KEENELAND NOVEMBER STARTS

TODAY The 1996 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale begins today at 10:00 a.m. with the first of 11 sessions. A total of 3,844 horses, including 1,721 weanlings and 1,955 broodmares, have been catalogued for the sale, which runs through November 20. Highlighting the catalogue are weanling half-siblings to: Classic winner **Bet Twice** (Sportin' Life), a colt by Gilded Time; champion older horse **Blushing John** (Blushing Groom {Fr}), a colt by Seattle Slew; champion sprinter **Groovy** (Norcliffe), a colt by Storm Cat; champion sprinter **Housebuster** (Mt. Livermore), a filly by Deputy Minister; French champion **Pennekamp** (Bering {GB}), a filly by Storm Cat; MGISW **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled), a filly by Caerleon; and MGISW **Waquoit** (Relaunch), a filly by Capote. Broodmares on offer at the auction include **Ingot Way** (Diplomat Way), the dam of certain 1996 champion three-year-old **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), in foal to Skip Trial; **Most Precious** (Nureyev), dam of the ill-fated French Classic winner **Matiara** (Bering {GB}), in foal to Bering (GB); English champion **Only Royale (Ire)** (Caerleon), in foal to Holy Bull; and MGISW **Turnback The Alarm** (Darn That Alarm), in foal to Gone West. Windfields Farm completes its dispersal with a consignment of 41 broodmares and 29 weanlings at the November Sale. Last year, Keeneland sold 2,863 horses for a total of \$142,142,300 at its Breeding Stock Sale.

BRIDLEWOOD BROODMARE TOPS FASIG-

TIPTON SATURDAY **Stacie's Toy** (Baldski), a nine-year-old broodmare in foal to Jolie's Halo, brought a bid of \$75,000 to top the second session of the 1996 Fasig-Tipton Fall Mixed Sale, held yesterday in Lexington. Part of the Bridlewood Farm reduction, the stakes winner of \$450,753 was purchased by Eastside Stud. The top-selling weanling at the session was a colt by West by West out of Katie Ledyard (Danzig Connection). Consigned by Pillar Stud Inc., agent, the bay was purchased for \$40,000 by Franklin D. Franklin. A total of 353 horses sold for \$1,723,900 during the first book of the Fall Mixed Sale. The gross was up 22.6 percent from the comparable sessions in 1995, when 254 hips sold for \$1,405,600, but the 1996 average of \$4,884 was down 11.7 percent from last year's figure of \$5,534. The sale continued with a second Saturday session, which began at 5:00 p.m., and closes with a final session Sunday evening at 7:30 p.m.

Fast Catch, a winner in three of her last five starts while facing allowance foes at Churchill, Saratoga and Turfway, was the second longest shot on the board taking on graded stakes company but proved up to the task despite the odds. Rated in seventh through fast early fractions of :22 and :44 2/5, the dark bay dark horse moved closer as the field headed into the stretch and produced a strong late surge to catch 1-2 Serena's Song in the final yards. "She's been sharp lately and we just took a shot," said trainer Frank Brothers. "A mile is her distance, and we were in light--sometimes things just work out. It was a hot pace and she's a filly that comes from off the pace. We got lucky and we got 16 pounds from the queen." The impost may have cost Serena's Song the victory but it did not cost her the record as North America's all-time leading distaff money earner. With her second-place purse, the Team Lukas star brought her bankroll to \$3,283,398, surpassing the previous and controversial mark of \$3,263,836 (much of which is in Canadian dollars) set by Dance Smartly.

The Washington Horse Racing Commission Friday awarded racing dates for the 1996-97 winter season to both Emerald Downs and Playfair Race Course. The two tracks will be operating in direct competition, with Emerald Downs racing Fridays through Sundays from December 6 through March 2, and Playfair offering live cards on the same days December 6 through March 23. A statement made by the Commission said, "It is in the best interests of racing to attempt to structure an innovative and experimental award of racing dates that will be of maximum benefit to the industry participants. It should be stressed this is experimental in nature and not intended to be precedent setting." The winter dates became available after Apple Tree Turf Associates, operators of Yakima Meadows, informed the Commission October 18 that they would be able to conduct their scheduled November through March meet.
