ALLEGED MARE TOPS AT KEENELAND A four-year-old unraced broodmare in foal to West by West brought a top price of \$90,000 during Sunday's session of Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale. Tik-Tik Trinidad bought the mare, **Alley Aggie** (Alleged) from Walmac International, Agent. The West by West foal will be Alley Aggie's first. West by West's first foals are weanlings this year. He earned \$1,038,123 during his racing career. Keeneland sold 263 horses during Sunday's session for \$4,362,000. The average of \$16,568 is up 16 percent from last year's comparable session. In last year's eighth session, 280 horses were sold for \$3,973,100, an average of \$14,190. With three days remaining in the 11-day auction, gross sales total \$163,969,500--third highest in the history of the November sale--for 2,160 horses. The average is \$75,912. The sale continues through Wednesday.

CORREGGIO TAKES COLONIAL CUP Jockey Jeff Teter closed his 16-year steeplechase career in style Sunday with a wire-to-wire victory aboard Bill Lickle's **Correggio (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the \$100,000 GI Colonial Cup, the final race of the 1996 National Steeplechase Association calendar. The win proved definitive in many ways--it was Teter's first in the historic race, was the 34-year-old jockey's final ride in a career that began in 1991 and it probably clinched an Eclipse Award for Correggio. A two-time NSA champion jockey, Teter goes out as the leading active U.S. jump jockey with 221 career victories. Making just his sixth career hurdle start, the five-year-old Correggio assumed an easy lead and waited for challengers that never came. Winner of the Breeders' Cup Grand National Oct. 26, Correggio outfinished **Stop and Listen** (Sovereign Dancer) by one length with **Mr. Yankee (NZ)** (Americus {Ire}) third. Eclipse contender **Petroski** (Polish Navy) finished fourth after threatening on the turn while another potential Eclipse winner **Rowdy Irishman** (Erins Isle {Ire}) was a lackluster sixth. **Lonesome Glory** (Transworld), going for his third straight Colonial Cup win, finished a well-beaten fifth. The winner completed the course in 5:09 2/5, the fourth fastest time in 27 runnings. NSA year-end awards went to Bruce Miller (trainer) with 30 wins. Chip Miller, Bruce's son, took the jockey title 28-20 over his sister Blythe and Augustin Stable clinched the owner award with two wins Sunday.

JIMMY KILROE DEAD AT 84 Frank E. "Jimmy" Kilroe, a respected member of the racing community after working as an executive at tracks in California, New York and Chicago for nearly 50 years, died late Saturday at his home in Pasadena, California following a series of strokes. He was 84. Kilroe, who retired in 1990 as senior vice president of racing of the Los Angeles Turf Club and Oak Tree Racing Association, started his career in racing at New York's old Jamaica Race Course, where his father was president. He was named racing secretary and handicapper for the New York Racing Association in 1954, where he stayed until 1960. After a stint in Chicago, he moved to California, and was named director of racing in 1973. Kilroe's many honors included an Eclipse Award of Merit in 1979, and the Joe Palmer Award from the National Turf Writers' Association in 1978. Plans for a memorial service are pending.

Iamacarr finished first in the Lady Fingers S. at Finger Lakes in August but was disqualified and placed fourth. Ryan Dant, an 8-year-old from Carrollton, Texas who is battling the rare genetic affliction Hunter's Disease, had one of his fondest dreams come true on Saturday at Churchill Downs. Ryan, whose life expectancy is 15 years, got lots of special attention from the Churchill jockey colony who dressed him in jockey silks, helmet, goggles and boots and he carried a rider's crop given him by Hall of Fame jockey Pat Day. The Dant family holds a benefit golf scramble and auction each year to raise money for the Ryan Foundation, which then turns over the money raised to support research on Hunter's Disease being conducted at UCLA in Los Angeles. 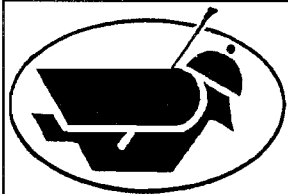
