### AMERICAN ADVERSITY IN HONG KONG

Two of the four horses set to represent North America in today's Hong Kong International events, **Da Hoss** (Gone West) and **Mateo** (Lil Tyler), will not run, and the sprinter **Comininalittlehot** (Just the Time), shipped to Hong Kong but never entered, will not be coming home. According to a report by *The Blood-Horse* on-line, the five-year-old Comininalittlehot, who was slated to compete in the seven-furlong International Bowl, became ill after arriving in Hong Kong; the gelding did not respond to treatment and was humanely destroyed Saturday morning. "He was fine the first couple of days he was here," Dr. Keith Watkins, the senior veterinarian of the Hong Kong Jockey Club told *The Blood-Horse*. "Then he had a high temperature. He started scouring and then developed respiratory signs of pneumonia and pleuritis. He was treated with antibiotics and anti-inflammatories. Friday morning we drained fluid from his lungs; by late that night, it was apparent he was going to die. The decision was made to put him down before he had to endure any more suffering." Comininalittlehot, a two-time stakes winner trained by Mike Mitchell and owned by Gary and Timothy Burke, captured 10 of his 36 career starts and \$393,627; he set a Santa Anita course record of 1:11 2/5 for six-and-a-half furlongs on the turf winning his last start, the Morvich H., October 27. *The Blood-Horse* also reported that both of the American runners scheduled to compete in the nine-furlong Hong Kong International Cup, GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner Da Hoss and three-year-old Cal-bred stakes winner Mateo, were scratched after testing positive for anabolic steroids. Hong Kong racing rules do not allow for any trace of medication in a horse's system on race day; the first of three drug tests is taken 24 hours before post time.

## Local News: Suffolk Downs

Overnight purses will be boosted 5 percent at Suffolk when the track opens for its 103-day winter/spring meet December 28. Track officials credited strong business at the fall meet, which ended yesterday, as part of the reason for the increase. The Massachusetts oval's fall season began a month early this year. Management also pointed to the track's current three-week holiday break and the scheduled four-day racing week through March for making the purse raise possible. "We're very encouraged by the success we've had over the past 12 months," said Suffolk Downs Executive Vice President of Racing Lou Raffetto Jr. "We had a great MassCap Day due to Cigar, the early opening helped us get some great racing in the fall, and we're glad to be able to return some of the success to the horsemen."

Lone Star Park officials have added another event to their 1997 stakes schedule with the creation of the \$200,000 Mid-South Futurity, set for next July 26. The six-furlong race, open to accredited Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma and Texas-breds, is expected to draw the region's top two-year-olds. Nominations close March 19, and trials for the Mid-South Futurity are scheduled for July 9. The race will be the third-richest at the Grand Prairie, Texas track, after the \$250,000 Lone Star Derby, set for April 20, and the two divisions of the \$250,000 Texas Thoroughbred Association Sale Futurity, set for June 28 and 29; the Lone Star Derby and the \$100,000 Grand Prairie Gold Cup, to be run June 21, will be televised on ESPN.
