PRICES SOAR AT TATTERSALLS Prices continued to rise at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale, with Thursday's second-session average of \$25,132 showing a 70-percent increase over the 1995 figure and Friday's average of \$40,941 up nearly 49 percent over last year's third weanling session. The highest bid Thursday came in for a colt by Caerleon out of La Veine (Diesis {GB}). Consigned by Raffin Stud, the bay was purchased for \$346,500 by Irish pinhooker Tim Hyde. Raffin Stud also produced the session topper Friday, sending out a colt by Caerleon out of Amandine (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}), who went for a bid of \$320,513 to Robert Nataf of Horse France. The highest price to date for a weanling by a first-crop sire is \$150,728 for a filly by Breeders' Cup Mile winner Barathea who sold Friday. Friday's session set records for gross and average on a single day of the December Foal Sale, with 207 lots bringing \$8,642,576. The Foal Sale concludes today.

DUBAI WORLD CUP ON-LINE The Dubai World Cup Committee has announced the launching of its Internet web site. The site, designed by Search Internet Development, a Dubai-based company, contains information ranging from how to purchase tickets and book corporate hospitality, to ordering official Dubai World Cup merchandise, to details from last year's inaugural running and plans for the second renewal, set for March 29, 1997. MEADOWLANDS CANCELS WEDNESDAY Racing was called off after the first race Wednesday night at the Meadowlands due to high winds and low temperatures, which caused unsafe track conditions. The Meadowlands management and jockeys met after the first race had run and mutually decided to cancel the remainder of the card. Traditionally closed for the Thanksgiving holiday Thursday, the New Jersey track was back in action Friday night.

Jockey Sidney Underwood, 33, who was paralyzed from the waist down after a spill at Atlantic City Race Course in 1992, will be able to sue the track for negligence, according to a state court of appeals ruling handed down Wednesday. A report from the *Associated Press* said that Underwood and her lawyer, Michael Scotland, believe that the spill was caused when Underwood's mount tried to prop at a shadow on the track that was the result of poor lighting. The track's lawyers argue that the accident occurred when Underwood put her horse in tight quarters, and may appeal the case to the State Supreme Court.

Colonial Downs announced yesterday that its Richmond Satellite Wagering facility will have its grand opening Monday, December 10. Off the board in three starts since taking the GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H.
