KING OF THE HEAP TO SAN FERNANDO Newly minted GI winner King of the Heap (Allen's Prospect), who scored an upset in Santa Anita's opening day Malibu S., will be pointed back to the \$300,000 Jan. 11 GI San Fernando Breeders' Cup S., the second leg of the Strub Series, according to his connections. Trainer Wally Dollase said the three-year-old seems to enjoy one part of his job more than the others--standing in the winner's circle. The colt posed for photos for nearly five minutes after Thursday's race. "He's a very smart horse," said Dollase. "He loved being in the winner's circle with his owners. It's probably because they come to see him every time he races and feed him carrots and candy after the race."

JRA YEAR ENDS ON HIGH NOTE The Japanese Racing Association concluded its 288-day racing year Sunday with gains in every major category. Total attendance for the season, including all JRA tracks, was 14,116,684--up four-tenths of one percent from last year. The average daily attendance was 49,016, up from last year's 48,816. Handle totaled \$35,757,339,535, averaging out to a JRA record \$124,157,429 daily, up 5.8 percent from last year's average. A new JRA record was also set for single-day handle when Arima Kinen day at Nakayama Racecourse Dec. 22 saw \$944,108,137 wagered on the card. Betting on the G1-Jpn Arima Kinen alone that day totaled \$784,903,502, breaking the record handle on a single race--\$735,476,265--wagered on last year's Arima Kinen. A total of 17,360,800 people attended non-operating racecourses for intertrack wagering, up 16.4% from last year, while off-course betting attendance dipped one-tenth of one percent to 107,301,431. The 1997 Japanese season opens January 5.

GREAT COMMAND WINS NEW ZEALAND DERBY Great Command (NZ) (Marscaj {Aust}), won yesterday's \$247,175 New Zealand Herald Derby over a mile and a half at Ellerslie in Auckland, New Zealand and now has the AJC Derby in Sydney in March as his main target. Great Command, sent off the 3-1 second favourite, had to work hard for his victory, edging out Heroes Return (NZ) (Clay Hero {Aust}) by a short neck, while the warm favourite Bubbles could finish only fifth after tracking Great Command almost throughout the race and looking the likely winner halfway down the Ellerslie straight. Trained by Mike Moroney, Great Command was ridden by jockey Darren Beadman.

Melbourne Cup hero **Saintly** (Aust) (Sky Chase {NZ}), who was forced to miss the Japan Cup because of severe travel sickness and two bouts of fever, is back to work and his trainer Bart Cummings is still hopeful of saddling him for an attempt at back-to-back victories in the G1 Australian Cup at Flemington March 10. There had been much speculation that the gelding had not recovered from his ordeal in Japan, but Cummings said Friday, "I can safely say that that is all a load of nonsense. He's back in work and he seems to have fully recovered, as I knew he would."

Local News: New Zealand

The world-famous Wrightson Bloodstock Sales Company in New Zealand, which stages the New Zealand National Yearling Sales and many other important sales at its Auckland base in Karaka, has been sold to the Vela Brothers, Peter and Philip. The sale, for an undisclosed amount, comes on the eve of New Zealand's most important and largest thoroughbred auction, the National Yearling Sales, which begin at Karaka on 22nd January. Said Wrightsons' chief executive, Grey Kay, "While the bloodstock operation continues to be a successful one for Wrightsons, it no longer has the same strategic fit with our broader business objectives. Other parties are better placed to add further value to the operation as we concentrate on the growth in other parts of our business." The Vela Brothers operate the boutique breeding operation of Pencarrow Stud at Cambridge in New Zealand and have raced many top-flight horses in the last two decades. Peter Vela said of the purchase of Wrightsons, "This is a business which we are passionately enthusiastic about and it sits comfortably with our farming and fishing interests. We are delighted that ownership has remained in New Zealand, for New Zealand breeders."

Capricious Lass (Aust) (Carry A Smile {Aust}), who finished fifth at odds of 4/7 in the West Australian Oaks two weeks ago, bounced back to her best form to win the G1 \$198,412 WATC Derby over a mile and a half at Ascot in Western Australia yesterday. Trained by Len Morton, the filly won by a short half-head from the 14/1 shot **Strike Swiftly** (Derby Wish). Capricious Lass suffered severe interference in the Oaks and again in the Derby, but her rider Denis Gundry refused to accept defeat. "I thought she was beaten when she struck trouble again, but Denis gave her a great ride and she finished courageously," said Morton, who added the filly will now get a break from racing.
