**CIGAR BIDS BIG APPLE GOODBYE** In a ceremony befitting his stature, **Cigar** (Palace Music) said goodbye to the people of New York yesterday in an emotional 30-minute farewell at the National Horse Show in Madison Square Garden. Driven down Seventh Avenue in a 40-foot van emblazoned with his name and photograph, Cigar poked his head out of the open door, looking back at the hundreds of people waving signs, calling his name and pressing closer for a better view. Jockey Jerry Bailey and trainer Bill Mott signed autographs for the crowd, and invited a dozen young girls chanting "we want Cigar" aboard for a closer look. At approximately 2:30 p.m., introduced by racecaller Dave Johnson and awaited by a group of celebrities headed by actor and comedian Bill Cosby, Cigar was led into the arena to the first of several standing ovations. With Bailey aboard, assistant trainer Tim Jones led Cigar around the ring once before unclipping the lead shank; Cigar jogged calmly to thunderous applause from the crowd. He was given gifts—a blanket with the Knicks and Rangers logo from MSG, a plaque bearing a gold horseshoe from the Budweiser Clydesdales, and three wagons of apples and carrots from the children starring in the upcoming MSG production of "A Christmas Carol." After a photo op with Cosby and the other celebrities, the house lights were darkened, the orchestra struck up "Auld Lang Syne" and Mott took hold of his champion as the spotlight followed him once around The Garden and then out of the arena. Cigar is scheduled to make one more farewell appearance, parading at Churchill Downs November 12 before beginning his stud career at Brookside Farms.

**MELBOURNE CUP DRAW** Irish-trained favorite **Oscar Schindler (Ire)** (Royal Academy) has been drawn 12th of the 24 runners in Tuesday's \$1,580,653 Fosters Melbourne Cup over two miles at Flemington in Australia. Last year's winner **Doriemus (NZ)** (Norman Pentaquad) has drawn post 18, while English hopes **Grey Shot (GB)** (Sharrood) and **Court Of Honour (Ire)** (Law Society) have drawn 13 and 17, respectively. Oscar Schindler, now the 7-2 favourite for Australia's most famous race, will be ridden by Irish jockey Michael Kinane, who won the race in 1993 on the Irish-trained runner Vintage Crop. Trainer Kevin Prendergast said yesterday: "I am very happy with the horse, but I would have preferred to have drawn inside the No. 10 barrier."

Sendoro led from the start and looked like a winner as they raced around the turn, but Daylami and Shaka also quickened and the race was between these two, with Shaka rallying again inside the final furlong to gain the victory. Said winning trainer Jean-Claude Rouget: "I have always thought highly of this colt. He was beaten on his debut in the provinces by a filly who had run twice before, and he found the six furlongs and the firm track against him. Then I decided to take the challenge and came to Paris and everything worked out perfectly. This colt is a genuine Classic prospect."

## THEATRICAL COLT WINS VICTORIA DERBY

**Portland Player (NZ)** (Theatrical {Ire}), conceived in the U.S. but raised in New Zealand, won Saturday's G1 \$790,326 AAMI Victoria Derby over an extended mile and a half at Flemington in Melbourne. Owned and bred by David Hains, the 10-1 shot, who is out of the VRC Oaks winner Spirit Of Kingston, won by a short neck over 2-1 favorite **Alfa (Aus)** (El Moxie) and 6-1 shot **Ebony Grosve (NZ)** (Grosvenor), who dead-heated for second. Hains, a merchant banker who has owned stud farms in America and Australia, said after his first Victoria Derby victory: "I thought Portland Player had a good chance, but I couldn't say I was confident. But he was bred to run this distance and it's a big thrill to see it come to fruition. This was the sweetest victory of all." Winning trainer Lee Freedman had always been confident. "He is a real stayer," said Freedman. "He just outstayed them. When it came to the crunch, his breeding came through. I didn't think there was much between the colts this year and I thought he could beat them because he would relish the distance." This was only the second victory in eight starts for Portland Player and he will now be rested until early next year, when he will be prepared for the AJC Derby over a mile and a half at Randwick.
