ANCIENT WARRIOR WINS AT SUFFOLK *Playing Politics* (In Reality--Belle Poule, by Barbizon), a 16-year-old Thoroughbred believed to be the nation's oldest active race horse at a major track, picked up his 25th career victory Sunday at Suffolk Downs in what was his 201st lifetime start. "He just loves to run," said owner/trainer Richard Fruzzetti. "I wouldn't keep running him if he didn't have it in him anymore." *Playing Politics* made his debut July 4, 1984 at Calder and came back to break his maiden two weeks later. In his third start, he ran third to 1985 Kentucky Derby winner and Horse of the Year Spend a Buck. He was also twice fourth in stakes that year behind Smile, the 1986 champion sprinter. The gelding, listed as a grey but now nearly pure white, raced in Florida for four years before joining the New Jersey circuit in 1988. He moved to New England in the fall of 1990. On the board in four of nine starts at 15 with one win, the Florida-bred started the New Year with a neck tally over \$4,000 claimers. While he paid \$41.80, the victory was still popular with the fans, who greeted him with an ovation as he returned to the winner's circle. With 25 wins, 25 seconds and 35 thirds to his credit, *Playing Politics*, bred by Lasater Farm, has earned \$187,367.

LIL'S LAD SHARP IN RETURN Three-year-old Lil's Lad (Pine Bluff), who attracted attention with an impressive second-place finish to Grand Slam in the GI Moet Champagne S. at Belmont Park October 18, returned to action yesterday for the first time since that performance and wowed the crowd at Gulfstream with a 16 1/2-length score. The bay set an eye-opening pace in the mile-and-a-sixteenth Champagne, going three-quarters in 1:08 4/5 and holding on gamely to miss by a head. Owners Murray and Lillian Durst sold a share in the colt to Centennial Farm and Will Farish after the race, and he was subsequently shipped to Kentucky and trainer Neil Howard. Making his first start under new management Sunday, the 1-5 Lil's Lad led every step in the 6 1/2-furlong allowance test, winning as much the best under jockey Jerry Bailey.

Time Limit, who registered stakes victories last year in the July 3 Tremont S. at Belmont and the Aug. 24 Count Turf S. at Delaware Park, was edged by a half-length last time out by stablemate Cape Town in the Nov. 29 1 1/16-mile GIII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill. Turning back to a sprint, the second choice sat close to the pace, grabbed the lead nearing the stretch and drew away late under pressure. "It was my first time on him," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "Never been on him in the morning. He's a speed horse. It didn't look like there were any Eclipse Award horses in there today. I hit him a few times through the stretch and he finished up well. He had enough left." The shift from a route to a sprint was a concern for his Team Lukas connections. "We were afraid he wouldn't show enough speed coming off a mile and a sixteenth race," assistant trainer Jerry Barton said. "But he jumped out there. (Fiend) went out there, like we thought, and Jerry just backed off him. He rode him very nicely. He kicked in coming for home." Barton indicated that the winner may run next in the Feb. 1 GII Danka Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream. The 6-5 favorite POLISHED BRASS (Dixie Brass), running for the first time since capturing the July 24 GIII Sanford S. at Saratoga, was in striking position early but gave way in the stretch to finish fifth. "He seemed to get a hold of the race track early," said his jockey, Pat Day, "but at the half-mile pole he seemed to lose his footing a little bit. I kinda called on him. I wanted to hold his position, but he was unable to do that today."

The Exeter Man came back after a two-and-a-half month vacation to take two in a row, including the Lit De Justice H. at Hollywood November 7, but then shipped to New York for the GI Cigar Mile H. November 29 and did not finish the race, pulling up in distress. None the worse for the experience, the bay was nevertheless sent off the longest shot in this field. Fourth through rapid fractions of :43.78 and :55.92, he closed to take control late in the lane and edge clear. "In the last race, the jock (Mike Smith) said he took a bad step turning for home--he thought he broke down, and he pulled him up," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "Coming back (after this win), (jockey) Garrett (Gomez) even said he felt funny behind, but that's just the way he goes. That's him." Added Gomez, "The race set up real good. The colt broke well, but I let him do all the work the first part. I waited and waited...when I asked, he went to hitting some gears for me. I was afraid he might go to jumping up and down when the mud started hitting him in the face, but he ran through it like an old pro." The 8-5 favorite Tower Full, winner of the Gill Vernon O. Underwood S. in his last December 6 and two-for-two on wet tracks, was in tight while making his bid in deep stretch but found running room late and just got up for the place. "I'm very pleased with his run, the way he fought back and got second," said trainer Craig Dollase. "(Jockey) Alex (Solis) said he kind of ran in spurts. I don't think we were going to beat the winner today. He had a clear trip on the outside. The next race may be the Palos Verdes H. (Gill, January 31)."
