a Grade II rating is the \$200,000a Churchill Downs Distaff Nov. 9. The daily average purses for the meet are expected to be close to last fall's record of \$322,000.
