BREEDERS' CUP WRAP-UP *The Winners...* Trainer David Hofmans, who bet \$50 at odds of 85-1 in Las Vegas on his Classic winner **Alphabet Soup** (Cozzene) a month ago, said yesterday morning that the grey colt came back from his gutsy performance in good order. "He is great," said Hofmans. "He cooled out in no time. We might not run him again the rest of the year. There has been some talk about Dubai."...Juvenile champ **Boston Harbor** (Capote) set a record for most earnings by a two-year-old after picking up \$1,928,605, including the \$1 million Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund bonus, this year. "We'll back off on him," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who earned his fifth Juvenile victory with the colt. "We'll give him 60 days. He's had his races close together. We'll bring him to Kentucky for a while, and then maybe take him to Florida since that's where (owner William T. Young) spends the winter, but that's not certain by any means."...**Jewel Princess** (Key to the Mint), impressive taking the Distaff, was in fine fettle yesterday and will take a break now but return to race again next year at five. "We hope to get her back to the Distaff at Hollywood Park next year," said trainer Wally Dollase...Mile winner **Da Hoss** (Gone West) flew out of Canada yesterday morning at 5:00 a.m., bound for Maryland. "He'll be out in his favorite paddock by now," said trainer Michael Dickinson from Woodbine Sunday. As for the future, he said, "We're hoping, if we get an invitation, to go to Hong Kong. He's the best he's been right now."...**Lit de Justice** (El Gran Senor) is headed to Adena Springs in Lexington to begin his stud career. Said his owner, C. N. Ray, "(Trainer Jenine Sahadi) said to me (Sunday) morning, 'this horse is so sound, let's run him another year.' But I can't do that. He's already got a home."...**Pilsudski** (Ire) (Polish Precedent), first in the Turf, "looks better today than he did yesterday," said trainer Michael Stoute Sunday. Stoute also saddled Turf runner-up **Singspiel** (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}), and said both have been invited to run in Hong Kong. "We'll have to get them home and decide if they have another race in them or nor," he remarked.

WORSE FOR THE WEAR...**Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold) came back from his ninth-place Classic finish with cuts on his hind legs, but they are not serious and the colt will race again next year...Trainer Richard Mandella said yesterday that **Dare and Go** (Alydar), 11th in the Classic, was off on his right front after the race and may have chipped a knee, cancelling a possible final career start in the Japan Cup. **News cont. p2**

A first Group win for the filly Red Roses Story and her young apprentice rider, 20-year-old Vincent Vion, who is apprenticed to the winning owner/trainer Mme. Corinne Barbe. Moonax led from the start, followed by Helen Of Spain and Red Roses Story. On the turn into the straight, Moonax still led, but Vion then brought Red Roses Story between Moonax and the rail and the filly quickened well to go and win comfortably. Mrs. Barbe said: "I'm absolutely delighted. Red Roses Story is a very fragile filly and had not run since April because she not only needs softish ground on which to run, but also the same conditions for training. I hesitated between running her here or taking her to Canada along with Carling (*see below*), but as she is also delicate at the stalls, I thought it better to stay here. I now wish she had wings so she and I could get to Canada in time."

Wandering Star, winner of the Lyceum Atlanta S. at Sandown in England August 31 for her third straight score, was making her first start in America after trying Group company for the first time in the G2 Sun Chariot S. October 5 and finishing fifth. A longshot here, the filly rated behind the early leaders, took over entering the stretch and drew clear. "It was a tremendous effort," winning rider Herb McCauley said after the race. "There were some million-dollar fillies in here and she ran like one herself. She was in tight quarters the whole way, covered up the way she likes to be, and when she got clear run in the straight she was powerful; she just overpowered them all." The filly will now be sent to trainer Shug McGaughey.

