KEENELAND NOVEMBER SALE ENDS WITH HUGE INCREASES

Keeneland's marathon 1996 November Breeding Stock Sale ended Wednesday with double digit increases in both gross sales and average price. Keeneland sold 2,830 horses during the 11-day auction for a gross of \$170,925,800, an increase of 20.5 percent from \$141,897,300 last year. The number of horses sold was down 1.1 percent from 2,861 in 1995. It was the third highest gross in the history of the Breeding Stock Sale. Only the 1983 and 1984 totals--\$191,957,900 and \$181,545,300 respectively--were higher. During both the 1983 and 1984 sales, horses which failed to reach their reserve bids were included in Keeneland's sales totals. That policy was changed in 1985 to omit RNAs from the totals. This year's average, \$60,398, represented a 21.8 percent increase from \$49,597 last year. It was the highest average for a Breeding Stock Sale in the decade of the 1990s. Seven horses brought \$1 million or more during the auction, topped by the \$2.6 million paid by John Magnier for **Mariah's Storm** (Rahy). The five-year-old broodmare is in foal to Storm Cat. Demi O'Byrne, agent, paid a sale record for a weanling colt, bidding \$1.4 million for a colt by Storm Cat--Tinnitus. O'Byrne, an Irish veterinarian, bought the weanling for the partnership of Michael Tabor and Mr. and Mrs. Robert Lewis. During yesterday's final session of the Keeneland sale, **Easy Virtue** (Tejano), a four-year-old broodmare in foal to Carr de Naskra, brought a top price of \$46,000. A half-sister to MSW Carrbine Special (Carr de Naskra), Easy Virtue was consigned by Gemstone Farm, agent I, and purchased by Bill Tracy, agent. Overall, 172 horses were sold Wednesday for a gross of \$1,156,400, an average of \$6,723 and a median price of \$4,200.

CHELSEY FLOWER RETIRED This year's GI Flower Bowl Invitational winner **Chelsey Flower** (His Majesty) has been retired from racing. The five-year-old mare, who also recorded wins in this year's GII Sheepshead Bay H. and the 1993 GIII Miss Grillo S., made her final start a seventh-place showing in the Nov. 3 GI Yellow Ribbon. She retires to Taylor Made Farm in Nicholasville, Kentucky with eight wins from 34 starts and earnings of \$568,305.

Advancing Star ran Beyer Figures of over 100 in each of her first four career starts, breaking her maiden by eight lengths in Oct. '95, winning the Maker's Mark S., finishing second to Cara Rafaela in last year's GI Hollywood Starlet then resurfacing at three to take the C.E.R.F. S. at Del Mar Aug. 22. The bay filly then posted fourth-place efforts in her last two outings, the GII Turfway Park Breeders' Cup S. and GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H.--both against older fillies and mares. Back against three-year-olds here, Advancing Star was sent off the 4-5 favorite and she dominated the five-horse field, forcing the early pace along the rail, taking the lead midway on the backside and drawing off for the victory. "When I saw the half-mile in :43 2/5, I thought the clock was broken," said winning trainer Richard Mandella. "That was fast! It must be downhill out of the chute. She's such a special sprinter--as good as any sprinter. The last couple of times she had run, she was hanging out and bearing out to the right. We put the blinkers on today to try and bring her in. I think we solved that problem. We'll point her to the seven-furlong La Brea S. at Santa Anita opening weekend (Dec. 29). It's a Grade II and part of the La Canada series."

Matriarch Field Takes Shape A star-studded cast of 16 fillies and mares--including 12 Grade I winners--is shaping up for the GI \$700,000 Matriarch S., to be run at 1 1/4-miles over the Hollywood Park turf Dec. 1. "It's one of the best races of the year," said Ben Cecil, trainer of **Donna Viola (GB)** (Be My Chief), who took the GI Yellow Ribbon S. in her last outing. "Whoever wins the Matriarch should win the Eclipse Award. But Timarida will be very tough to beat." **Timarida (Ire)** (Kalaglow {Ire}), who this year won a Group 1 race in Germany, the GI Beverly D. at Arlington and the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown in succession, breezed six furlongs over the Hollywood Park turf Wednesday morning in 1:16 4/5. Also prepping for the Matriarch yesterday were **Windsharp** (Lear Fan) and **Real Connection** (Vigors), who both went seven furlongs in 1:27 3/5 on the grass, and **Auriette (Ire)** (Caerleon), who drilled seven furlongs on the main track in 1:26. Other probables for the race are GI Oak Tree Turf Championship S. winner **Admise (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}); last year's Yellow Ribbon heroine **Alpride (Ire)** (Alzao); 1995 GI Del Mar Oaks victress **Bail Out Becky** (Red Ransom); Italian import **De Puntillas (GB)** (Distant Relative {Ire}); GI Three Chimneys Spinster winner **Different (Arg)** (Candy Stripes); Yellow Ribbon third **Dixie Pearl** (Dixie-land Band); 1995 Matriarch champ **Duda** (Theatrical {Ire}); **Hollywood Dream (Ger)** (Master Willie {GB}), a Group 1 winner in Italy and Germany this year; GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup heroine **Memories of Silver** (Silver Hawk); Italian 1000 Guineas winner **Olimpia Dukakis (Ity)** (Isopach); and **Wandesta (GB)** (Nashwan), third in the Matriarch in both 1994 and 1995.

STORM CREEK TO MOCKINGBIRD FARM Storm Creek (Storm Cat), winner of the GIII Sheridan S. at Arlington Park in May, has been retired from racing and will enter stud in 1997 at Harry Mangurian Jr.'s Mockingbird Farm in Ocala, Florida. The three-year-old won four of 14 starts for earnings of \$183,887. He placed in four stakes--the Hawthorne Juvenile S. at two and the GIII Derby Trial, Great West S. and Promised City S. at three. Out of the stakes-winning Mr. Prospector mare Shawnee Creek, Storm Creek is a half-brother to stakes-winners Raft Trip (Assert {Ire}) and Rose Violet (Alleged). He will stand the 1997 breeding season for a fee of \$5,000 live foal.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

ONTARIO GETS VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINALS

The Ontario government has passed Bill 75, which makes video lottery terminals legal in Ontario, it was reported in today's *Daily Racing Form*. The VLTs will be allowed to make their first appearances at racetracks and charity casinos. That first phase could begin in four to six months. Ontario Horse Racing Industry Association Executive Director Jane Holmes told the *Form*, "Now we start discussions with the government as to the implementation, so that we can try to get the best deal possible for the horse racing industry."
