MILLION-DOLLAR MARES AT KEENELAND NOVEMBER

Two broodmares topped the million-dollar mark as the 1996 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale opened yesterday. Bringing the highest bid at the opening session of the 11-day auction was the 11-year-old **Most Precious** (Nureyev), who was purchased for \$1,450,000 by John Magnier. The dam of last year's French 1000 Guineas winner **Matiara**, who suffered a fatal injury in this year's GI Beverly D., was consigned by Hagyard Farm, agent, as part of the Societe Aland dispersal; she is in foal to **Matiara's** sire, **Bering** (GB). Magnier indicated that the mare had been purchased for a partnership which includes **Michael Tabor**, and that she will be sent to **Tabor's** Eclipse Award winner **Thunder Gulch** next season. Also making seven figures was the English champion **Only Royale (Ire)** (Caerleon). In foal to **Holy Bull**, the seven-year-old retired last year after winning nine races, including the G1 Yorkshire Oaks twice, and over \$500,000; she was named the highweight older mare at 11-14 furlongs in England three straight years, and the highweight mare on the European Free Handicap at 11-13.5 furlongs once. Consigned by Adena Springs, agent, she was purchased for \$1,200,000 by Eugenio Colombo, agent. "She's staying with us," said Adena Springs owner **Frank Stronach**. "I owned her in partnership before the sale, so I own her 100 percent now. She'll stay at Adena. We're looking forward to her foal--we like **Holy Bull**." Windfields Farm completed its dispersal of broodmares and weanlings Sunday, selling 68 horses for a total of \$7,238,000, an average of \$106,441. Included in the legendary farm's final consignment were three of yesterday's top five weanlings. Windfields' colt by **Kingmambo** out of stakes winner **Play all Day** (Steady Growth) brought the highest price for a weanling Sunday, attracting a bid of \$300,000 from **Shadwell Estate Co. Ltd.** A total of 220 horses sold Sunday, bringing \$27,998,000 for an average of \$127,264. The gross was up 22.4 percent from the '95 opener, when 185 hips brought \$22,864,200, an average of \$123,590. The average was up 2.9 percent from 1995. The sale continues through November 20, with the second session beginning today at 10:00 a.m.

THE OPPENHEIM REPORT: AT THE KEENELAND

SALES...Big news of the week is Ashford/Coolmore's acquisition of **Cigar** (Palace Music). There's a strong vibe among breeders that if Coolmore has that much confidence in him, he'll work commercially. John Magnier says they're being "swamped" with applications at \$75,000. It just shows what a huge player Coolmore is in the stallion business...Frank Stronach's Adena Springs Farm is a huge consignor at this sale, and Stronach reportedly bought out partners when agent Eugenio Colombo signed for **Only Royale (Ire)** (Caerleon) for \$1.2-million Sunday. Interestingly, she was in foal to Holy Bull. He's slightly a forgotten man with all the hoopla over Cigar, but the fact is his speed figures were always about the same level. The knockers knock his pedigree, too, but Great Above was pretty well-bred himself, and was always a hard-knocking Florida sire. Holy Bull's inbred to Mahmoud on the bottom (out of an Al Hattab mare, out of a Grey Dawn mare), and just might be a good buy himself at \$25,000...Speaking of hot sires, how about A.P. Indy? I love the start he's made, three stakes winners already, and they sure figure to be better at three than two. This is a Seattle Slew-Alydar-Fappiano-type start, even if he doesn't finish up top of the Freshman Sire List...Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell Stud was among the interesting foal buyers on Sunday, including a Kingmambo colt for \$300,000 and a Dixieland Band colt for \$190,000...a new name on the buyer's sheets is that of Frances Genter Williams, who bought two mares for \$500,000 to go to Unbridled. Yep, she's a daughter of the late Frances Genter. The Minnesota resident was assisted at the sale by son Hal Williams and the team from Florida's Silverleaf Farm...Windfields VP Ric Waldman was well satisfied with the day's proceedings when I talked to him toward the session's end. "We'll be up about 15-18% over projections," Waldman reported. "Considering we had no superstars, we're gratified with the market's broad acceptance of our overall program." Four Windfields mares brought \$350,000 or more, and they had the session's top weanling, the \$300,000 Kingmambo colt. *Bill Oppenheim is a journalist and consultant specializing in pedigrees, sires and the auction market. FASIG-TIPTON FALL RESULTS A colt by Seattle Slew out of GISW Top Corsage (Topsider) brought a bid of \$150,000 to top the third session of Fasig-Tipton's 1996 Fall Mixed Sale, held Saturday night at Newton Paddocks. The bay, consigned by Jeffry Morris' Highclere, Agent III, was purchased by Kim Nardelli, agent. A total of 108 horses sold for \$2,606,300 during the offering of selected weanlings. The gross was up 29.9 percent from the 1995 selected weanling session, when 65 horses sold for \$2,005,000; the 1996 average of \$24,132 was down 21.7 percent from the average of \$30,846 a year ago. The final session of the Fall Mixed Sale was held last night, and the session topper was seven-year-old **White Corners** (Caro {Ire}), in foal to Unbridled. Consigned by Muirfield East, agent for the Estate of Leonard Pearlstein and Partners, the stakes-winning mare attracted a bid of \$330,000 from Nicoma/Grassick Bloodstock. The second-highest price Sunday night came in for graded-stakes placed six-year-old **Fondly Remembered** (Skywalker); in foal to Wild Again, the dark bay was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, Agent XII, and purchased for \$250,000 by Nicoma Bloodstock. Final results of the Fasig-Tipton Fall Mixed Sale will be in tomorrow's edition.

Still out of it on the turn, Love View began passing horses at the top of the stretch, finally taking the lead at the sixteenth pole to draw away to a three-length win. "I knew he was going to take a while to figure out what he's doing; it took all summer to learn how to gallop," winning trainer David Bell admitted after the race. "He has shown us some talent, though and he's done everything right so far." The trainer added that Love View will be headed for next year's Queen's Plate. "We're definitely pointing him toward the Plate. He's a mile-and-a-quarter horse."

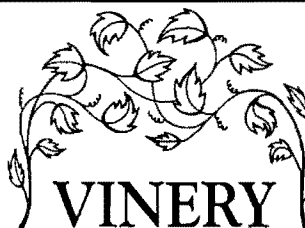