BREEDERS' CUP ODDS AND ENDS The 1996 Breeders' Cup attracted a Woodbine record crowd of 42,243, breaking the old mark of 40,137 set for the 1973 Queen's Plate. Total on-track wagering on this year's event \$11,635,337...There were four winners of the Pick Seven; one was purchased at Chinatown OTB in Toronto (\$366,772); two in Las Vegas (\$494,653); and one at Bay Meadows (\$541,737)...Allen Paulson became the leading breeder of Breeders' Cup money winners with Cigar's third-place purse of \$480,000, pushing Paulson's total to \$3,712,000, but Cigar (Palace Music) failed to reach the \$10 million mark in career earnings by a mere \$185...Serena's Song (Rahy), with \$3,238,348 in the bank, is \$25,488 behind the all-time money winning filly Dance Smartly and will race again next year to try and top her mark...Despite problems at the starting gate and with the tote system, Breeders' Cup Ltd. was pleased with Woodbine's performance as the first track outside the U.S. to host racing's championship day. "Has the Ontario Jockey Club earned a place for future consideration for the Breeders' Cup?" offered Executive Director D. G. Van Clief. "Yes, indeed, they have."...The 1997 Breeders' Cup will be held at Hollywood Park November 8.

STABLE 9 WINS AUTOTOTE PROP BET Stable #9, consisting of jockey Gary Stevens, Classic winner **Alphabet Soup** (Cozzene), Juvenile Fillies runner-up **Love That Jazz** (Dixieland Band) and **Talloires** (Tremolino), won Autotote Enterprises' Breeders' Cup Stable Wars proposition bet Saturday. The stable accumulated 20 points in the seven Breeders' Cup races. Sent off at 6-1, the wager paid \$15.80 to win. The favored stable, #6, consisting of jockey Corey Nakatani, **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold), **Honour and Glory** (Relaunch) and **Ordway** (Salt Lake), went off at 5-2 but finished with only 12 points.

ROYAL LANDMARK SET SATURDAY The success of two-year-old filly **Tempting Prospect (GB)** (Shirley Heights {GB}) in the Whatcombe Conditions S. at Newbury on Saturday, which gave The Queen of England her 600th winner as an owner, was being hailed yesterday as "a great thrill" by the two men most closely connected with the bay. Lord Huntingdon, who trains the homebred for Her Majesty, said: "It was marvelous and a miracle that The Queen could be there to see the race in person. It had been over three weeks since Her Majesty had her previous winner. So perhaps we can persuade her to attend more often. You never know, we might manage to make 700--or even better." Huntingdon has high hopes for **Tempting Prospect**, a half-sister to The Queen's G2 winner **Phantom Gold**. Michael Oswald, manager of The Royal Studs at Sandringham, was unable to make the trip to Newbury, but he was equally delighted that this filly should be the one to bring The Queen to her remarkable milestone. Oswald said: "It is particularly delightful that this total should have been reached by a daughter of Shirley Heights. He has been such a brave horse to come through two major operations earlier this year. But he recovered tremendously well and covered 24 mares this season. We are hopeful of him filling a book of 40-plus for 1997."

SAINTLY TAKES AUSTRALIA'S TOP EVENT

Australia's most prestigious race, the mile-and-a-quarter \$1,185,490 W.S. Cox Plate at Moonee Valley Saturday was won by the four-year-old gelding **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}). Saintly had a head over **Filante (NZ)** (Star Way {GB}) at the wire, while '95/'96 Horse Of The Year **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) raced only fifth. Winning trainer Bart Cummings said: "It was a very good effort from Saintly, but from where I was sitting I thought Filante had won." Winning jockey Darren Beadman said: "We were very wide up the straight so I couldn't tell whether we'd got up or not to beat Filante."

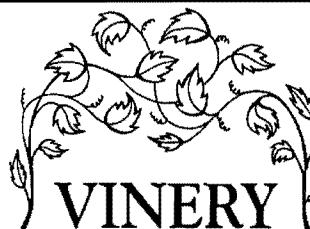
