### PRINCESS POLONIA TOPS KEENELAND

**THURSDAY** Princess Polonia (Danzig), a Grade III winner of \$455,213, topped Thursday's fifth session of the 1996 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. The six-year-old mare, in foal to Meadowlake, was purchased by William S. Farish for \$370,000. Overall, eight horses--five broodmares and three weanlings--were sold yesterday for price tags of \$150,000 or more. In contrast, during last year's corresponding fifth session, there was only one horse sold for \$150,000 or more, a weanling colt by Gilded Time--For Dixie, who brought exactly \$150,000 to top the session. Keeneland sold 271 horses yesterday for a gross of \$11,365,700 and an average of \$41,940, up 36 percent from last year's fifth session average of \$30,828. The sale continues through Nov. 20.

### TRAINER BUTCH LENZINI JR. FOUND DEAD

Trainer John J. "Butch" Lenzini Jr. was found dead in his apartment Wednesday. The cause of death has not yet been determined. Lenzini, 49, was born in Weymouth, Massachusetts. He worked two summers in New England for his father, trainer John Lenzini Sr. After spending time at both the University of Rhode Island and Kansas State University, Lenzini took out his trainers license. He is probably best known for winning the 1982 Preakness with Aloma's Ruler. Among the other stakes-winners he trained were Wood Memorial winner Eternal Prince; Royal Ski, a top two-year-old in 1976; Best by Test, Boom Towner and Once Wild. After moving his stable to New York in 1984, he finished among the top 10 trainers from 1985-1989. Funeral arrangements are tentative with visitation planned for Sunday at the Manning-Heffernan Funeral Home at 68 Broadway in Pawtucket, Rhode Island with a funeral Monday.

**Windsharp** (Lear Fan), who has beaten males twice this year, prepared for her first 1996 start against fillies and mares Thursday with a five-furlong work in :59 2/5 over Hollywood's main track. "It was a very nice work," trainer Wally Dollase said. "She went slow and finished terrific." The five-year-old mare, fifth in the Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup Turf, is slated to run next in the GI \$700,000 Matriarch Dec. 1. "She ran great in the Breeders' Cup, beating so many good males," Dollase added. "We all know what she can do against colts, now we'll get to see how she does against fillies."

Also working for the Dec. 1 Matriarch, GI Gamely H. winner **Auriette (Ire)** (Caerleon) breezed six furlongs in 1:16 2/5 over Hollywood Park's turf course.

**Local News, Australia:**

The effect of shuttle stallions on the Australian bloodstock market is reaching new heights, as evidenced by the release of the sales preview by auctioneers William Inglis & Son. Several Northern Hemisphere-based stallions have their first Southern Hemisphere lots entered in Inglis' Easter, Premier and Classic sales in 1997. The phenomenal success of Danehill has seen buyers go "shuttle crazy," which augers well for stallions like Brief Truce (23 lots), Royal Academy (38), Mukaddamah (12) and Night Shift (7). Other stallions represented are Personal Hope (10), Casual Lies (5) and Waajib (Ire) (3). Another result of improved transport arrangements is the presence of several yearlings conceived in the Northern Hemisphere to Southern hemisphere time. These include four lots by Sadler's Wells, two by Seattle Slew, and each one by Fairy King and Chief's Crown.

The Melbourne Cup-winning combination of Darren Beadman and **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}) will compete together in the Japan Cup November 24 after the jockey's careless riding suspension was reduced on appeal. His suspension, incurred for his ride in the VRC Oaks, was due to end November 30 but was reduced by a week by the newly formed VRC Appeals Board. There was however a catch as he was fined \$7,900 (\$10,000 Australian) as an alternative, the money being donated to the VRC Disadvantaged Trainers & Jockeys Fund. Saintly has already arrived in Japan and is said to be in good shape after his trip.
