MARIAH'S STORM SELLS FOR \$2.6 MILLION

AT KEENELAND *Mariah's Storm* (Rahy), a MGSW of \$724,895, brought over 3½-times that yesterday at the second session of the 1996 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. John Magnier purchased the five-year-old bay mare, in foal to Storm Cat, for \$2.6 million on behalf of a partnership that includes Michael Tabor. "She's going to Cigar," Magnier said. "Our pedigree people thought that it would fit well." The second highest-priced broodmare yesterday was **At the Half** (Seeking the Gold), winner of the Gill Golden Rod S. and \$338,393. In foal to Storm Cat, the dark bay or brown mare was purchased for \$950,000 by Will Farish, owner of Lane's End Farm in Versailles, Kentucky. "She'll be a Lane's End mare," said Farish, who also commented on the sale overall. "The quality horses are really bringing the premium in every category," he said. "I think there's a lot of optimism around."

STORM CAT WEANLING COLT BRINGS

RECORD \$1.4 MILLION A dark bay or brown weanling colt by Storm Cat--Tinnitus (Restless Wind) brought a top bid of \$1.4 million at Keeneland yesterday, the record price for a weanling colt at the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. The previous record of \$1,175,000 was held by Razeen, a Northern Dancer colt purchased by Darley Stud Management in 1987. Razeen went on to win a listed stake in England, place in a pair of graded stakes at Hollywood Park and earn \$108,667. Monday's Storm Cat colt was purchased by Irish veterinarian Demi O'Byrne, agent for Michael Tabor and Robert & Beverly Lewis. The colt is a half-brother to Champion Sprinter Groovy and to Harbor Springs, the dam of 1996 Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Boston Harbor. "The bidding went over a million before I got in," said O'Byrne. "This was a very exceptional weanling. When I saw him, I liked him. I hope he's lucky now. That's the most important part. If he can be lucky, he can be a nice horse." O'Byrne said the weanling, the third horse to be owned together by Tabor and the Lewises, will be raced by the partnership and will be trained by D. Wayne Lukas. The second highest-priced weanling yesterday at an even \$1 million was a bay filly by Mr. Prospector--Angel Fever (Danzig). Purchased by Robert & Beverly Lewis, she was the fourth highest-priced weanling filly in the sale's history, the first being Ghashtah, by Nijinsky II--My Charmer, who brought \$2.3 million in 1987.

KEENELAND MONDAY WRAP-UP Monday's second session of the 1996 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale saw 264 horses sell for a gross of \$46,322,500 and an average of \$175,464, up 19.76 percent from last year's second session average of \$146,516. Yesterday's median price was \$120,000. Through the first two days of the auction, 484 horses have sold for a total of \$74,320,500 and an average of \$153,555. The 11-day sale runs through Nov. 20.

THE OPPENHEIM REPORT: ON CAMPUS AT KEENELAND...

Note from late Sunday...What a great tribute to the late Roland de Chambire and his longtime partner Alec Head to see the Societe Aland's mare Most Precious, dam of Matiara and Precious Ring, top the session for \$1,450,000 to Coolmore's John Magnier...It was all European money at the finish of the bidding for Mariah's Storm Monday. Rick Nichols of Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell Estates was in at \$2.4 million for the Rahy mare in foal to Storm Cat. Agent Charlie Gordon-Watson, accompanied by the Lloyd-Webber's manager Simon Marsh, stepped in for one bid at \$2.5 million, but John Magnier trumped them both with his one and only bid of \$2.6 million. "I loved her from the day I saw her beat Serena's Song at Churchill," said agent Demi O'Byrne. "I believe she goes to Cigar." O'Byrne later paid \$1.4 million for a Storm Cat weanling half-brother to Groovy...Gordon-Watson gained some compensation a few lots after Mariah's Storm when he signed the ticket for \$600,000 for 1993 Irish 1000 Guineas winner Nicer. Rick Nichols has been supporting the foal market, adding five today to his two yesterday, for \$1.5-million. ...Pinhooking Notes: Florida's Ken Ellenberg, who spent a few quid on yearlings in Europe this autumn is buying a few foals, too. Signing as Cypress Farms, he bought an Unbridled colt for \$180,000 Sunday, and splashed out \$235,000 for a Pleasant Colony colt out of Gils Magic Monday morning ...

