CIGAR TO ASHFORD Allen Paulson announced Monday that he plans to sell a majority interest in his homebred superstar **Cigar** (Palace Music), and that, upon completion of the deal, the six-year-old will stand the 1997 breeding season at Ashford Stud, the American division of Coolmore, in Versailles, Kentucky. "We are currently negotiating a deal with Coolmore which will allow us to retain a significant share in Cigar," said Paulson. "The deal is being brokered by Emmanuel de Seroux, and will value Cigar at approximately \$25 million. It will ensure that one of the best horses seen in America in modern times will be available to U.S. breeders. We plan to breed some of our best mares to him. We are attracted to the Coolmore proposal because Coolmore is a global operation. It has a record second to none in marketing stallions, it has first-rate personnel and it has a worldwide network of very successful clients. I believe that they will give Cigar the best possible chance at stud." Added John Magnier of Coolmore Stud, "It is a great honor for Ashford to stand the best horse any of us can remember. Our interest in the horse began when Vincent O'Brien saw Cigar in Dubai and was deeply impressed by him. Vincent considered Cigar to be an outstanding racehorse with the looks to match, and a great example of a sire line he knows so well." Michael Tabor, who raced '95 champion three-year-old Thunder Gulch, is also expected to be a partner in the deal. Cigar's stud fee for 1997 will be \$75,000.

The Melbourne Cup, the race that brings Australia literally to a standstill for three-and-a-half minutes, will be run on what is expected to be a fast surface. Race favourite **Oscar Schindler (Ire)** (Royal Academy), trained in Ireland by the Melbourne-born Kevin Prendergast, has impressed punters with his last two runs. Having won the G1 Irish St. Leger at his previous start, he then finished a great third to Helissio (Fr) in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. No horse in Australia can match that form, but the two miles of the Cup will be an entirely different challenge. The three 'heavyweight' trainers in Australian racing, Bart Cummings, Lee Freedman and Gai Waterhouse, saddle up the best three chances for a home victory. Cummings, looking for his 10th Melbourne Cup, has **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}), last start winner of the prestigious Cox Plate. **Doriemus (NZ)** (Norman Pentaquad), trained by Freedman, is aiming to be only the fifth horse in the Cup's 136-year history to win twice, while Waterhouse, having trained the runner-up twice in her short career, saddles the proven stayer **Nothin' Leica Dane (Aus)** (Danehill).

MECKE SHARP AT CALDER James Lewis Jr.'s top turf runner **Mecke** (Maudlin) worked five furlongs in 1:00 3/5 at Calder Monday morning and will make his next start in the GIII Tropical Turf H. November 30. "He went good this morning," said trainer Manny Tortora. "I want to run him a mile and an eighth later this month, and then come back in the McKnight." The GI W. L. McKnight H., at a mile and a half, is set for December 21. Third in the GI Canadian International at Woodbine last out September 29, the four-year-old has wins in the GI Arlington Million and GI Early Times Classic this year.

Local News: Santa Anita

The Santa Anita Companies yesterday reported improved results for the third quarter and nine months ending September 30, 1996 over the comparable periods of a year ago. For the 1996 third quarter, The Santa Anita Companies had a reduced loss of \$1,891,000, or \$.16 per share. The combined net loss in the 1996 third quarter was \$811,000, or \$.07 per share, compared to \$1,255,000, or \$.11 per share in 1995. For the nine months ended September 30, 1996, Santa Anita had combined net income of \$7,579,000, or \$.67 per share, compared to a combined net loss of \$30,273,000, or \$2.70 per share, for the same period a year ago. Combined net income for 1996 was \$8,659,000, or \$.76 per share, compared to \$7,409,000, or \$.66 per share, in 1995. During the quarter, Santa Anita Realty Enterprises received \$8.3 million in net proceeds from the sale of two office buildings in California; these funds were used primarily to reduce debt, which was \$22.2 million for the combined companies as of September 30, 1996, as opposed to \$51.8 million a year earlier.
