MEDIA ECLIPSES ANNOUNCED Media Eclipse Awards in four categories were announced yesterday, with NBC Sports leading the way with a win in the national television division for their coverage of the Breeders' Cup. The telecast featured four and one-half hours of live coverage of the seven championship races, and was produced by David Michaels and directed by Bucky Gunts. NBC last won the award in 1984, also for their Breeders' Cup coverage. Honorable mention went to two shows by *CBS News Sunday Morning*--"Mr. Hooper" and "Bill Mott." WTVQ-TV of Lexington won this year's Eclipse Award for Local Television Achievement for their documentary on the Keeneland July Yearling Sales entitled "Four Days in July." The one-hour feature, written, produced and hosted by Kenny Rice, aired July 27 on WTVQ, Lexington's ABC affiliate. Kentucky stations swept the category, with honorable mentions going to WHAS-TV and WAVE-TV in Louisville and to WKYT-TV in Lexington. Skip Dickstein won his first Eclipse for photography for his head-on shot of the finish of this year's Breeders' Cup Classic which appeared on the cover of the Nov. 2 *The Blood-Horse*. The photo also won the Sovereign Award for Photography, Canada's award for outstanding achievement. Honorable mentions went to Jim Booth, Wally Skaliz and Michael Burns Jr. Robin Dawson, a radio broadcaster and program producer in Toronto, was awarded the prize for Outstanding Radio Achievement for *The Whip in Horse Racing*, a story which examined the use or misuse of the whip in the sport. The story aired Nov. 30 on "Racing With Magee," a daily Thoroughbred racing program on CJCL Sports Radio, Toronto, and became the first Canadian radio entry to win an Eclipse Award. Honorable mentions went to E.J. Clark of WTMT, Tom Leach of WVLC, and John Asher of WHAS. The Eclipse Award of Merit will be announced January 2, followed by the writing awards January 7, and the human and equine divisional honors January 9.

SEACLIFF TO T-SQUARE STUD Seacliff (Valid Appeal), a graded stakes winner of \$456,300, has been retired to T-Square Stud in Fairfield, Florida. The three-year-old colt started off his career by sweeping the three stakes in the Florida Stallion Series at Calder at two. He began 1996 with a win in Gulfstream's GIII Spectacular Bid S., but, injured in that start, never made it back to the winner's circle. He will stand for a fee of \$2,500, live foal.

King of the Heap was off seven months before finishing second in a Golden Gate allowance and then took a Dec. 7 Hollywood allowance in his last outing. Making his graded stakes debut here, the bay ran last while Hesabull, SANDTRAP (Irish River {Fr}) (5th) and favored VICTORY SPEECH (Deputy Minister) (6th) dueled through fractions of :22, :44.2 and 1:08.4. Hesabull took charge in deep stretch but could not hold off the fast-closing King of the Heap. "It took him a while to get his legs underneath him," explained winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "It worked out good though, because the pace was honest in front of him. When I called upon him, he gave me his life. At the three-eighths pole, I wasn't that confident. But when we straightened away in the stretch, he switched leads and leveled off his stride, and there wasn't any doubt that he'd win."

DON MEADE DEAD AT 83 Jockey Don Meade, made famous by his participation in the 1933 Kentucky Derby 'fighting finish', died Dec. 21 in his home in Hollywood, Florida. He was 83. Meade won the 1933 Derby by a nose aboard Brokers Tip after engaging in a physical, stretch-long struggle with rider Herb Fisher, who finished second aboard Head Play.

Highweight Ampulla comes off four wins in her last five, including the GII Long Island H. at this distance last out.

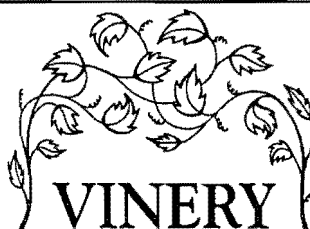
