BOLD EXTREME TAKES RAILWAY STAKES

Former invalid **Bold Extreme (Aust)** (Bold Invader {Aust}) landed a hat-trick of wins this season when winning the G1 Railway S. over a mile at Ascot in Western Australia Saturday. A year ago Bold Extreme, a seven-year-old gelding, broke down with suspensory ligament trouble and there was speculation that he would never race again. But trainer Wally Mitchell decided to give the veteran another chance after giving him a long break, and his decision has paid off handsomely. "I have never gone into a race more confident of winning, even when Placid Ark won the big treble in Melbourne," said Mitchell, referring to his great sprinter who won the Melbourne sprint Triple Crown, the Lightning S., the Newmarket H. and the Oakleigh Plate, in 1987. Bold Extreme, who started the 9-2 favourite for the Railway, now heads for the G1 Australian Cup at Flemington in Melbourne on March 10, when one of his probable opponents is the Cox Plate and Melbourne Cup hero Sainly, who will be trying to win the race for the second straight year.

TOP FILLIES ON CALIFORNIA WORK TAB

Jewel Princess (Key to the Mint), winner of the G1 Breeders' Cup Distaff at Woodbine October 26 and the leading candidate for honors as this year's champion older filly, will make her next start in the G1 Santa Maria H. at Santa Anita February 16. The four-year-old worked three furlongs in :36 3/5 at Hollywood Park December 23 in her first breeze since her Breeders' Cup score. Pointing for a possible rematch with Jewel Princess is Breeders' Cup Distaff third **Different (Arg)** (Candy Stripes). The four-year-old South American import, winner of the G1 Three Chimneys Spinster S. on dirt and G1 Beverly Hills H. on turf, is "getting cranked up" for a return to action, according to trainer Ron McAnally; she worked for the second time since the Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita Christmas Day, going three-eighths in :36 3/5. A three-time champion in Argentina, Different is now four-for-five since shipping to the U.S.

Odds-on looking for her third straight win and her fifth in her last six starts, Ampulla had never been beaten in four prior starts at this distance. The bay mare settled midpack to the quarter pole, swept to the lead from the four path as they straightened into the stretch and outkicked Miss Carleona in the final furlong. "She's been such a pleasant surprise for us," said winning trainer Patrick Byrne. "We bought her as a broodmare prospect with a hope she could race this year. She's helped my career as well." Byrne said the mare would run next in The Very One H. February 12 at Gulfstream, then point for the Orchid H. March 16 "If all goes well, we hope to go to California to run against the colts in the G1 San Juan Capistrano at Santa Anita...she would love the mile-and-three-quarters in that race," he added.

Race Artist, winner of a Calder allowance two starts back and third to U Can Do It in an overnight handicap last out, was no match for the original winner but earned her first graded win via the stewards' decision. "You take 'em anyway you can," said Race Artist's trainer, Frank Gomez. "I've always thought this filly had a lot of ability. We'll look at all the good races at Gulfstream."
