**RELAUNCH SUCCUMBS TO COLIC** Hillary J. Boone III, general manager of Wimbledon Farm, announced yesterday that the 20-year-old stallion **Relaunch** (In Reality) died on the evening of November 5 of acute colic. The horse had been admitted to the Hagyard-Davidson-McGee Veterinary Clinic earlier in the week after exhibiting neurological signs consistent with equine protozoal myelitis. A multiple-graded stakes winner, Relaunch stood his entire stud career at Wimbledon in Lexington, Kentucky. Since his third crop of foals hit the racetracks, his progeny have averaged over \$3.1 million in earnings per year, and he has ranked in the top 10 on the General Sire List six times. His top runners to date have been multimillionaires **Waquoit** and Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Skywalker**; he is also the sire of 1996 three-year-old **Honour and Glory**, who took this year's GI Met Mile in stakes record time.

**HALLING RETIRED** **Halling** (Diesis {GB}), the only horse ever to win both Sandown's G1 Coral Eclipse S. and York's G1 Juddmonte International S. in two consecutive seasons, has been retired. The five-year-old will stand as a stallion in 1997 at Sheikh Mohammed's Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket, England. His covering fee is to be 12,000 pounds (\$18,780). Halling won four races as a three-year-old, including the prestigious Cambridgeshire H. at Newmarket. But, after switching to the Godolphin team, his status steadily rose and he completed his unique "double-double" of Group One races by making all the running under Frankie Dettori to collect the 1996 Juddmonte International by three lengths August 20. His last racecourse appearance saw him finish second to **Bosra Sham** (Woodman) in Newmarket's G1 Dubai Champion S. October 19. He retires with a record of 12 wins from 18 career starts; his European earnings total more than \$1.2 million.

**T.V. COMMERCIAL DEAD** **T.V. Commercial** (T.V. Lark), who sired 27 stakes winners in 18 crops with total progeny earnings of \$15,637,399, died yesterday at the Northview Stallion Station at the age of 31. A multiple-stakes winner of \$404,034, the stallion stood his entire career in Chesapeake City, Maryland, first at Woodstock Farm and then at Windfields Farm, before being pensioned to Northview in 1990.

**FASIG-TIPTON KENTUCKY'S FALL MIXED SALE BEGINS TODAY** Fasig-Tipton Kentucky's Fall Mixed Sale begins today at the Newtown Paddocks in Lexington, Kentucky. The sale will be conducted in four sessions. The first session, which begins this morning at 10 a.m., is an open session featuring broodmares, horses of racing age and stallions. An open session of weanlings will be held Saturday at 10 a.m., followed at 3 p.m. by a 53-horse Bridlewood Farm Reduction. The sale's first selected session, featuring weanlings, will commence Saturday evening at 5 p.m. The auction ends with a select session of broodmares, broodmare prospects, racing/broodmare prospects and a single stallion prospect--stakes-winner and MGSP **Myrmidon** (Rahy)--to be held Sunday night at 7:30 p.m.

**ARAZI, MIESQUE'S SON ARRIVE AT THREE CHIMNEYS** Three Chimneys Farm announced yesterday that 1991 Champion Two-Year-Old Colt and Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Arazi** (Blushing Groom {Fr}) and **Miesque's Son** (Mr. Prospector), one of the top sprinters in Europe in 1996, will be at Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky for breeders' inspections during the upcoming November Sales. Arazi is scheduled to arrive at Three Chimneys at about 7 a.m. this morning. Miesque's Son, traveling from France, arrived at the farm Wednesday. Arazi arrives from England, where he stood the last four years at Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's Dalham Hall Stud. Sheikh Mohammed retains ownership of the horse, whose 1997 fee will be \$30,000 live foal. The seven-year-old stallion's first foals are two-year-olds of 1996; he has two winners in the U.K. to date. Miesque's Son, a full-brother to French 2,000 Guineas winner Kingmambo, won this year's G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis over six furlongs. In his final career start Oct. 20, the four-year-old was second, beaten only a head, in the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp. His 1997 fee will be \$20,000 live foal.
