CLAIBORNE/GORMAN CONSIGNMENT BOOSTS KEENELAND JANUARY SALE

Propelled by the complete dispersal of the Claiborne Farm and Nicole Perry Gorman partnership, which accounted for eight of the nine seven-figure lots, total sales for the 1998 Keeneland January Horses of All Ages Sale which concluded yesterday in Lexington rose an impressive 121 percent. After 1,159 hips changed hands, the five-day auction grossed \$53,163,800. Last year's four-day event saw 1,002 horses sell for \$24,041,600. The 1998 average of \$45,870 was up 91 percent from a figure of \$23,994 year ago. Aggregate sales and average rebounded after being down significantly in 1997--declines of 20.5 and 21.1 percent, respectively--while the median, which was up 25 percent a year ago, increased again, gaining 30 percent from \$10,000 in '97 to \$13,000 this year. The gross and average were the second highest in the sale's history; the 1988 January Sale, which featured the \$46.9 million Nelson Bunker Hunt dispersal, grossed \$66,694,900, an average of \$50,182. The 34-horse Claiborne/Gorman consignment brought a total of \$21,205,000, averaging \$623,676. The dispersal was headed by the sales topper, a yearling filly by Seeking the Gold out of Number (Nijinsky II) who sold for a January Sale record \$3.4 million to Demi O'Byrne, agent for John Magnier and Michael Tabor. The top-selling broodmare was Claiborne/Gorman's **Limit** (Cox's Ridge), a six-year-old in foal to Boundary who was purchased for \$2.5 million by Adele Dilschneider. Friday's final session saw 197 horses sell for \$1,694,400, an average of \$8,601 and a median of \$5,000. The session topper was the four-year-old filly **Ticket Counter** (Deposit Ticket), a stakes winner being sold as a broodmare prospect. Consigned by Hopewell Farm LLC, Agent V, the chestnut was purchased for \$67,000 by Doug Arnold, agent.

The Eclipse winner just missed taking the Triple Crown, running second in the June 8 Belmont S. **Lord Grillo (Arg)** (Engrillado {Arg}) would not be a surprise after upsetting Silver Charm in the Malibu in his second U.S. start. **Mud Route** (Strawberry Road {Aus}), fourth in the GI Malibu S. in his previous trip to the post, is trying to live up to the promise he showed last year before being knocked off the Triple Crown trail by injury.

CHARGES FILED IN ALYDAR CASE According to a report in the Louisville *Courier-Journal*, a former Calumet Farm groom has been arrested and charged with two counts of lying to the Texas grand jury which is investigating the 1990 death of the notable racehorse and sire Alydar. Alton Stone was on duty November 13, 1990, the night Alydar was fatally injured, filling in for the regular night watchman. He testified last August that he left the stallion barn at about 9:30 p.m. with a security guard, returning an hour later to find Alydar in obvious pain. Stone, arrested Thursday at the Kentucky construction site where he worked, has been charged with lying about who asked him to substitute that night, and about the condition of the stallion when he was found. Stone was released on \$50,000 bond and is scheduled to appear in court in Houston next week. MGSW Alydar, runner-up in all three Triple Crown races in 1978 and a leading sire, suffered a fractured right hind leg and was subsequently put down. The grand jury is looking into allegations that the valuable stallion was intentionally injured so that Calumet, which was heavily in debt at the time and declared bankruptcy in 1991, could collect on a \$36.5 million insurance policy.

RUSSELL BAZE WINS ISAAC MURPHY AWARD

Jockey Russell Baze has picked up his third consecutive Isaac Murphy Award from the National Turf Writers Association as the rider with the highest win percentage (from at least 500 mounts) in 1997. Baze won with 420 of his 1,484 mounts last year for a winning percentage of 28.3. Edgar Prado ranked second at 26.2 percent, and Garrett Gomez was third at 25.1 percent. The Isaac Murphy Award, named in honor of the 19th century black jockey who won with an eye-opening 44 percent of his mounts, was begun in 1995, and Baze is the only recipient to date. He won with a 29.1 win percentage in 1995; his winning percentage in 1996 was identical to his 1997 mark. Baze, who became the 12th rider in history to reach the 6,000-win plateau December 3, 1997, is based in Northern California.

SECOND TRAINER FOR STRONACH The *Daily Racing Form* reports that owner Frank Stronach, who put Patrick Byrne under contract as his private trainer earlier this month, has now hired Joe Orseno as private conditioner for his New York string through the year 2003. Orseno, 42, has been training since 1977 and has saddled the winners of more than \$18 million. A leading trainer at Garden State, Monmouth Park and the Meadowlands, he currently leads the Aqueduct training standings. Orseno, who will have a division in New York year-round and another at Monmouth Park during the New Jersey track's meet, will continue to train for long-time client DJ Stable until April.
