SHAAMIT TO NATIONAL STUD Shaamit (Ire) (Mtoto {GB}), winner of the 1996 Epsom Derby, will stand stud in 1997 at The National Stud in Newmarket, England. He will stand for a fee of \$11,737, due Oct. 1 to a restricted number of mares. His owner, Khalifa Dasmal, has agreed to provide the breeders of each of Shaamit's first three two-year-old winners in Britain or Ireland with a \$15,649 'bonus.' Nicholas Jones, chairman of The National Stud, said yesterday, "I am delighted that Mr. Dasmal has chosen to stand his Derby winner at The National Stud. Shaamit is a fine, good-looking horse and will provide a great opportunity for British breeders to use this year's Epsom Derby winner at a very fair price." Shaamit won two of six starts for earnings of \$909,200. He also finished third behind Pentire and Classic Cliche in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S.

MGM GRAND CLASSIC CROWN BONUS RAISED TO \$3 MILLION According to a story in today's *Daily Racing Form*, the bonus for sweeping the 1997 MGM Grand Classic Crown was officially raised to \$3 million Monday. The series of three \$1 million races, which includes the Santa Anita H., Hollywood Gold Cup and Pacific Classic, will now be worth \$4.8 million to a winner of all three races--a \$3 million bonus plus \$1.8 million in purse money. In addition, the *Form* reported the \$500,000 bonus for participating in all three races has been altered. The highest point earner will now earn 50 percent of the \$500,000, rather than the entire bonus as was the case in 1996. Second through fourth will be worth 25, 15 and 10 percent respectively. Bonus standings will be determined on a 10-7-5-3-2-1 point basis for first through sixth-place finishes. The first leg of the 1997 series is the March 2 Santa Anita H.

SAINTLY HEADS FOR JAPAN CUP Tuesday's Melbourne Cup winner **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}) will fly out from Australia next Monday to race in the \$4.1 million Japan Cup in Tokyo Nov. 24. His trainer Bart Cummings said Wednesday, "You wouldn't know he's run and won the Melbourne Cup. He's taken no harm from the race. As long as everything goes well, he'll be off to Japan, and everything has gone well so far." Saintly will be the only representative from Oceania in the Japan Cup, following the withdrawal of **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}). The last Australian winner of the Japan Cup was Better Loosen Up in 1990.

Montecito, the most experienced runner in the seven-horse field with nine previous starts under her belt, finished second in a Santa Anita allowance in her most recent outing Oct. 16. Trying turf for the first time here as the 3-1 third choice, the dark bay filly rallied along the rail to take the lead at the top of the stretch and win under a hand ride. A number of fillies were spooked by a pack of ducks on the turf course when the field turned for home. "As for what happened with the ducks, they flew up and all the horses in front of me scattered," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "I got through on the rail. As I was getting through, one flew up and hit me directly in the head. It kind of dazed me a little bit. I wasn't real sure of where I was for about an eighth of a mile. But when I figured out where I was, I was in the right spot. In front. But that duck that hit me, he left a little reminder on my silks. Guess he felt at home with the Oregon Ducks colors I was wearing." Montecito's owners Bob and Beverly Lewis race in green and yellow silks to honor their alma mater, the Oregon Ducks. Jeff Lukas, assistant to winning trainer D. Wayne Lukas, said the GII \$200,000 Miesque S. at Hollywood Park Nov. 29 will be next for Montecito.

CHARLES TOWN GETS VIDEO LOTTERY

TERMINALS By a margin of over 3,400 votes, the electorate of Jefferson County, West Virginia Tuesday approved the installation of Video Lottery Terminals (VLTs) at the Charles Town Races. Of 12,343 ballots cast, 7,880 (63%) were in favor of VLTs, while 4,463 (36.2%) were opposed. "I can't begin to tell you how pleased I am," said Charles Town President Roger R. Ramey. "This clears the way for Penn National Gaming Inc. to purchase the track. The sale should be completed within the next month, and after a period of extensive renovations, a new and energized racing program will begin here next Spring." The Nov. 5 VLT referendum won out in 24 of Jefferson County's 26 voting districts. In 1994, a nearly identical referendum lost in 17 of the county's districts. "I want to personally thank the citizens of Jefferson County for their support," Ramey added. "They have given us the opportunity to assure that the 63-year heritage of the Charles Town Races, and the jobs it provides, will continue."

TURFWAY PARK HOLIDAY MEET BEGINS

DECEMBER 1 Turfway Park will open its gates for the 1996 Holiday Meet Sunday, Dec. 1. The 22-day season runs through Dec. 31 and is highlighted by five stakes events, including the \$60,000 Holiday Inaugural opening day. Racing will be conducted on a Wednesday through Sunday basis, with the exception of Christmas Day, Wednesday, Dec. 25, when the track will be closed. First post time Wednesdays through Fridays is 7 p.m., with a 1 p.m. post time Saturdays and Sundays. Turfway will conclude its Holiday Meet with six consecutive days of afternoon racing beginning Thursday, Dec. 26 through Tuesday, Dec. 31. The special first post for the final week of the meet is at 1 p.m.
