EARLY TIMES SPONSORSHIP CONTINUES AT CHURCHILL According to a report in *Blood-Horse On-Line*, Early Times will continue to sponsor Churchill Downs' GI Turf Classic while dropping its sponsorship of the second and third races in what was the Early Times Triple Turf Series. The Kentucky bourbon company will no longer back the GII Dixie H. at Pimlico or the GI Manhattan S. at Belmont Park, thereby ending the three-race series that had been run in conjunction with the Triple Crown. The *Blood-Horse* story said Early Times spent a reported \$2 million annually on the series sponsorship and promotions, but will now concentrate its focus on its home state of Kentucky.

OJC SIMULCASTING TO RESUME The Ontario Jockey Club will resume foreign thoroughbred simulcasting on January 1, according to OJC president David Willmot, the *Daily Racing Form* on-line reported. Signals will be imported from Southern California and Florida. North American simulcasts have been blocked since Dec. 6 after the Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association and the Ontario Harness Horse Association failed to come to an agreement on revenue-sharing. The OJC's contract with the two groups expires on December 31 and the jockey club has the approval of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency to resume simulcasting after that date.

Gentlemen, Champion 3-year-old in Argentina, took a three race winning streak into the Native Diver, capturing a Del Mar allowance in July before victories in the GIII Bay Meadows H. and the Nov. 30 GII Citation H.--all on the grass. The colt's last loss came on the Hollywood dirt, but he successfully returned to the the main track with a dominant performance here. The chestnut recovered from a slow start to grab the early lead, keeping a narrow advantage over favored Dramatic Gold before putting that rival away turning for home. Gentlemen easily extended his lead through the stretch to finish in track record time. "I'm a little speechless," winning rider Gary Stevens admitted after the race. "This horse is just unbelievable. (Trainer) Richard (Mandella) just made the comment that he could have rode him and set the track record -- and I think he could have. I never did really ever push the button. He was just doing it all on his own. As for what is next for the talented Gentlemen, Mandella said, "There's a lot of million dollar races in 1997, there's a four-million dollar race out there (the Dubai Cup). We'll have to sit down and figure out a game plan now, maybe the San Antonio. (Feb. 2 at Santa Anita)."

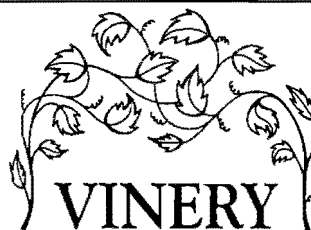
Local News, Hollywood Park:

Hollywood Park Racing Charities, Inc., a non-profit corporation which has allocated grants of over \$28 million since its inception in 1944, presented 85 non-profit organizations with donations totaling \$469,700. Among the largest racing industry endowments were \$25,000 to the Shoemaker Foundation which provides medical assistance to racing industry personnel; \$15,000 to the Winner's Foundation, which provides assistance in alcohol and drug abuse recovery for all California racetrack backstretch personnel; \$10,000 to the Don MacBeth Memorial Jockey Fund toward medical needs, therapy, support and financial aid to disabled jockeys.
