NO CARD ROOMS FOR GULFSTREAM

Gulfstream Park will not install card rooms in order to concentrate all of its financial resources and personnel on the presentation of world-class racing during its January 3 through March 16 meet. "We decided not to dilute our focus presenting what most experts consider the best winter racing," said Douglas Donn, Gulfstream president and chief executive officer. "Gulfstream is the most desirable pari-mutuel in the marketplace from every measurable standpoint—including the lowest take-out. We have significantly increased our expenditures for capital improvements, customer service and marketing in order to better showcase and sell our unique brand of live Thoroughbred racing."

TOP STEEPLECHASER CORREGIO TO

IRELAND Corregio (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), the likely steeplechase Eclipse Award winner, will head to Ireland for his next start in the \$83,640 European Champion Hurdle at Leopardstown January 19. The five-year-old will go for his fourth straight win in the two-mile race, also known as the Irish Champion Hurdle; he ended his 1996 campaign with back-to-back wins in the GI Breeders' Cup Grand National and GI Colonial Cup. The Irish-bred Corregio has raced in his native country before, breaking his maiden at Tralee in 1994. Looking forward to the trip, trainer Janet Elliot, also a native of Ireland, said, "It could be a lot of fun, because I think his chances would have to be pretty good. It obviously depends on who else is in there, but his confidence is up and I think he'd be tough with his race."
