KEENELAND NOVEMBER STILL GOING

STRONG Continuing the trend of the first six days of the sale, both gross and average for the seventh session of the 1996 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale showed significant increases over the comparable session in 1995. A total of 276 hips sold for \$7,051,300 during Saturday's bidding, up 42.8 percent from the seventh-session gross of \$4,936,700 for 281 horses a year ago. The 1996 average of \$25,548 marked a gain of 45.4 percent from the '95 average of \$17,568. Two broodmares brought \$175,000 to top the bidding Saturday. The first to go through the ring was **Vienna Charm (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), a four-year-old in foal to Gilded Time. Consigned by Adena Springs, agent, the filly was purchased by Mrs. G. M. McAlmont of Yeomanstown Lodge Stud. Bringing the same price was the 14-year-old **Cheerily** (Drone), in foal to Alydeed. The dam of multiple-stakes winners **Canadian Silver** (Geiger Counter) and **Cheery Knight** (Ascot Knight) was consigned by Anderson Farms, agent, and purchased by Payson Stud. The sale continues through Wednesday.

"RICK" NOT TOO QUICK AT LOS ALAMITOS

He didn't win it, but things are looking up for **Rick's Natural Star** (Natural Native). Making his first start since his celebrated last-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, the seven-year-old finished sixth of seven in an allowance race at Los Alamitos in California Friday night. Behind the field most of the way, he came on late to beat one horse, finishing 11 lengths behind the winner as one of two Thoroughbreds facing Quarter Horses in the 870-yard dash. There was \$2,767 bet on the 10-1 shot. Owner William Livingston was paid a \$5,000 appearance fee to bring the horse to Los Alamitos, and would have picked up a \$40,000 bonus if his horse could have won. "I'm disappointed, but I'm not devastated," he told the *Los Angeles Times* after the race. "I still think he's a stakes horse." Ricks Natural Star will now ship to Turf Paradise, where Livingston said he may run in claiming races.

Five-year-old Come on Flip was seeking the first graded stakes win of his career and first win of any kind since taking the Cicero Mile H. at Sportsman's Park in April '95. "This is the best day I've had in my career," said jubilant rider Chris Emigh. "He warmed up great and broke close and just glided across the ground all the way. He just sat so easy for me. Miss Caerleona, winner of the Sixty Sails H. at Fair Grounds this past January and most recently fourth in the GI Flower Bowl H. Oct. 12, earned the first graded win of her career via a disqualification. While Miss Caerleona settled into fifth down the backside, favored Bail Out Becky raced seventh until the three-quarters pole; the two rallied as a team, but the original first-place finisher, coming up the inside, bumped Miss Caerleona as she rummaged for running room at the three-sixteenth pole before drawing away down the lane. "Once I committed to make my move, I was there and (jockey) Larry (Melancon) wanted to hold me in there and he didn't have enough horse to do it," said Craig Perret on the disqualified favorite. "Miss Caerleona came on through and the hole opened up. I didn't think it was fair, and anytime you come down, no one thinks it's fair. You can't change the outcome but it's a shame she has to lose it that way because she was much the best." Niall O'Callaghan, trainer of Miss Caerleona, said, "It was evident that the rider (Perret) had more horse than we had at that time, but the rule is you can't come out and bump another horse."
