“DIPLOMATIC” JETS TO VICTORY IN MCKNIGHT

Looking to strengthen his credentials for an Eclipse Award as the year's top turf horse, four-year-old **Diplomatic Jet** (Roman Diplomat) proved yesterday he does not need Belmont Park's hometrack advantage to score a big victory. Sent off the 5-2 second choice in the GII W.L. McKnight H. at Calder Race Course, the Florida-bred chestnut rated midpack for the first 10 furlongs of the mile-and-a-half event, then made a three-wide move to challenge 33-1 outsider **Marcie's Ensign** (Blue Ensign) with a furlong remaining and proved narrowly best, getting home a neck in front while giving the longshot runner-up 10 pounds. It was the winner's fourth graded win of the campaign, but his first away from Belmont after taking the GI Early Times Manhattan, GI Man o'War and GI Turf Classic Invitational over his home course. "I think he deserves the Eclipse now more than I did going into the race," said his trainer, Jimmy Picou. "It would mean a great deal to me personally--I've never had a champion myself--but more so for Mr. Hooper, who has given so much to the game." Fred W. Hooper, 99 years young, has been in racing for more than six decades; he won the 1945 Kentucky Derby with Hoop Jr., and has also raced champions Precisionist, winner of the 1985 Breeders' Cup Sprint, and two-time champ Susan's Girl. He bred Diplomatic Jet on his Ocala, Florida farm. As for the colt's future, Picou, who has trained for Hooper for close to 30 years, said, "I think we'll probably keep him going for the winter. Mr. Hooper is always quick to turn a horse out if he needs it, but this horse is a real warrior." **Mecke** (Maudlin), the 8-5 favorite with Eclipse aspirations himself, was last after a mile, then gained some ground late but never threatened and had to settle for sixth while running wide throughout. The McKnight was marred by the breakdown of **Nash Terrace (Ire)** (Nashwan), who fractured a leg in the stretch and had to be put down. The four-year-old, imported from England, had won two of his six prior U.S. starts, including the Louisville H. at Churchill in June.

Winner of the GI Man o'War and GI Turf Classic back-to-back, Diplomatic Jet had disappointed in his last two starts, first running 12th after leading for a quarter in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, then finishing fifth as the 2-1 favorite in the GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct November 23. Looking to redeem himself, the Hooper homebred settled just off the pace to the top of the stretch before rallying to take the photo. "I knew a few horses in here had a lot of speed, so I would have to wait for my moment," said winning jockey Jorge Chavez. "In the stretch I let him go and he kicked in real strong. He's tough when he starts running." Commenting on the colt's turn-around, Chavez added, "His last two races, he was not the same horse. I can't explain it. They are like human beings, except they can't always tell you how they feel. But he told us how he felt today. I think he deserves the Eclipse. People say he can't run outside of New York--well, he showed that he can run anywhere today." MECKE (Maudlin), off as the 8-5 chalk, was not eligible for the Breeders' Cup and so skipped the big event, but had captured the GI Early Times Turf Classic and GI Arlington Million earlier this year. The four-year-old picked up another win in the GIII Tropical Park Turf H. with his patented late run last out, but his kick didn't carry him far enough this time as he closed from last to finish sixth.

Miss Slewy was looking for a second straight graded win after taking the Gill Carousel in her last start Dec. 1 at Laurel. The mare came from just off the pace with a three-wide rally in the stretch. She took a narrow lead at the furlong marker and edged clear late for a one-length win. "I knew that if she ran her race she would be right there," said winning trainer Ronald Cartwright. "Her last couple of races have been good and right now she's doing even better." Winning rider Larry Reynolds said, "She was all business out there. I was real confident down the stretch because I knew I had a ton of horse." Shoop, the 7-5 favorite, finished seventh. "I was real happy with her positioning and she was really running strong on the backside, but when I asked her to fire she didn't," explained jockey Richard Migliore on the beaten favorite.

Jess C's Whirl (Island Whirl), a graded stakes winner of \$305,928, was humanely destroyed yesterday after breaking down in the fifth race at Aqueduct. The six-year-old, who captured six stakes including last year's GII Fall Highweight H., was leading the field by four lengths inside the eighth-pole when he suffered a dislocated left front ankle which caused irreparable suspensory damage. Still raced by breeders Ted and Larry Oleck, Jess C's Whirl had raced in high-priced claimers before his '95 Fall Highweight victory; one-for-six on this campaign, he was 13th in the Breeders' Cup Sprint and 10th in this year's edition of the Fall Highweight before dropping in for a \$40,000 tag yesterday.
