**MECKE TOPS MCKNIGHT WEIGHTS** Four-year-old **Mecke** (Maudlin), who makes his bid for the Eclipse Award as champion turf horse in Saturday's GII W. L. McKnight H. at Calder, has been assigned top weight of 124 pounds for the event. The James Lewis, Jr. colorbearer was second, beaten just a half-length, in this race a year ago. Next in the weights is three-time 1996 Grade I winner **Diplomatic Jet** (Roman Diplomat) with 123 pounds; the colt, also up for Eclipse consideration, worked a mile in 1:42 on the main track at Gulfstream Friday morning. The two top runners last met at equal weights in the GI Man o'War going a mile and three-eighths at Belmont Park, with Diplomatic Jet winning by two lengths over a fast-closing Mecke on a yielding course. Also expected for the mile-and-a-half McKnight are **Lassigny** (Gone West), the winner of last year's GI Rothmans International, and the five-year-old mare **Ampulla** (Chief's Crown), first in four of her last five starts; both will carry 116.

**PLENTY OF SUGAR RETIRED** According to a report in today's *Daily Racing Form*, the multiple stakes winner **Plenty Of Sugar** (Ascot Knight) has been retired and will be bred to Pleasant Colony next year. The five-year-old mare, a winner of 10 races and \$781,764, put together back-to-back stakes wins this fall, taking the GII C Halton S. at Woodbine and the GIII Sheraton Meadowlands Violet H., before finishing fifth in her final career start, the Castle Forbes S. at the Meadowlands November 2. A stakes winner at two, three, four and five going from seven to nine furlongs on both turf and dirt, the Canadian-bred's biggest victory came in the GIC Canadian Oaks in 1994; she was also runner-up in that year's GI Coaching Club American Oaks.

Making her first start since finishing a discouraging ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies October 26, where she was hard to handle through the early going and bore out on the first turn in what was her two-turn debut, Sharp Cat was the favorite to get back on track here. The chestnut filly was once again a little rank through the opening fractions, racing just off the flank of stablemate City Band to the top of the lane, then seized the lead and pulled away to a determined victory. City Band was easily second best, giving trainer D. Wayne Lukas the one-two finish. "This is a very immature filly," he said of the winner. "I told (jockey Corey Nakatani) that she's very, very sensitive. If you snatch her, she'll throw her head in the air...he was smart by dropping his hands and letting her alone, then she settled nicely. She's going to be very, very tough going these double-turn races at Santa Anita. All she has to do is mature a little bit both mentally and physically." This was Lukas' fifth win in the Starlet, a record, and his third in a row following Serena's Song in 1994 and Cara Rafaela last year.

Impressive winning the GII Norfolk by 3 1/12 lengths in his two-turn debut, **Free House** (Smokester) was then a disappointing ninth as the 4-5 chalk in the restricted Cal Cup Juvenile. On Lasix for the first time, the speedy **Arthur L.** set the pace but tired to finish second in a Calder allowance going a mile last out; he had led for a quarter-mile in the **Foolish Pleasure S.** at a mile and a sixteenth two starts back before weakening to fifth, but showed he was dangerous if let loose on the front end when he wired the field for a 14-length score in a Calder allowance October 10. Allowed to coast on a clear lead through a moderate half in :47 3/5, the bay stretched his advantage to five lengths after six furlongs, had 12 as they straightened into the stretch and widened the margin even further in the final furlong to win laughing. The winner will be back for the **Tropical Park Derby** January 2. The 8-5 favorite **LOVE VIEW** (**Sports View**), outrun early, was flying on the far outside when **David's Ghost** drifted out into him and knocked him off stride, causing him to go down. **Love View** and his jockey, **Mickey Walls**, were not injured.

The 1996 Meadowlands Thoroughbred season offered the highest daily purses in the track's history despite declines in both on-track attendance and handle. Daily average purses reached \$167,000, while daily handle averaged \$2 million, down 8 percent from 1995, and attendance averaged 5,500, down 10 percent from a year ago. "Our strong day-night simulcast program helped increase the purses for the live product," said **Hal Handel**, chief operating officer of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority.
