HALL OF FAME TRAINER BUDDY HIRSCH PASSES AWAY

William James "Buddy" Hirsch, inducted into racing's Hall of Fame in 1982 after nearly 60 years in the sport, died Saturday in Bal Harbour, Florida after a lengthy illness. He was 88. Born in 1909 in San Francisco, California, Hirsch was the son of trainer Max Hirsch, himself a Hall of Famer who won three Kentucky Derbies and a Triple Crown. A graduate of Georgetown University, he worked for Bernard Baruch's Wall Street brokerage firm during the Depression. He served with the Army during World War II, earning a Bronze Star and the Purple Heart. During his six decades on the racetrack, he handled champions such as Gallant Bloom and Kentucky Derby winner Canonero II, saddling more than 1,000 winners of more than \$15 million. Hirsch leaves his wife of 49 years, Sandy, sons Bill and Michael, daughter Marilyn and a sister, Catherine Reynolds. A private burial will be held at Holy Rood Cemetery in Westbury, New York. There will be a memorial service this winter in Bal Harbour. In lieu of flowers, the family requests donations be made to the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame, the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation or the Alzheimer's Foundation.

ROWDY IRISHMAN TAKES BREEDERS' CUP GRAND NATIONAL

Vesta Balestiere's **Rowdy Irishman** (Erins Isle {Ire}) ended an 11-race losing streak over fences with a 1 1/4-length score in Saturday's \$161,400 Breeders' Cup Grand National at Far Hills, New Jersey. The eight-year-old, ridden by Sean Clancy and trained by Bruce Haynes, took over with seven furlongs left to run in the 2 5/8-mile test, then held off the late bid of **Master McGrath** (Compliance) for the victory. His final time over a soft turf was 5:09 2/5. "Usually you wait and try to outrun the other horses over the last three fences," said Clancy, whose only other ride aboard Rowdy Irishman came when the pair was fourth in the New York Turf Writers Cup at Saratoga August 21. "But I learned at Saratoga that this horse doesn't have a lot of kick. He's got a great gallop and will give it to you the whole race, so I decided a few days ago that moving early was a better plan." Purchased by Haynes for \$1,500 after an unsuccessful career on the flat, the winner has earned \$400,808, 10th on the all-time leading steeplechasers' list.

Australia's most valuable and prestigious weight-for-age event was won by the 20-1 outsider Dane Ripper (Aus), ridden by Damien Oliver. The bay filly became only the fourth of her sex in history to win the Cox Plate--the last was Surround (NZ) in 1976. She gave her master trainer Bart Cummings, known as the "Cups King," his second straight win in the race. This was Dane Ripper's second Group 1 success, following the Stradbroke H. in Queensland in June. Her long odds betrayed the fact that she had never run beyond a mile, but the dark horse enjoyed a perfect trip, coming through smoothly to beat last year's runner-up, favored Filante (NZ), into second place once again.

● GENTLEMEN BOWS OUT OF BREEDERS' CUP

It's official. **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois), who would have been one of the favorites for this year's \$4 million Breeders' Cup Classic at Hollywood Park November 8, will not be supplemented to the race after coming down with a fever last week. "He's not going to run," said trainer Richard Mandella yesterday. "His blood work and his temperature were back to normal (Sunday), which is good. But if I went ahead and started galloping him and then worked him, he'd be at the risk of getting pneumonia and I can't do that. We X-rayed his lungs and there's a little dense area on the right side, which means it's not just a virus. Who knows what it is? Maybe it was the start of pneumonia." The five-year-old will, however, run again next year. Added Mandella, "I'd like to show him off one more time before everyone votes for the championships but, then again, a rest will do him good."

Returning to the form which she showed when winning the G1 Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks at The Curragh in July, **Ebadiyla (Ire)** bounced back handsomely from a 12th-place finish in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe October 5. Ridden for the first time by French jockey Gerald Mosse, the three-year-old filly was always travelling well in midfield; when odds-on **Oscar Schindler (Ire)**, fourth in the Arc, made his move for home at the quarter-mile pole, she cruised up alongside and then steadily drew away. The five-year-old mare **Snow Princess (Ire)** finished strongly to pip **Oscar Schindler** on the line for the place. Mosse said: "Ebadiyla was clearly a sharper filly today than in the Arc, and the ground suited her."

Coronado's Quest struck gold in his debut with a 7 3/4-length romp in a Saratoga maiden event and followed up with an Aug. 15 allowance victory at the Spa, but weakened to run fourth in the Aug. 30 GI Hopeful S. Returning off a two-month break, the favorite stalked the early pace before accelerating to the front at the top of the lane and pulling away to set a new track record. "He warmed up well and then went out and ran a tremendous race today," jockey Mike Smith said. "I certainly felt like I had a lot of horse out there. I just moved a little bit on him and he was there for me." The Nov. 11 **Nashua S.** or Nov. 30 **GII Remsen S.** could be next for the winner, but trainer Shug McGaughey ruled out going for the big one. "I'm not too keen on sending a young horse out to California, especially one like him," he said. The son of **Forty Niner** broke the previous track record of 1:15, set by **Torsion (Never Bend)** in 1974.
