NO PENALTIES FOR HONG KONG POSITIVES

After a full inquiry into the matter, the stewards of the Hong Kong Jockey Club have decided not to take action against Michael Dickinson and Ian Jory, the trainers of the two horses scratched from Sunday's Hong Kong International Cup after testing positive for anabolic steroids, according to yesterday's *South China Morning Post*. Explaining the situation, Dickinson, who handles GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner **Da Hoss** (Gone West), the early favorite for the Cup, told the *Post*, "We administered the drug five weeks before we left after contacting a top scientist in America. He, in turn, put us in touch with the chemist out here, and together they said three weeks would be enough for the drug to clear. There was still some present when we arrived two weeks ago and just a trace when we tested earlier in the week, but they said it would be gone by Saturday. We worked in conjunction with the Club the whole time we were here and the Club knew all along exactly what was happening." Jory trains three-year-old **Mateo** (Lil Tyler), who was also set to represent the U.S. in Hong Kong. Looking to prevent similar problems in the future, Hong Kong Jockey Club chief executive Lawrence Wong will bring up the subject of a worldwide drug policy while attending this week's racing symposium in Arizona.

CANDY STRIPES TO TAYLOR MADE FARM

Candy Stripes (Blushing Groom {Fr}), second in the French 2,000 Guineas in 1985, will stand the 1997 breeding season at Taylor Made Farm in Nicholasville, Kentucky, according to *The Blood-Horse Interactive*. The 14-year-old stallion formerly stood at Haras Abolengo in Argentina. Candy Stripes is the sire of **Different** (Arg), who was named Champion Older Mare, Mare of the Year and Champion Three-Year-Old Filly in Argentina. The chestnut made a splash in the U.S. this year as well, winning the GI Three Chimneys Spinster and GII Chula Vista H. on dirt and GI Beverly Hills H. on turf and finishing third in the Breeders' Cup Distaff. Candy Stripes' progeny also include **Seaborg** (Arg), the Champion Stayer in Argentina in 1995; GIII Churchill Downs H. victor **Criollito** (Arg); and six other Argentine Group winners.

EQUINE STUDY SET FOR 1998 The National Animal Health Monitoring System, a unit of the United States Department of Agriculture, is planning to conduct its first equine health study in 1998. The NAHMS program is designed to help meet the animal health information needs of U.S. agriculture. In order to determine the focus of the 1998 study, the agency is asking those in the horse industry to provide information which will point out the current gaps in equine health information. GI Futurity winner **Traitor** (Cryptoclearance), runner-up in the GI Moet Champagne in his last start at two, is in training at Calder; Alfred Vanderbilt's colorbearer will prep for next year's Triple Crown in Florida. "He's doing well and is in light training. Mr. Vanderbilt wants him to run only a couple of times before the Derby--maybe a race at Gulfstream and the Flamingo--but we haven't picked out anything for sure just yet," said his trainer Mary Eppler. Cumani, successful with Kahyasi in the 1989 Epsom Derby and Barathea in the 1994 Breeders' Cup Mile, has just taken charge of two yearling colts--one by Alzao, the other by Night Shift--for Salman. The handler said: "I am very happy to be training for Fahd Salman. Both colts are nice and, hopefully, we will prove successful together." Salman's most prestigious success in Britain was registered by Generous in the '91 Epsom Derby.

Churchill Downs officials announced yesterday that Roger Nagle will replace Tom Wagoner as the starter for the Louisville, Kentucky track. Wagoner retired following the fall meet after 37 years of service at the Downs. A 52-year-old native of Evansville, IN, Nagle began his career in Thoroughbred racing as a trainer in 1968, and became an assistant starter in 1976. During his career, he has served as an assistant starter at seven separate racetracks, and as starter for Ellis park and Dueling Grounds. Nagle has served under Wagoner for the past 16 years.
