LUNA WELLS RETIRED Five-year-old **Luna Wells (Ire)** (Sadler's Wels), five-for-nine with a victory in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary in France but winless in four North American starts, has been retired and will now head to Lane's End Farm in Versailles, Kentucky to be bred. A winner of two of her three starts in Europe at two and a three-time Group winner at three, the Irish-bred mare shipped across the Atlantic for the 1996 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Woodbine, finishing 10th. Off for nearly a year after that effort, the bay returned to be third in the GII Las Palmas H. at Santa Anita October 5, but was then off the board in her next two starts, finishing fifth in her final appearance, Saturday's GII San Gorgonio H. "There was no reason I could see for her not running well," said her trainer, Richard Mandella. "She looked really good. She's obviously lost her desire to run. So I talked with the owner (Stanley Gumberg) and we decided to retire her." Luna Wells retires with a record of five wins, a second and a third in 13 starts and earnings of \$319,834. Breeding plans have not yet been announced.

VIVID ANGEL BACK ON TRACK Three-year-old filly **Vivid Angel** (Septieme Ciel), who captured three of her first four starts at two but was sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and eighth trying turf in the GIII Miesque S. November 28 to end the campaign, worked six furlongs in 1:12 4/5 at Santa Anita yesterday and will make her seasonal bow in the seven-furlong GIII Santa Ynez S. January 25. "This is the best she has trained since before the Oak Leaf," said her conditioner, Bob Baffert. "She showed she's starting to come back to life. Maybe she can rebound." The Kentucky-bred bay was three-for-six last year with wins in the GII Del Mar Debutante and GI Oak Leaf S. before finishing 15 3/4 lengths behind champion Countess Diana in the Juvenile Fillies. "The Breeders' Cup was a disaster for her," said Baffert. "She got hit sideways and I think it knocked the wind out of her. When we ran her on the turf, it was muddy and she didn't handle that. But I think she's a legitimate Oaks filly." Jockey David Flores will have the call in the Santa Ynez, replacing Eddie Delahoussaye. "Usually, when I have two bad runs with one rider, I like to try something different," Baffert said.

Off at even-money, I Ain't Bluffing angled in from her outside post position on the first turn, herding 16-1 ALZORA (Seattle Slew) toward the rail, who in turn caused Minister's Melody to check sharply. The favorite then battled Alzora through the first quarter, opened up a clear lead on the backstretch and outgamed Fleet Lady in a prolonged stretch duel to cross the finish line a half-length in front. Five-for-six last year with a win in the GI La Brea S. last out December 27, she was disqualified this time for the interference on the clubhouse turn and placed third. Fleet Lady, 10-length winner in the restricted Andestine S. at Golden Gate in her most recent effort December 21 and bidding for her third straight, was on the pace from the start and held well in the stretch, earning her first graded victory compliments of the stewards. "I hate to see the other number get taken down, (the connections of I Ain't Bluffing) are friends of mine and they want to win it just as badly, but we'll take it," said winning owner John Mabee. "The incident looked like it bothered (Minister's Melody) more than it did ours." The filly will be back for the GII La Canada S. February 8. Explaining the series of events that cost him the win, I Ain't Bluffing's rider Eddie Delahoussaye said, "Going into the first turn, Alex (Solis, aboard Alzora) hollers at me, so I grab my mare and naturally she switches leads right when she comes to the turn. I'm not saying my mare didn't cause a little interference, but I think Alex's horse caused most of it. If he stays straight and holds his position, he's going to be fine. I don't think I actually made contact with Alex's filly."

Irish Conquest returned from an eight-month break to finish second in the Dec. 26 Kenny Noe, Jr. H. at Calder in his previous trip to the post. Looking to increase his record over the Gulfstream main track to four-for-five, the upset winner pressed the pace between horses, grabbed the lead turning for home and held off favored Frisk Me Now in the final stages. "(Trainer Mohammed Moubarak) told me to try and break good," winning jockey Eibar Coa said. "Try to get behind the speed. The other day (in the Kenny Noe, Jr. H.), he broke a little slow. This time my horse broke really good. I was just sitting behind (Heckofaralph) and coming to the stretch, I knew I had enough horse to pass. I was just a little scared of (Frisk Me Now). But when I hit my horse, he responded really well and I knew no one was going to catch me." Moubarak indicated that the winner would run next in the GIII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint Championship March 13. Frisk Me Now, unraced since a second-place finish in the Oct. 4 Indiana Derby, stalked the pace, came wide at the top of the stretch, but could not catch the winner inside the final furlong. Jockey Jerry Bailey was not happy with his ride aboard the beaten public choice, who upset the field at 105-1 in last year's GII Danka Hutcheson S. "I rode him bad," Bailey said. "Plain and simple, I rode him bad."

Triple Crown nominee **Clover Hunter** romped by 12 lengths in a Dec. 3 allowance contest over a track labeled "wet fast" at Golden Gate in his previous start.
