SURGERY FOR WILL'S WAY Travers winner **Will's Way** (Easy Goer) came out of his seventh-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Classic with a chip in his left front ankle and will undergo arthroscopic surgery Nov. 11 at Cornell University. Trainer Jim Bond said his three-year-old will be out of training for only a short period of time and is expected to be ready to race by February or March at Gulfstream. "(Jockey) Jorge (Chavez) said he bobbed at the half-mile pole in the Breeders' Cup and felt funny," said Bond. "He picked his head up and ran down the lane, but it was a case of too little, too late." Will's Way will return to serious training at Payson Park toward the end of December. Bond will consider starts in the Donn and Gulfstream Park H., but also said he hopes to earn an invitation to the Dubai World Cup.

TOBA OWNER OF THE MONTH TO GUSTAV SCHICKEDANZ Top sprinter **Langfuhr** (Danzig), winner of the GI Forego H. at Saratoga September 2 and the GI Vosburgh at Belmont September 21, gave his owner, Gustav Schickedanz, the edge in the voting for the September Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association Owner of the Month Award for September. Schickedanz, the proprietor of Schonberg Farm in Ontario, migrated to Canada in 1950, where he worked in the construction business. He registered his first two foals as a breeder in 1982, and the broodmare band at Schonberg now numbers 20 to 25. Schickedanz also has 20 horses in training with trainer Michael Keogh; he will be featured on ESPN's *Racehorse Digest*.

DUMAANI TO SHADWELL Dumaani (Danzig), who won back-to-back runnings of the GIII Keeneland Breeders' Cup, has been retired to Nashwan Stud, the stallion division of Shadwell Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. A stakes winner in England and Japan as well as North America, he retires with earnings of \$352,866. "He is back on the farm and seems to be enjoying his new lifestyle," said Rick Nichols, Shadwell's Vice President and General Manager. The five-year-old Dumaani will stand for a fee of \$5,000, live foal.
