**YANKS MUSIC POINTS FOR RETURN** Yanks Music (Air Forbes Won), scratched from the Breeders' Cup Classic the afternoon of the race with filling in her right front ankle, will resume training today and is being pointed toward the Nov. 29 GI Delta Top Flight H. at Aqueduct, according to trainer Leo O'Brien. "She is doing really good and if everything continues to go well, we should run her in the Top Flight, which will be her last race this year," said O'Brien. "The problem wasn't very big--it was just enough to stop us from running up there. I was really enjoying the Breeders' Cup up to that point. I was more disappointed for the owners than for myself." Four-year-old filly **Chaposa Springs** (Baldski), second last year in the Top Flight, will also be back to take on the three-year-old filly after her last-place run in the Breeders' Cup Mile. "She's fine," said trainer Marty Wolfson. "She had to run hard in the soft part of the course down the backstretch where several other horses had trouble handling the going, too." Wolfson said a decision had not yet been made as to whether she will campaign again next season.

**TIMARIDA SCRATCHED FROM YELLOW RIBBON** Morning-line favorite **Timarida (Ire)** (Kalaglow {Ire}), who shipped from Ireland to run in yesterday's GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational at Santa Anita, came down with a fever after arriving last Thursday morning and had to be scratched from the race. "Her temperature was up and it hasn't really gone down all that well," said trainer John Oxx. "Since (Thursday) it's been hovering a little bit too high and the blood count wasn't right. It just hasn't improved enough for her to run. She's not sick--she's quite bright in herself. She'll bounce back and recover pretty quickly, but not quickly enough for the race. We won't transport her back to Ireland in this condition. We'll let her recover first and then make a decision regarding what's next. The plan is to bring her home in a week's time, and we'll consider the Matriarch (at Hollywood December 1)."

**CIGAR APPEARANCE MOVED** The planned public appearance of reigning Horse of the Year **Cigar** (Palace Music) at Churchill Downs has been moved from Tuesday, November 12 to Saturday, November 9. Cigar is scheduled to arrive at Louisville International Airport on Tuesday morning, November 5; he will be stabled at Churchill until his farewell. Due to the change in itinerary, plans for the champion's final racetrack salute have not yet been announced.

Donna Viola (GB), an English-bred filly, had won Group races in Ireland and France in her last two starts but was overlooked in the wagering in her American bow. Rated in fourth behind the moderate pace of **CHELSEY FLOWER** (His Majesty), the bay found herself four-wide on the final bend but snuck through an opening between horses as they came into the stretch and finished full of run to edge longshot Real Connection. "I couldn't believe she wasn't getting any respect--nobody was talking about her before this race," said winning rider Gary Stevens, who took five races on the card. "She's a real classy filly. At the eighth-pole, she was just steadily starting to gain momentum...I pulled my stick into my left hand, hit her twice, and she just rebroke. I knew at that point she had a gear that I couldn't really feel beforehand." **WANDESTA** (GB) (Nashwan), the 4-5 choice, was last early after getting pinched at the break, made a bid on the far turn but was blocked as they straightened into the lane and found running room too late, finishing fifth. "I hurt my left elbow earlier, went out there and tried to ride, and I just couldn't do it well enough," said her jockey, Corey Nakatani. "I could never let her run."