...Our old running mate Allan Lavin from Longfield Farm was busy buying mares for the farm's new stallions, Northern Spur and Ide. "Good reception from the breeders," reports Lavin. "We tried to price them commercially, at \$10,000 and \$5,000 respectively." Strong, strong market in general...Buyers paid a 60 percent premium in many cases to get the best.

CLAIBORNE ACQUIRES INTEREST IN

ORDWAY Claiborne Farm has purchased a minority interest in the two-year-old **Ordway** (Salt Lake), winner of this year's GI Moet Champagne S. and third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. The colt will continue to run in the colors of owners William J. Punk and Philip Dileo. Trained by David Donk, Ordway will begin his three-year-old campaign at Gulfstream Park. "We are excited about both Ordway's racing ability and his future potential as a stallion," said Claiborne spokesperson Dell Hancock. "His pedigree, with Salt Lake's current success, makes him an attractive addition to our stallion roster."

FASIG-TIPTON FALL WRAP-UP The final session of the 1996 Fasig-Tipton Fall Mixed Sale was held Sunday night at Lexington's Newton Paddocks, with 51 selected broodmares grossing \$2,591,000 for an average of \$50,804. The gross was down 45.1 percent from last year's final session, which saw 97 horses bring in \$4,720,700, but the average was up 4.3 percent from the '95 figure of \$48,667. A total of 159 horses sold for \$5,197,300 during the two selected sessions of the 1996 auction, averaging \$32,687. The gross revenues were down 22.7 percent, while the average was down 21.2 percent. Last year's selected sessions saw 162 hips sell for \$6,725,700, an average of \$41,517.

EMERALD WINS NEW ZEALAND CLASSIC In only her third lifetime start, the filly **Emerald** (Grosvenor), trained by John Gudopp, son-in-law of the filly's Cambridge-based owner and former trainer Jim Campin, won Saturday's G1 \$70,701 One Thousand Guineas over a mile at Riccarton, Christchurch, New Zealand. Runner-up was the filly **Bubble** (Sir Tristram), who will now attempt to go one better when she takes on the colts in Wednesday's G1 \$88,377 Television New Zealand Two Thousand Guineas over a mile at the same track.

MONTH Jockey Corey Nakatani, who won back-to-back Breeders' Cup races aboard **Lit de Justice** (El Gran Senor) in the Sprint and **Jewel Princess** (Key to the Mint) in the Distaff, has been named the *Cobra Golf/Thoroughbred Daily News* Subscriber of the Month for October. Nakatani, 0-for-12 in the Breeders' Cup before this year's event, became just the third rider in history to win consecutive Breeders' Cup races. Nakatani will receive a set of King Cobra golf clubs, the country's leading irons and woods, in recognition of the honor. "I'd like to thank King Cobra for sponsoring this award in the *Thoroughbred Daily News*," said Nakatani. "As bad as my golf game is right now, I could use a set of irons and woods. Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's four-year-old colt **Flemensfirth (Alleged)**, winner of Sunday's **G1 Premio Roma** in Italy and dual winner of the **G2 Prix Dollar** at **Longchamp**, will definitely stay in training in 1997, with either the \$4 million **Dubai World Cup** in March or the **G1 Prix Ganay** at **Longchamp** in May as his first major target.

Belmez (El Gran Senor), winner of the **G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S.** in 1990, is on the move. The nine-year-old stallion has been standing at the **Royal Stud at Sandringham** in Norfolk, England, but he will be resident next year at the **Haras de Chartreux** in **Calvados, France**. Kentucky-bred **Belmez** was one of the best three-year-olds in Europe in 1990, also winning the **G2 Great Voltigeur S.** and the **G3 Dalham Chester Vase** and finishing third in the **G1 Budweiser Irish Derby**. He won five of seven starts for earnings of \$780,366. From his three crops of racing age, he has sired **Caramba (GB)**, winner of the **G2 Falmouth S.** and **G2 Vodafone Nassau S.**, and **Spanish Falls (GB)**, who took this year's **G3 Prix de Royaumont**.
