FREGY'S TRIUMPHANT IN PELLEGRINI Argentina's G1 Gran Premio Internacional Carlos Pellegrini lost some of its mystique when the expected favorite **Refinado Tom (Arg)** (Shy Tom) was forced to scratch with a shoulder injury. His defection left a wide-open field of 18 for the South American classic. Peruvian invader **Fregy's (Combsway)** stepped up to the challenge and scored a 1 1/2-length win over **First Oca (Arg)** (Batty) and 3-1 favorite **Gran Ducato (Chi)** (Roy). **Fregy's**, this year's G1 Prix Jockey Club Del Peru and the G3 Prix Comercio winner, covered the mile and a half on the grass in 2:23.8. The 6-1 shot, owned by Myrna Stable and trained by Jorge Salas Vera, increased his earnings by \$200,000. The G1 Gran Premio Felix de Alzaga Unzue was a supporting feature on Saturday's race card at San Isidro Racecourse in Buenos Aires. The race was won by **Emigrant (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) who covered the five furlongs in :55.63. It was the first graded stakes win for the four-year-old, who finished second in the G2 Gran Premio Maipu earlier in the year. **Emigrant**, who earned \$50,000 for his win, had five lengths on **Loveshine (Per)** (Flying Paster) who was a head in front of **Wally (Arg)** (Southern Halo).

ALPHABET SOUP WORKS Breeders' Cup Classic Champion **Alphabet Soup (Cozzene)** returned to the Hollywood Park worktab for the first time since the Oct. 26 win at Woodbine. "He worked a half-mile in :50 4/5, very nice and easy," trainer David Hofmans said. "He'll come back next week and go either five-eighths or three-quarters." The five-year-old roan is scheduled to make his 1997 debut in the January 12 GII San Pasqual H.

FASIG-TIPTON DECEMBER SALES RESULTS Fasig-Tipton's Midlantic December Mixed Sale began yesterday with broodmares, broodmare prospects and stallions on the auction block. The sales topper for the session was **Lady Bering (Lord Gaylord)**, a seven-year-old mare in foal to **Not For Love (Mr. Prospector)**, consigned by Derry Meeting Farm, agent. The MSP mare brought \$65,000 from Mrs. J. W. Y. Martin, Jr. In all, 172 horses were sold for \$925,700, an average of \$5,382. That is up 49 percent from last year's average of \$3,597 and up 29 percent from last year's aggregate when 199 horses were sold for \$715,900. The sale concludes today.
