LUNA WELLS TO BE TRAINED BY RICHARD MANDELLA Luna Wells (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), purchased for approximately \$3 million by Stanley Gumberg's Skara Glen Stables at the Tattersalls December Sales in Newmarket, England Wednesday, will join trainer Richard Mandella's Southern California stable later this month, according to the *Daily Racing Form*. "She should be here around Christmas," Mandella said. "It'll be a nice present. She'll leave England in a couple of weeks after some blood work is done." The three-year-old filly has won five of 10 starts for earnings of \$259,605. Second in the G3 Prix Saint Roman at two, she blossomed this year, winning the G1 Prix Saint-Alary and G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp and the G3 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville through disqualification. In her only start outside France, Luna Wells placed 10th in the Breeders' Cup Turf at Woodbine Oct. 26.

WANDESTA TO BE BRED TO DISTANT VIEW Wandesta (GB) (Nashwan), retired after her half-length victory in Sunday's GI \$700,000 Matriarch S. at Hollywood Park, will be bred in 1997 to Distant View (Mr. Prospector). A Juddmonte Farms homebred, Wandesta is scheduled to return to the Lexington, Kentucky nursery from trainer Bobby Frankel's Southern California barn in about two weeks. Distant View, also owned by Juddmonte Farms, will be standing his second season at stud there in 1997. He was named Champion Three-Year-Old Colt in England in 1994 after winning the G1 Sussex S. over Breeders' Cup Mile hero Barathea.

TWICE THE VICE, EXOTIC WOOD TO RACE NEXT YEAR Grade I winners Twice the Vice (Vice Regent) and Exotic Wood (Rahy), currently at River Edge Farm in Kentucky, will return to Southern California next week and resume training early in the New Year. "They're doing great," trainer Ron Ellis said. "We want to have them run about once a month, maybe five times next year before the Breeders' Cup, which is the series we're aiming for. Look for them to start running in April." Twice the Vice has 10 wins in 19 starts for earnings of \$1,057,204. The five-year-old mare won this year's GI Santa Margarita Invitational H., GI Apple Blossom H. and GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. in succession. Exotic Wood has a nearly perfect race record, with eight wins and one second in nine starts for earnings of \$407,350. In her last outing July 28, the four-year-old took the GI Go For Wand H. at Saratoga. Both mares are owned by Pam and Martin Wygod.

IRISH RIVER GELDING TOPS HONG KONG SALE A two-year-old chestnut gelding by Irish River (Fr)--Sham Street (Sham) brought the top price of \$387,998 at the second annual Hong Kong International Breeze-Up Sale, held Thursday at Happy Valley Racetrack in Hong Kong. According to the *Thoroughbred Times Online*, the gelding was purchased by Lui Siu Mun. A half-brother to Queen's Gray Bee, a MSW of \$416,564, and Shahik, second in the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S. in Ireland, the Irish River gelding had been previously sold for \$110,000 at the 1995 Keeneland July Yearling Sale. Overall, prices at the Hong Kong auction were down from 1995, with 29 horses selling for a gross of \$3,879,980 and an average of \$133,792, down 19.6 percent from \$166,451 last year.

TATTERSALLS THURSDAY RESULTS Tattersalls December Mares and Fillies Sale at Newmarket, England continued Thursday with 174 horses selling for a gross of \$2,188,171 and an average of \$12,575. The session topper was Marie La Rose (Fr) (Night Shift), a four-year-old broodmare whose dam, Rose Bonbon (Fr) (High Top), is a half-sister to three French Group 1 winners including G1 Prix Ganay victor and G1 Arc de Triomphe third Vert Amante (Fr). In foal to Lycius, Marie La Rose was consigned by Haras de Meautry, agent for Baron Guy de Rothschild, and purchased by Kirtlington Stud Ltd. for \$73,476. The sale concludes today.
