DOVE HUNT RETIRED TO LANE'S END Dove Hunt (Danzig) has been retired from racing and will enter stud in 1997 at W.S. Farish's Lane's End Farm in Versailles, Kentucky. A Lane's End homebred, Dove Hunt won 11 of 33 starts and \$732,998. His five graded stakes victories, from ages two to four, came in the Gill Belmont Breeders' Cup H., Gill Pilgrim S., Gill Laurel Futurity, Gill Fort Harrod S. and Gill Red Bank H. The top grass runner also placed in eight other stakes. In his final career start at Woodbine Oct. 25, the five-year-old was second to Ok By Me in the Sky Classic S. Out of Hunt's Lark, Dove Hunt is a half-brother to Grade I winner Lieutenant's Lark, MSW Rio's Lark and Down the Flag, a Group 3 winner in England. He will stand for \$7,500 live foal as the property of Lane's End.

HELISSIO TAKES CARTIER Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King) dominated Tuesday night's Cartier 1996 Racing Awards dinner in London. According to a story in Wednesday's *Sporting Life*, Helissio, a winner of five of six starts last season, won horse of the year, champion three-year-old and leading three-year-old colt. Owner Alec Head and his daughter, trainer Criquelette Head, accepted champion sprinter honors for **Anabaa** (Danzig) and the champion two-year-old filly award for **Pas de Reponse** (Danzig). **Nononito (Fr)** (Nikos {GB}) was the leading stayer and **Bosra Sham** (Woodman) was named champion three-year-old filly. **Revoque (Ire)** (Fairy King) took the award for champion two-year-old, but **Bahamian Bounty (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) was named the top juvenile colt. Godolphin's **Halling** (Diesis {GB}) was named champion older horse and his regular rider Frankie Dettori was the winner of the Cartier award of merit.

JAPAN CUP-G1, \$3,000,000, 3yo/up, 12fT

A field of 16 has assembled for the 16th Japan Cup, headed by Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King). The colt, six-for-seven lifetime, would become the third three-year-old to win the Japan Cup, following **Le Glorieux (GB)** (Cure the Blues) in 1987 and **Half Iced** (Hatchet Man) in 1982. Also representing Europe are **Pentire (GB)** (Be My Guest), winner of the 1996 G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S.; **Strategic Choice** (Alleged), England's highweight older horse at 11 to 14 furlongs last year and a Group winner in Italy and France this season; and **Singspiel (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}), successful in the GI Canadian International and runner-up last time out in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. **Lando (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}) became the fourth European to take this event with his victory in last year's edition; Americans have won four times and horses from Oceania twice, but the Japanese have taken advantage of the home field five times, and have won three of the last four runnings. The two American representatives this year are **Awad** (Caveat), a good fifth in 1995 but looking for his first victory since the 1995 GI Arlington Million; and GII Bowling Green H. winner **Flag Down** (Deputy Minister). Melbourne Cup winner **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}) will represent Oceania. Last year's Japanese champion two-year-old colt **Bubble Gum Fellow (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence) leads the list of nine from Japan after accounting for the Fuji TV Sho Spring S. and Autumn Tenno Sho S. this campaign; 1995 Japanese champion three-year-old filly **Dance Partner (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence); and American-breds **Hishi Natalie** (Seattle Slew) and **Taiki Fortune** (Seattle Dancer) will also try to take it for the home team.

November 29-December 1, Hollywood Park:
HOLLYWOOD PARK TURF FESTIVAL

Twenty late nominations have been added to the sixth annual Turf Festival. The three-day festival consists of six stakes worth \$2.15-million.

Memories of Silver (Silver Hawk), winner of the GI Queen Elizabeth II Cup in stakes record time and fifth in the Breeders' Cup Mile, was supplemented to the Dec. 1 \$700,000 GI Matriarch. Also supplemented to the Matriarch, for \$30,000 each were **Hollywood Dream (Ger)** (Master Willie {GB}) and **Real Connection** (Vigors).

In other Matriarch news, trainer Ron McAnally said **Different (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) will not start. **Donna Viola (GB)** (Be My Chief) pulled a muscle and will also miss the race.

The Dec. 1 \$500,000 GI Crown Royal Hollywood Derby drew four late nominations. The connections of **Le Triton** (El Gran Senor), who won the G1 Prix Jean Prat in France and is now trained by Bill Mott, **Astor Place (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Lago** (Lac Ouimet) and **Take a Left (GB)** (Formidable) each paid \$17,500 to supplement their three-year-olds to the race.

There were eight late nominations of \$10,000 each to the Nov. 30 \$200,000 GIII Generous S. for two-year-olds: **Falkenham (GB)** (Polar Falcon), fifth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, **Bagshot** (Smokester), **Churchland (GB)** (Kylian), **Daylight in Dubai** (Twilight Agenda), **Demolition Man (GB)** (Primo Dominie {GB}), **Hello** (Phone Trick), **Serotonin** (Cure the Blues) and **Steel Ruhl** (Ruhlmann).

The Nov. 29 GIII \$200,000 Miesque S. for two-year-old fillies brought three \$10,000 late nominations: **Montecito** (Seeking the Gold), trained by D. Wayne Lukas; **Pun (GB)** (Batshoof {Ire}); and Cal Cup Juvenile Fillies winner **Rexy Sexy** (Huddle Up).

The lone supplemental entry in the \$200,000 GIII Hollywood Turf Express on Nov. 29 was **Track Gal** (Track Barron).

International Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc. have reported their results for the quarter ended September 30, 1996. The ITB realized a loss of \$530,488 during the first quarter of fiscal 1997, as compared to a loss of \$150,416 for the corresponding quarter a year ago. The increased loss primarily resulted from an increase in certain Corporate expenses associated with the development of casino gaming opportunities, the net loss generated by Garden State Park during the period; it was partially offset by an increase in the net income generated by Freehold Raceway during the comparable period. The loss per share was \$.05 as compared to a loss of \$.02 per share for the same quarter in the prior fiscal year.

Bucking the current local and national trend of declining on-track handle, Hawthorne Race Course is showing increases in both live and full-card handles on-track. Through the first 30 days of its 67-day Thoroughbred meeting, Hawthorne is generating an average daily on-track handle of \$402,480 for its live racing, up 4.42% from the \$385,457 per day wagered during a similar period one year ago. "Racing fans have responded to our full fields and lack of an on-track surcharge on winning wagers," said track President Thomas F. Carey.
