RECORDS FALL AT CHURCHILL FALL MEET

Record wagering and the highest purse levels in the track's history were accompanied by predicted declines on-track and in-state at the Churchill Downs Fall Meet which concluded Saturday. "The significant changes occurring nationwide in the racing and wagering business were evident this fall in Kentucky," said Thomas H. Meeker, Churchill's president and CEO. "Our racing product and overall business have never been stronger, yet the competition from river boat casinos that we anticipated has begun to take its toll. That competition will increase as two new boats come on-line over the next 12 months." An estimated total of \$175,288,369 was wagered on the 30-day fall meeting, including handle on-track, inter-track and off-track in Kentucky, and at approximately 620 satellite wagering facilities throughout North America. The average daily handle of \$5,842,945 was up 14 percent over last year's Fall Meet. But on-track betting declined 14 percent as compared to 1995, and wagering on Churchill races at other Kentucky tracks was down from 20 to 40 percent. Churchill Downs attendance, which averaged 7,408, was down 9 percent from '95. Purses reached a record daily distribution of \$342,000 this season. D. Wayne Lukas led all trainers with 14 wins at the meet for a track-record 10th Churchill title. Jockey Shane Sellers was the leading jockey at the Louisville oval for the third time, booting home 52 winners, while John Franks led the owners for the fourth time with 12 victories.

JERRY BAILEY TOPS WORLD SUPER JOCKEYS

Jockey Jerry Bailey earned 46 points over four races to take the two-day 10th annual World Super Jockeys Series at Japan's Hanshin Racecourse this weekend. Bailey became the second foreign rider to capture the event; Cash Asmussen won the first edition in 1987. Japan's Shinji Fujita finished second with 45 points, and Takayuki Ishizaki was third. All 12 contenders came into the final race with a chance to win, with British representative Frankie Dettori leading the field, but Bailey, who won the first leg with 7-1 Mejiro Lambada, guided 40-1 S. G. Flat to victory in the final race to take top honors. Completing the order of finish were Australian Darren Beadman and Japan's Yutaka Take, tied for fourth; American Corey Nakatani, winner of the third leg with Cinema Scope, sixth; Dettori, seventh; Hong Kong's Basil Marcus, eighth; Ireland's Mick Kinane, ninth; France's Olivier Peslier, 10th; Japan's Norihiro Yokoyama, 11th; New Zealand's Tony Allan, 12th.

On the board in five-of-six starts this year, Wandesta (GB) was on the sidelines from April to October before returning to take the GII Las Palmas H. two starts back. The Juddmonte homebred was bet down to 4-5 to take the GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational after that performance but encountered a traffic jam in the stretch and finished fifth. Enjoying smooth sailing here, the chestnut rallied from eighth to turn the tables on Windsharp, who had bested her by three-quarters in the GII San Luis Obispo H. in February and by a neck after a tough trip the GI San Luis Rey H. in March. "This is real sweet--especially for this filly," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "She's been in so much trouble this year. If anybody deserved to win this race, I think she did. She's the best, and I feel she deserves the Eclipse Award." Frankel added that the mare would now likely be retired. The 7-5 favorite TIMARIDA (IRE) (Kalaglow {Ire}), rank early, settled midpack down the backside and made up some ground in the stretch. "She didn't finish with her usual burst; she was just too keen early on," said trainer John Oxx.

Marlin, winner of the GI Secretariat S. in August, had faced older horses in his three starts since, finishing third in both the GI Man o'War and GI Turf Classic before running 13th in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf last time out. Backing up to a mile and an eighth, the Florida-bred took on fellow three-year-olds once again and returned to the winner's circle with a powerful late run. Rated just off the pace early by jockey John Velazquez, who was riding in California for the first time, the bay found room between horses at the top of the stretch and sprinted away to his second Grade I win of the year. "I've just loved this horse from the get-go," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "All week long we felt very comfortable with him. If you take out the Woodbine race, which was on a very yielding and deep course, his numbers just jump out. With the firm turf in place here, I thought he'd run big." As for what's next, Lukas said, "I want to try him on the dirt again. I'm not ruling out the fact that he could show up in the Strub series at Santa Anita."

The Silver Move made a five-wide move in the Gill Nashua S. going a mile last out but flattened out in the final drive and finished fourth. Sitting closer to the pace in his two-turn debut here, the grey followed pacesetter CROWN AMBASSADOR (Storm Cat) to the top of the stretch, put a head in front as they straightened for home and cruised clear in the slop for a definitive victory. "Everything went according to plan," said winning trainer Linda Rice. "We were expecting a really big performance from him today and he gave us just that. I think the Nashua really prepared him for this race; he really bounced back from that performance." Rice added that the colt is now likely to get a vacation before getting ready for his sophomore season. The even-money choice Jules, sixth for six furlongs, finished well but was no match for the winner. "He was sliding at the gate," said jockey Jose Santos. "He'd never been in the mud before. Give him a lot of credit--he made a huge move from the three-eighth's pole." Trainer Alan Goldberg said the Gill Fountain Of Youth at Gulfstream February 12 could be next for the colt.

Dropping a couple of notches, the consistent miss was bet down to 3-5 and rewarded her backers with a rallying score under jockey Larry Melancon. "We'll take her to the Fair Grounds for a little rest in the next couple of weeks," said winning trainer Hal Wiggins of the filly, who was winning her seventh race of the year. "She'll be back to the races in March at either the Fair Grounds or at Oaklawn."
