TATTERSALLS DECEMBER SALES STARTS

MONDAY Europe's largest-ever bloodstock sale, the Tattersalls December Sales, starts this Monday, November 25 and runs through Friday, December 6. The auction begins with over 400 yearlings representing top European stallions such as Sadler's Wells, Caerleon and Rainbow Quest, as well as leading U.S.-based stallions including Alleged, Diesis (GB), Dynaformer, El Gran Senor, Nureyev, Phone Trick, Silver Hawk, St. Jovite and Roanoke, whose yearling colt is a half-brother to GII E.P. Taylor winner **Wandering Star** (Red Ransom). Ten more U.S. sires have weanlings catalogued among the 890 on offer November 27-30, including Lear Fan and Tremolino, and 19 of the top 20 British and Irish-based stallions are also represented. Highlighting the weanling sessions will be a half-brother to Epsom and Irish Derby winner **Generous (Ire)** (Caerleon) by Sadler's Wells; a half-sister to French Classic winner **Matiara** (Bering {GB}) by Diesis (GB); and a half-brother by that same sire to Grade I and Group 1 winner **Timarida (Ire)** (Kalaglow {Ire}). Top broodmares and broodmare prospects on offer at the sale include three-year-old **Luna Wells (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), a Group 1 winner in France; this year's French Oaks winner **Sil Sila (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}); **Celtic Ring (GB)** (Welsh Pageant {Fr}), the dam of French Derby winner **Celtic Swing (GB)** (Damister), in foal to Rainbow Quest; MGISW **Some Romance** (Fappiano), in foal to Lammtarra; and GISW **Miss Josh** (Nasty and Bold), in foal to Machiavellian.

HOLLYWOOD HOLDS "WALK-UP" START Friday night's featured eighth race at Hollywood Park, a mile-and-a-quarter allowance test on the turf, went off without the benefit of a starting gate after the back wheels of the gate used for the turf course became frozen. The walk-up start is believed to be the first of its kind in the modern history of the Southern California circuit. "We wanted to use the main track's starting gate, but the turf gate would have been stuck in its path," said steward Pete Pedersen. "It was a real concern, because we thought we might have to cancel the race." But California Horse Racing Board Rule No. 1696 gives stewards the power to conduct a walk-up start in an emergency. The start was uneventful as all five runners got away in order, and Pedersen added, "All the credit has to go to the assistant starters. They did an excellent job." (See So. Race favorite **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King) has been beaten only once and comes into this race sporting a three-race winning streak, all at the Japan Cup distance of a mile and a half. The three-year-old was five lengths the best when defeating GI Breeders' Cup Turf winner Pilsudski (Ire) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in his last start October 6. He makes his first start outside of France. **Singspiel (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}), runner-up in the Breeders' Cup Turf, has been first or second in all six starts this year and is no stranger to world travel after visiting Canada for his last two outings. The four-year-old has been one-two in 13 of his 15 career starts. American challenger **Awad** (Caveat) was fifth in this event last year but has been off the board in five of 10 starts on this campaign. Ninth in the Breeders' Cup Turf, he scored his last victory in the 1995 GI Arlington Million. Countrymate **Flag Down** (Deputy Minister) makes his first start since running sixth in the GI Man o'War at Belmont September 14; the five-year-old Canadian-bred, who has raced in North America, France and Germany, has been third in his two starts at the Japan Cup route this year.

"SHAMATEUR" RIDER ARRESTED AT

AQUEDUCT Claiming to be amateur jockey Carlos Castro, former professional rider Angel Monserrate Jr. finished first in the Amateur Riders Club of America race at Aqueduct yesterday afternoon, but found himself on the way to jail rather than the winner's circle after the event. The New York stewards were alerted to the deception by a phone tip which came as the race was being run; Monserrate and the Rusty Arnold trainee **Cop a Kiss** (Kris S.) crossed the wire in front of the field of New York-bred maidens, but the inquiry sign began flashing immediately. The race, held as a special event between the second and third at the Big A, was never declared official, and the regular card continued as stewards conducted an investigation which took more than an hour to complete; finally the race was declared no contest and all wagers, which totalled \$181,799, were refunded. The stewards released a statement which said, "The rider was held for identification. He produced documentation alleging that his name was Carlos Castro, but he was identified by other individuals as Angel Monserrate. When we felt we had enough evidence...to confirm that he had misrepresented his true identity, we decided that, in the best interests of racing and in fairness to the public, that the race be declared a no-contest." Monserrate, who had already ridden three races on the ARCA circuit as Carlos Castro, picking up a second and a third, had been ejected from the grounds of New York Racing Association tracks in July of 1995. He was also the subject of an outstanding warrant in Nassau County; NYRA security placed him under arrest and took him to Nassau's 106th precinct.

Mr. Bluebird was coming off a narrow win in the Gill Knickerbocker H. Nov. 5. The gelding made the step up to Grade II company successfully with a powerful run from 10th that saw him take charge in deep stretch. "In a race with this big of a field, you have to hope for a good pace and a clean trip--we got both," said winning trainer John Kimmel. "He saved ground and stayed out of traffic. When he found a clear spot he really kicked in." The five-year-old now heads for a winter campaign in Florida.
