### MARE IN FOAL TO GO FOR GIN TOPS

**KEENELAND FRIDAY Countess Steffi** (Geiger Counter), a seven-year-old mare in foal to Kentucky Derby winner Go for Gin, brought a top price of \$180,000 during Friday's session of the 1996 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. A multiple-stakes winner of \$594,275 pregnant with her first foal, she was consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, and purchased by Nobuo Tsunoda. The second highest price at the session was the \$165,000 paid for a weanling colt by Salt Lake. The chestnut, consigned by Robert E. Courtney/Crestfield Farm LLC, agent for Dr. J. David Richardson, was purchased by Ken Ellenberg's Cypress Farms. A total of 298 horses sold Friday for \$8,986,000, up 50.3 percent from last year's comparable sixth session when 261 hips sold for \$5,976,200. The 1996 average of \$30,154 is up 31.6 percent from the '95 sixth-session average of \$22,897. The sale continues through Wednesday.

**EARL OF BARKING RETIRED** Millionaire **Earl Of Barking (Ire)** (Common Grounds {GB}), second in a photo in the Henry P. Russell H. October 12 in his last start, has been retired. "He's done nothing but good for a long, long time," said trainer Richard Cross. "I would have liked to run him in the Citation (November 30), but he had some small problems. But for a neck, he would have gone out a winner." The six-year-old Grade I winner won nine of his 37 career starts and \$1,230,992. Stud plans have not yet been announced.

**FLORIDA DRUG TESTING VINDICATED** After nearly three months of investigations, the Florida Chief Inspector General's Office reported yesterday that six of the seven allegations made by whistle-blowers against the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering Drug Laboratory last August were either unfounded or that results of their investigation were inconclusive. The whistle-blowers had claimed that lab technicians were using outdated Elisa drug tests. According to the report, "Interviews and reviews of material provided during the investigation revealed some justification and validation for the use of expired Elisa test kits." To back up their findings, the CIG office referred to a letter written by Dr. Mona Boules from the University of Florida, College of Veterinary Medicine, which stated, "I can say that as long as the positive and negative control samples gave the expected results, and as long as the kit produces a standard curve, we usually use the results for publication even if the kit had expired." The one charge the CIG did find credible was that a piece of lab equipment purchased in 1988 for \$417,025 was never used because no one was ever trained in its operation; it was subsequently sold to the Florida State University for \$40,000 in 1996. There is a second piece of robotic equipment, purchased three years ago, that remains untouched because lab personnel were never trained to run it. The CIG office did suggest the lab conduct an internal audit and a formal management review of certain laboratory processes and management controls.
