POOR BUT HONEST EUTHANIZED Poor But Honest (Nasty and Bold) was euthanized Saturday night after breaking down on the far turn during the running of the GIII Queens County H. at Aqueduct. The six-year-old gelding, sent off the 4-5 choice in the mile and three-sixteenths event, broke both left front sesamoids and suffered suspensory damage to the leg. "We asked three doctors to try to save him," said assistant trainer Baldi Rojas. "It was just that bad." Trained by Juan Serey, the former claimer finished second to Cigar in the 1995 Massachusetts H., and went on to win three Grade III events, earning over \$600,000.

MEADOWLANDS WRAP-UP While purses reached record levels, attendance and handle figures at the 1996 Meadowlands Thoroughbred meet, which ended Saturday night, showed declines both on-track and overall. A total of \$138,816,762 was handled from all sources during the 67-day meeting, down 5.9 percent from last year's 66-day season; the 1996 daily average handle of \$2,071,892 was off 7.3 percent from a year ago. On-track, bettors wagered a total of \$47,727,759, down 12 percent from 1995; this year's on-track daily average handle of \$712,355 decreased 13.5 percent. Attendance at the track was 373,947 for the season, down 7.4 percent; the average of 5,581 was off 8.8 percent. "It was difficult to develop any real momentum for the live meet with five weather-related cancellations, including the earliest ever--in September," said Hal Handel, chief operating officer of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. Lois and Leonard Green's D J Stable took home leading owner honors with 21 wins; Joe Orseno, who handles the D J Stable runners, earned his first leading-trainer title at the meet, edging 1994 and 1995 champ Danny Lopez by one after saddling 25 winners. Perennial top Jersey jockey Joe Bravo was the leading rider for the sixth straight year, booting home 68 winners, including two on the final day of the season.

Swiss Yodeler opened eyes when he swept through his first five starts without a defeat, taking the GII Hollywood Juvenile Championship and GIII Best Pal S. along the way, but faltered when asked to stretch out beyond six-and-a-half furlongs. The chestnut Kentucky-bred was third in both the GII Del Mar Futurity at seven furlongs and the GII Norfolk S. at a mile and a sixteenth before falling to seventh when trying turf in the restricted Precisionist S. at a mile last out November 11. Given a break after that effort, the colt was seemingly forgotten on his return, going off at nearly 20-1, but soon reminded racing fans of his talent, wiring the field in the Hollywood Futurity for a narrow win over another longshot, Stolen Gold. "The horse was a tired horse and I had to freshen him before this race," explained trainer Mike Harrington. "Certainly people lost faith in the horse; people don't understand what's going on with him. He's still a nice horse, and there was never a question in my mind that he had the ability to do this." In Excessive Bull, favored at 4-5, was well back early, got caught in traffic on the far turn, then came on late to get third.

Making his American bow for new connections after winning three-of-12 in France, Running Flame (Fr) had worked a bullet seven furlongs for this race. Off since finishing sixth in the G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris at Longchamp October 20, the four-year-old was ready for his return; last for a half, the bay moved into contention at the top of the stretch, found running room to split horses inside the final furlong and got up to slip past three-year-old Marlin and draw clear. "It was like he had eyes for that hole that opened up," said winning jockey Chris McCarron. "He knew exactly where he was going." Trainer Mike Puype, who has had the horse in his barn for just over a month, added, "The soft going, I knew, would prove to be very advantageous to him. I was just worried for an instant he might not get through--he had so much horse. He won like he was much the best today. It might have been the right time, right place for him today." The colt will make his next start in the San Luis Obispo at Santa Anita February 17. Favored at 2-1, Talloires, never far from the lead, finished well but had to settle for third. "He gave me his life," said jockey Kent Desormeaux. "His heart is bigger than the racetrack. He handled the soft turf like a champ, but came up a little bit short."

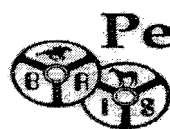
