PARAGALLO: UNBRIDLED'S SONG RETIRED

Ernie Paragallo, owner of **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled), who returned from a 4 1/2-month layoff to finish second in a seven-furlong Aqueduct allowance yesterday, said after the race that the colt will be retired. The three-year-old was sent off as the 2-5 favorite in Saturday's event and finished 1 1/4-lengths behind winner **Pacific Fleet** (Afleet), a four-year-old with no stakes credentials. Paragallo, who has been known to change game plans throughout Unbridled's Song's career, said after yesterday's runner-up performance, "I'm going to retire him. If he can't beat these kind of horses, he's not going to beat handicap horses." The gray colt, winner of the 1995 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, took the GI Florida Derby and GI Wood Memorial at three. After a fifth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby, he was second in the GI Peter Pan S. May 26 and ninth to Cigar in the July 13 Arlington Citation Challenge. After that race, it was discovered he had suffered a non-displaced fracture of the splint bone in his left front leg. In addition to giving the colt time off to heal his injury, Paragallo also moved him from trainer Jim Ryerson's barn to Nick Zito's. Unbridled's Song made only one start for Zito, in yesterday's allowance event. The Kentucky-bred won four of 11 career starts for earnings of \$1,266,800.

SADLER'S WELLS FOAL BRINGS \$623,700 AT

TATTERSALLS The 1996 Tattersalls December Foal Sale ended on a high note Saturday, with new records for average and gross of \$33,902 and \$23,561,634 respectively, as well as the highest individual price at the Foal Sale since 1991. The high price came for a Sadler's Wells weanling colt out of Doff the Derby (Master Derby). The half-brother to Epsom Derby winner Generous (Ire) (Caerleon) brought a final bid of \$623,700 from Irish vet Demi O'Byrne. The underbidder was Irish pinhooker Bobby Barry. Sadler's Wells claimed the top four foals on the sale's final day. His colt out of Millieme (Mill Reef) went to Irish pinhooker Timmy Hyde for \$259,875, the same price as his filly out of Katie McLain (Java Gold), who was purchased by agent Charlie Gordon-Watson. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony said, "With a full week of mares and fillies to go, it is obviously very pleasing to precede it with a strong foal sale, and in particular with the highest-priced foal through this ring since 1991. The Sadler's Wells colt out of Doff the Derby is now the third foal out of the mare to top this sale for Barronstown Stud." The Tattersalls December Sales resume Monday.

Gold Fever, winner of an overnight handicap at this distance at Belmont two starts back, stretched out to nine furlongs in his last start and scored by a neck in the GI Discovery H. at Aqueduct. Back at a mile in his first Grade I try of the year, the Cynthia Phipps colt had no speed early but came running when it counted, circling the field at the top of the stretch to take the lead late and draw clear. Explaining his charge's rapid improvement, trainer Shug McGaughey said, "Before the overnight handicap, I asked Mike (Smith) to get on him and give him a little bit of a wake-up call. He went five-eighths in :58 and change and since then he's been a different horse." Added Smith, "Everyone figured there would be a good pace, but to say the race set up for him takes away from how good he is. This colt has gotten so much better these last two months." Gold Fever will now head to Gulfstream, and could make his next start in the GI Donn H. The 2-1 favorite **HONOUR AND GLORY** (Relaunch) was on the pace through a half in :43.84 and six furlongs in 1:09.02 but tired from his early efforts and ended up eighth.

The chestnut has campaigned solely in the U.S. at age four, posting two turf victories in as many starts on the grass, including a six-length tally in the GIII Bay Meadows H. in his last outing Sept. 28. Sent off the 2-1 favorite in this seven-horse field, he pressed the early pace set by BEAU JINGLES (Riverman), took command at the top of the stretch and drew clear to win under a hand ride.

"She got away from there a little slow, but she worked her way into contention and the rest of it looked to be pretty easy," said winning trainer Bill Mott. "She looked like she won with something left." The filly will ship to Florida for a winter vacation before getting ready for a three-year-old campaign.

Hello, winner of the G1 Gran Criterium in Italy in his most recent outing Oct. 20, was sent off the 7-2 third choice here in his first start outside Europe. The son of the Mr. Prospector stallion Lycius raced near the back of the pack until the second turn, where he moved up between rivals, fanned wide into the stretch, came between foes again and was bumped in midstretch but closed gamely to nail Steel Ruhl at the wire. "Usually they're better off when they come in right before a race, like he did," said winning trainer Ron McAnally. "He's only been here three days. I was really surprised, to be honest with you. He's not a very big horse, but the talent he showed to find his way through there, that's amazing. He showed a lot of courage today."

Impressive winning the GI Oak Leaf S. October 5, City Band showed little in her next start, finishing 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Off as the slight choice here, the chestnut miss returned to form; sprinting to the front right out of the gate, the crowd's choice drifted in after the break and caused some crowding, but then took a clear lead and held it all the way to the wire for a handy victory. Runner-up Glitter Woman was banged from both sides at the start, then bumped hard again soon after; she recovered to make a bid for the lead on the far turn but proved second best.

Making his ninth turf start in a row here off a two-month hiatus, the Florida-bred was sent off the 3-5 chalk and lingered near the back of the pack until the stretch drive, where he split horses and finished full of run to catch Satellite Nealski in time. When asked if he thinks Mecke is deserving of the 1996 Eclipse Award as Champion Turf Male, trainer Manny Tortora said, "Yes, I think he should win it. He's done everything at every distance. We went everywhere and ran well against the best."

Timarida (Ire) (Kalaglow {Ire}), four-for-six at a mile and a quarter, has shipped to North America twice in her career, taking the GII E.P. Taylor S. at Woodbine last year and the GI Beverly D. this past August. Scratched from the Yellow Ribbon November 3 due to a fever, the four-year-old has been training at Hollywood since; this is the first time she isn't running right off the plane. Fourth in this event last year, **Windsharp** (Lear Fan) makes her first start of '96 against fellow fillies. SINGSPIEL TO DUBAI WORLD CUP Japan Cup hero **Singspiel** (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) will train toward the 1997 Dubai World Cup, according to yesterday's *Racing Post*.
